In 2019, this issue was placed on the U.S. Marshal's Agenda. At that time, the Marshals voted not to have a limit. Since then, and especially recently, I have been approached by numerous members that really want to see some sort of maximum amount of shots per bout. Perhaps at some point the targets need to be declared the winner. This is similar to what we already do with the Nevada 8 Format. Holding up an entire event just to watch 2 shooters go on and on, while sometimes hundreds are waiting for the next round to be drawn just doesn't make a lot of sense.

As Executive Director, since this is not an emergency, it is not my place to make such a rule unilaterally. The solution should be found through a sport-wide discussion and be codified by a vote of the U.S. Marshals. If you as a member feel that a change should be made, please reach-out and discuss possible solutions with your U.S. Marshal. I am also asking U.S. Marshals to bring this issue up for discussion with your clubs.

The solution should have some combination of number of shots, and procedures similar to Nevada 8 regarding what happens during the shots leading up to and through reaching the maximum number of shots. Some people have suggested 12 Shots (an even dozen), some say 13 (the number of knots in a hangman's noose), and some say 14 (because that's how many spaces we currently have on a standard score sheet). Some may still say no limit. Whatever the decision is, we need to make it, accept it and move on.

Second Chance Matches

Second Chance Matches were created in 2007 as a way to provide fun for those who had been X'd Out of a match on the 1st Day of competition. I really supported that basic principle and it worked well in two-day Last Man Standing Formats, back in those days.

Times have changed! We have innovated and developed better scoring systems and range operation procedures. It used to be a struggle just to get a 100-Shooter Match through just 5 rounds in a day, using two 8 Lane Ranges. Now we're able to run a 100-Shooter Last Man Standing Match to be completed or nearly completed in just one day. Or even easier, a 100-Shooter Magnificent 7 Shoot-off Match down to the Magnificent 7 in one-day. We can do it because we are much more efficient and it works without rushing shooters, as long as we shooters are paying attention, where they need to be as rounds are drawn, and don't have to hunt too much for shooters who not paying attention when called to the line. I firmly believe the large majority of our members like well-organized matches that are run efficiently, that provides more shooting and fun for everyone.

Running a Second Chance Matches is really no longer efficient in a two-day format. Especially now with the fact that there are far more X'-d Out Shooters than Main Match Shooters due to our efficiency. What has been working extremely well in the last several years is running a Bracket Shoot on the morning of the 2nd Day, with EVERYONE

INCLUDED. In most matches they are already down to the Mag 7, even if they are not, there are usually just a few rounds left usually in the Men's Division, which move very quickly. Whereas, if a Host Club elects to run a Second Chance Match sometimes it will leave hours of wasted non-shooting time for those still in the Main Match, since it's NOT generally accepted to begin a Mag 7 Shoot-off while a Second Chance Match is still in progress.

Running a Bracket Match the morning of the last day of competition has really developed into the way to go! We have done it at the largest match, the FGA, for many years. It's inclusive to all of our members and gives everyone a competitive opportunity no matter how fast they are. Plus, it creates a large crowd to watch our Magnificent 7 Shootoff Finals! We include it in the Main Match Entry Fee, so there is no extra-cost for the shooters. It's still optional for the shooters to stick around for, but why wouldn't they? We budget a good deal of our prize structure for the Bracket Shoot we call, "The Blast for Cash". It's also extremely important to run a 2-X (Nevada 8) Format to keep the rounds running efficiently and completed by Noon. We strive to begin our Finals and complete our Awards Ceremony, and get our shooters headed home according to schedule.

As for Second Chance Matches, they still have a place, but really only for much larger 3-Day Matches. For Instance, we still run them on Saturday at FGA, last year we had around 150 Shooters in our Second Chance Match, and we paid out Prize Money. After 7 Rounds we lose about 60% of our shooters in the Main Match, we have ranges available and it provides a fun-day for them. But, we still need to complete it by early afternoon, since our Sub-Category & Tournament of Champions Fabulous 5 Championship Shoot-offs on our Championship Range are popular to watch beginning around 2:30.

In Closing

As you can see, the main two subjects of this column is about efficiency in match management. Our Host Clubs should make their best attempt to condense their schedules to run an efficient format. We need not stretch out main match contests that can be run in one day, into two. If we are running combined championships like a State & Territorials, don't make them both 2-day events. If you want more shooting like Category, Jackpot, or Side Matches, I suggest running them day before main matches, for those who can attend. And, by all means, on the last day of any match, try to get those who may have driven a long way to support your match heading back home by mid-afternoon. Most still have jobs to get back to. I can assure you that shooters study Match Schedules when they are planning on which shoots they can attend. And, if your match runs very late on the last day, they may not come back the following year.



Alotta Lead's Family Favorite Recipe's

As summer approaches the thought of camping or backyard BBQing is on a lot of our minds. Wherever you're at, you want to make it easy, few ingredients as possible, easy prep and easy cleanup.

Here's a good one that might be a surprise when it comes to easy and yummy! Make it at your next camp-out, backyard campfire or heck you can even use your oven for this one if you're not inclined to be out in the great outdoors!

The Campfire Lasagna

Here's what you'll need:

4 to 5 cups of your favorite marinara sauce

2-8oz bags of grated Mozzarella cheese

1 1/2 teaspoon of Italian seasoning-more to taste

1 Tablespoon sugar- more or less to taste or omit altogether

12 pieces of no cook lasagna noodles-about 9oz worth

1 cup of grated Parmesan cheese

1 large egg


Dash of garlic to taste

2 cups whole milk ricotta cheese

1½ lbs. of your favorite Italian sausage- casings removed and diced into small pieces, cooked slightly not to be raw in the casserole (or use hamburger meat cooked- about 2 lbs. if you like and seasoned to taste.)

Let's put it together!

- First- mix the egg, ricotta cheese, Italian seasoning, and ½ cup of Parmesan cheese until fully blended- set aside.
- In a large Dutch Oven (with a lid) add ½ cup marinara sauce and ½ cup water to the bottom of the Dutch oven. Top with 3 of the noodles, placing them where they cover the bottom. Pour 1 cup sauce over the noodles and spread it out to cover the noodles.
- Take 1/3 of the ricotta mixture and spread it out over the sauce and noodles to cover. Back of a spoon makes it super easy.
- Next use 1/3 of sausage or other meat sprinkled all over.
- Next sprinkle 1 cup of mozzarella cheese. Repeat -sauce, noodles, ricotta, meat, etc. until everything is used up. Top with mozzarella cheese and cover with lid.
- If you're using a campfire, arrange so they're at medium heat- once coals are hot- make a circle in the center of the coals and place the Dutch oven in the center. Place a few of the coals closer and up the side of the pot the best you can- cook for about 25 minutes- rotating pot periodically -after 25 minutes take pot off fire and rest for 15 minutes- Serve up with a big chunk of warm French bread and tossed green salad- Great camp food and super easy! Enjoy!





Tombstone, Arizona Territory

The Old Pueblo Gunfighters Cowboy Fast Draw Club of Tucson, Arizona hosted their eighth Gunfight in Tombstone. On March 24th twenty-three members of the Club arrived at the empty lot across from the O.K. Corral at 9:00 A.M. Hankerin' Hank and Gold Dust had towed the trailer with the portable range and equipment to Tombstone that morning. We had the range set up and tested by 11:30. That's when we started the "Try Cowboy Fast Draw" event. The lucky tourists that were in Tombstone that day were able to learn about gunfighting and to participate as well. We had a curious crowd most of the day. Not everyone wanted to learn to shoot, but everyone was interested in the gunfighting going on. It was a good learning experience for new members of the Club, as well as the public. We stopped at 4:00 P.M. and had taught 59 people how to be a Gunfighter that day. We had people from all around the nation asking if there was a Fast Draw club in their area. We passed a

lot of information out to them about CFDA. Hopefully they will find a club in their state.

Because of some scheduling issues with the Town, we had to move our shoot date. It was 5 weeks earlier than last year. We were not able to give a firm date until just a month before. This kept our attendance a little lower than normal. But on March 25th the fifty-eight Gunfighters registered, arrived early. Sign up went smoothly. Specs had obtained door prizes for each Gunfighter that entered the Tournament. We had fifty sponsors for the Shoot (see web-site for list. www.oldpueblogunfighters.com) Diamondback Shooting Supply of Tucson had given the Club three Riton High Powered Rifle scopes 3x12x56, valued at \$500 each, as a donation. We decided to award one for the overall winner of the event and one for a raffle. Specs had also received a rod and real with a load of tackle from Club members, Boss Hoss, Tequila Shooter and 12 Gauge. Smoke Signals Cigar Shop of Tombstone had donated a very colorful holster made by Miguel Loco of Tombstone, valued at \$100.

Club member Alonzo Slim donated a Crossman air pistol that was a perfect replica of a Colt .45. Specs used the holster, pistol, and playing cards from the 1800's to put together a shadow box for a raffle item. Two raffles were held. One of the Riton Scopes was the first prize and the fishing gear was the second prize. Detox of Tucson was the lucky winner of the Riton Scope. Second Chance of Tucson won the fishing gear, making his daughter, Rajin' Raegan, very happy. The

raffle for the shadow box went to Muletrain of Phoenix. The third scope was put in a drawing of all the club members that helped set-up and run the "Try Cowboy Fast Draw" event. Specs welcomed the Gunfighters ahead of the scheduled time with everyone

being signed in early. Arizona Cactus Kid led us with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. Then Match Director Otto Matic went over the format and safety rules. He called the roll and Still Shot sent everyone into the street for a group picture in



front of the O.K. Corral. We had the Hateful Eight for the six qualifying rounds we were able to get in, then went to win with three for the shoot-off. It was a beautiful day in the Gunfight Capital of the World, sun shining, slight breeze, and 60 degrees.

We would like to say a big thanks to Still Shot for keeping the scoring going smoothly, with a little help from Bandana Kid and Sierra Rose. Bandana Kid, Dazzlin' Daisy, Hankerin' Hank, and Yucca Kid took turns on the microphone giving the commands. Thanks to everyone that



pitched in as a Range Officer as well. Much appreciated. In all, the shoot went smoothly with just a few miscues.

The Bracket Shoot-off saw a few of the Gunfighters go on some win streaks. In Bracket A Muletrain went from 14th to 11th place. Alonzo Slim started in 10th place and won his way up to 6th. In Bracket B Chaparral went from 28th to 26th. But no one moved up more than Yellowstone. He was in 54th place after qualifying rounds. He went on a 13 round winning streak. He moved up to 41st place overall and was 3rd in Bracket C. that is a terrific winning streak. Congratulations to Yellowstone.





THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

Ammunition

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center) 24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center) Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Westernstyle blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to <u>educate as many people as</u> <u>possible in the safe and proper use of firearms.</u> Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.


