INSIDE THE CFDA

Our CFDA Season is in full speed. I write this column in mid-May after returning from our 1st Indiana State Championship, that was held in conjunction with the Michigan State & Great Lakes Territorial in Harbor Springs, MI. So far this year, I've also made it to the 1st ever Arkansas State, Florida State & Eastern Territorial. Next week begins our West Coast Swing with the California State, Great Northwest Territorial, Washington State, Nevada State, Western Territorial, and National Championship all happening one week after another.

While for some folks who are retired and like to travel around in an RV, that can be a lot of fun. However, just like the Southern Swing we had in March, having so many shoots one right after another, in the same region, can having a limiting affect to those who hold down jobs and must watch their, time, travel and entry fee budgets. We are hearing a number of those types of comments from shooters across the country.

Another factor is that there are two spin-off organizations that are also attracting the attention of some of our members in some parts of our country. Now, I'm all for folks having as much fun as they can with their six-guns, but what concerns me is that it may have an effect on attendance of CFDA Titled Championships that our Affiliated Clubs work so hard to plan and host.

Even Though CFDA has a record 29 Titled Championships this year, including Top Gun of the Year, our attendance at most of our tournaments is holding up very well. I'm also pleased to report that CFDA membership is growing at the best pace it has experienced in several years. The excitement of Cowboy Fast Draw just keeps growing!

Maximum Shots Per Round

This issue has come up again lately. It seems that more and more we are seeing very long bouts between two shooters wherein both shooters just can't seem to hit their targets. I'm sure that just about everyone reading this column realizes that at one time or another we have all personally been involved in long rounds like this, to the point that we find ourselves hoping our opponent just hits their target to end the mutual embarrassment. We have all witnessed many such rounds, the longest I knew of until recently at a titled championship was 29 Shots. Recently, one went 44 Shots. That's not only 88 rounds of host supplied ammo, but also the time added to finish a round before the next round can be drawn for all shooters! The bigger the match, the more chance of extended bouts happening in each round, which is called clearing time. This can multiply into an hour or more at the end of the day for everyone.

In 2019, this issue was placed on the U.S. Marshal's Agenda. At that time, the Marshals voted not to have a limit. Since then, and especially recently, I have been approached by numerous members that really want to see some sort of maximum amount of shots per bout. Perhaps at some point the targets need to be declared the winner. This is similar to what we already do with the Nevada 8 Format. Holding up an entire event just to watch 2 shooters go on and on, while sometimes hundreds are waiting for the next round to be drawn just doesn't make a lot of sense.

As Executive Director, since this is not an emergency, it is not my place to make such a rule unilaterally. The solution should be found through a sport-wide discussion and be codified by a vote of the U.S. Marshals. If you as a member feel that a change should be made, please reach-out and discuss possible solutions with your U.S. Marshal. I am also asking U.S. Marshals to bring this issue up for discussion with your clubs.

The solution should have some combination of number of shots, and procedures similar to Nevada 8 regarding what happens during the shots leading up to and through reaching the maximum number of shots. Some people have suggested 12 Shots (an even dozen), some say 13 (the number of knots in a hangman's noose), and some say 14 (because that's how many spaces we currently have on a standard score sheet). Some may still say no limit. Whatever the decision is, we need to make it, accept it and move on.

Second Chance Matches

Second Chance Matches were created in 2007 as a way to provide fun for those who had been X'd Out of a match on the 1st Day of competition. I really supported that basic principle and it worked well in two-day Last Man Standing Formats, back in those days.

Times have changed! We have innovated and developed better scoring systems and range operation procedures. It used to be a struggle just to get a 100-Shooter Match through just 5 rounds in a day, using two 8 Lane Ranges. Now we're able to run a 100-Shooter Last Man Standing Match to be completed or nearly completed in just one day. Or even easier, a 100-Shooter Magnificent 7 Shoot-off Match down to the Magnificent 7 in one-day. We can do it because we are much more efficient and it works without rushing shooters, as long as we shooters are paying attention, where they need to be as rounds are drawn, and don't have to hunt too much for shooters who not paying attention when called. to the line. I firmly believe the large majority of our members like well-organized matches that are run efficiently, that provides more shooting and fun for everyone.

Running a Second Chance Matches is really no longer efficient in a two-day format. Especially now with the fact that there are far more X'd Out Shooters than Main Match Shooters due to our efficiency. What has been working extremely well in the last several years is running a Bracket Shoot on the morning of the 2nd Day, with EVERYONE

INCLUDED. In most matches they are already down to the Mag 7, even if they are not, there are usually just a few rounds left usually in the Men's Division, which move very quickly. Whereas, if a Host Club elects to run a Second Chance Match sometimes it will leave hours of wasted non-shooting time for those still in the Main Match, since it's NOT generally accepted to begin a Mag 7 Shoot-off while a Second Chance Match is still in progress.

Running a Bracket Match the morning of the last day of competition has really developed into the way to go! We have done it at the largest match, the FGA, for many years. It's inclusive to all of our members and gives everyone a competitive opportunity no matter how fast they are. Plus, it creates a large crowd to watch our Magnificent 7 Shootoff Finals! We include it in the Main Match Entry Fee, so there is no extra-cost for the shooters. It's still optional for the shooters to stick around for, but why wouldn't they? We budget a good deal of our prize structure for the Bracket Shoot we call, "The Blast for Cash". It's also extremely important to run a 2-X (Nevada 8) Format to keep the rounds running efficiently and completed by Noon. We strive to begin our Finals and complete our Awards Ceremony, and get our shooters headed home according to schedule.

As for Second Chance Matches, they still have a place, but really only for much larger 3-Day Matches. For Instance, we still run them on Saturday at FGA, last year we had around 150 Shooters in our Second Chance Match, and we paid out Prize Money. After 7 Rounds we lose about 60% of our shooters in the Main Match, we have ranges available and it provides a fun-day for them. But, we still need to complete it by early afternoon, since our Sub-Category & Tournament of Champions Fabulous 5 Championship Shoot-offs on our Championship Range are popular to watch beginning around 2:30.

In Closing

As you can see, the main two subjects of this column is about efficiency in match management. Our Host Clubs should make their best attempt to condense their schedules to run an efficient format. We need not stretch out main match contests that can be run in one day, into two. If we are running combined championships like a State & Territorials, don't make them both 2-day events. If you want more shooting like Category, Jackpot, or Side Matches, I suggest running them day before main matches, for those who can attend. And, by all means, on the last day of any match, try to get those who may have driven a long way to support your match heading back home by mid-afternoon. Most still have jobs to get back to. I can assure you that shooters study Match Schedules when they are planning on which shoots they can attend. And, if your match runs very late on the last day, they may not come back the following year.

Alotta Lead's Family Favorite Recipe's

As summer approaches the thought of camping or backyard BBQing is on a lot of our minds. Wherever you're at, you want to make it easy, few ingredients as possible, easy prep and easy cleanup. Here's a good one that might be a surprise when it comes to easy and yummy! Make it at your next camp-out, backyard campfire or heck you can even use your oven for this one if you're not inclined to be out in the great outdoors!

The Campfire Lasagna

Here's what you'll need:

| 4 to 5 cups of your favorite marinara sauce | 1 cup of grated Parmesan cheese |
| 2-8oz bags of grated Mozzarella cheese | 1 large egg |
| 1 ½ teaspoon of Italian seasoning-more to taste | Dash of garlic to taste |
| 1 Tablespoon sugar- more or less to taste or omit altogether | 2 cups whole milk ricotta cheese |
| 12 pieces of no cook lasagna noodles-about 9oz worth | |
| 1 ½ lbs. of your favorite Italian sausage- casings removed and diced into small pieces, cooked slightly not to be raw in the casserole (or use hamburger meat cooked- about 2 lbs. if you like and seasoned to taste.) | |

Let's put it together!

- First- mix the egg, ricotta cheese, Italian seasoning, and ½ cup of Parmesan cheese until fully blended- set aside.
- In a large Dutch Oven (with a lid) add ½ cup marinara sauce and ½ cup water to the bottom of the Dutch oven. Top with 3 of the noodles, placing them where they cover the bottom. Pour 1 cup sauce over the noodles and spread it out to cover the noodles.
- Take 1/3 of the ricotta mixture and spread it out over the sauce and noodles to cover. Back of a spoon makes it super easy.
- Next use 1/3 of sausage or other meat sprinkled all over.
- Next sprinkle 1 cup of mozzarella cheese. Repeat -sauce, noodles, ricotta, meat, etc. until everything is used up. Top with mozzarella cheese and cover with lid.
- If you're using a campfire, arrange so they're at medium heat- once coals are hot- make a circle in the center of the coals and place the Dutch oven in the center. Place a few of the coals closer and up the side of the pot the best you can- cook for about 25 minutes- rotating pot periodically -after 25 minutes take pot off fire and rest for 15 minutes- Serve up with a big chunk of warm French bread and tossed green salad- Great camp food and super easy! Enjoy!

Silsbee, Texas - Well, that was fun. The Big Thicket Bushwackers have a unique location to host events, in the Big Thicket National Preserve of Southeast Texas. We have a combination of indoor and outdoor ranges. Blue Eyed Bandit put together a nice walking video of the range area that she aired on Facebook at CFD Society.

Some of our guests brought their campers and stayed on-site. A few others stayed in cabins at the camp. Whiplash and Big Mark get up at the break of day, so they were in charge of having the coffee ready as shooters arrived.

We sorta put on a cowboy roundup event. Everything happened right here at the camp, starting with a Rooster Cogburn fun match on Thursday for early arrivals. With an eye patch over the dominant eye, guns were loaded and shooters hoped for the best. There's lots of laughter and complaining with this match. There can be only one winner. That winner was Whiplash.

We've always thought that the most fun shooting event at a match is the Bracket Match. It's a thriller for those who want to compete at an all-out pace, to those who feel less intimidated by shooting with their speed peers. Sometimes they are one and the same, but not always.

"Gun Fight at Cagle's Corral"

Many people were humming "Georgia on My Mind" this April as almost 60 shooters traveled to the Peach State. They came from Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Utah and Virginia for the second annual Georgia State Championship held in Holly Springs at the Cagle's Family Farm. The event was called Gunfight at Cagle's Corral.

The Cagle family is one of the oldest families in Cherokee County. They ran a successful dairy for many years and a lot of Cherokee County students remember drinking Cagle's chocolate milk at school. Still the best chocolate milk I ever tasted. The city of Holly Springs purchased the dairy a few years back and made it a park. The Cagle family still runs a Corn Maze event there in the Fall of the year.

Two six-lane ranges were set up side by side in a pole barn which serves as a pavilion. We were able to shoot totally in the dry, which was a blessing during several April showers that popped up during the three-day event.

The Ladies category was a great exhibition of accurate shooting. Our new Georgia champion was Slowpoke from Utah, second was Catskill Jean from Florida. Third was Brown Eyed Girl from Georgia, who won the Resident Champion belt buckle. Diamond Girl from Oklahoma

finished 4th, Wildfire from Kentucky finished 5th, Gypsy Girl from Florida was 6th, and rounding out the Mag 7 was Belle Ringer. Scrappy finished 8th, Mustang Diane 9th and Dead Eye Di was 10th.

In the Men's category a new Georgia champion was crowned. Green River battled last years champion 2 Buck Chuck in the final match, and won the match. 2 Buck Chuck finished 2nd, and has been in the finals of both Georgia Championships. Coming in third was Pale Rider, who was also the Georgia Resident Champion. Gunsmoke finished 4th, Adirondack Kid was 5th, B.A. was 6th and also won Men's Shootist, Sourmash Kid was 7th and it was his first Mag 7 ever. Slow Motion from Georgia finished 8th in his first State Match, Syx Killer finished 9th, and Charlie Horse 10th. The host club Hickory Flat Shootist Society had 4 members finish in the top 10. Corinda finished 11, Lead Poison 12th, Chuckwagon 13th, Outlaw Ike 14th, and Charles City Kid 15th to round

out the award winners. We had a total of 47 shooters in the Men's category.

Prior to the Magnificent Seven we shot the Resurrection Match. It was won by the Chuckwagon Kid from Florida, in a close match with Georgia's own 13 year old, Speedy James who finished 2nd. Coming in third was Nasty Nate from Georgia.

A special thank you to the Blue Grass Fast Draw Club for loaning us ballistic netting, and a complete six-lane range. Also to Major D and Gentleman George and their respective clubs for providing our ammo for the event. We as a small club, could not have hosted such a successful event without their generosity. Truly these CFDA clubs demonstrate the "Cowboy Way!"

GUNFIGHT IN TOMBSTONE

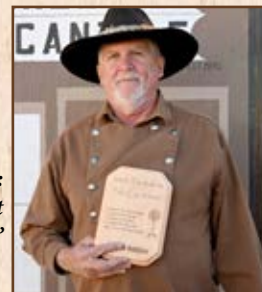

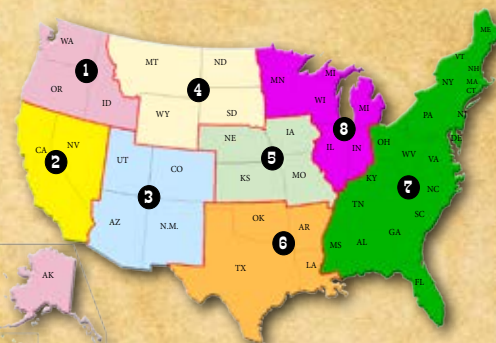

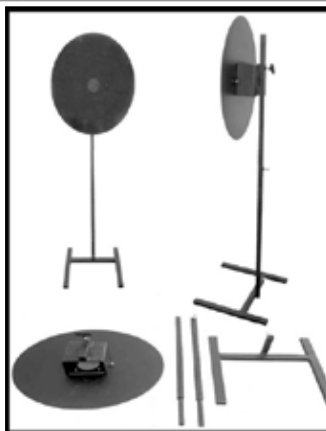

All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned to CFDA only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.

SOME OF OUR GOALS

To keep our clothing & equipment such as guns and holsters true to form of the time period that we represent (1873-1899). 1873 is the year that the Colt Peacemaker was introduced.
