Inside The CFDA

WOW!!! Our CFDA Season has really been busy this year. It all started in March with a CFDA Titled Championship on almost every weekend somewhere in our country. Plus, France had their 1st CFDA National Championship this year! Sometimes titled championships are even being held on the same weekend when there is enough distance between them, which is within our rules.

By in large, CFDA is more regional than it was years ago. In the early years between 2003 & 2006, there were only a few titled championships each year. So, our really active members would travel greater distances to support them all. We had 4 in 2004 & '05, by '07 we had 7. We added the use of Alias's and the Top Gun of the Year Point System in 2007 and by '10 we had 15 CFDA Titled Championships and never looked back. This year we have 28 titled championships! Having a lot of "choices" is a certainly nice problem to have.

We hope our committed members do their best to arrange their schedules each year to support their State & Territorial Championships, and then try to attend the National or World Championship or perhaps both. Some of our members find the time and means to make over a dozen titled championships, they love to go to as many matches as possible. Perhaps for Top Gun points, but most likely just because they enjoy the fun, camaraderie and the friendly competition that Cowboy Fast Draw offers.

We're also very proud of the fact that for many of our members CFDA has become a lifestyle. This lifestyle has become the dream of many of our retired, near retired, or semi-retired members to invest in an RV and plan travel schedules to visit many parts of our great nation. There's no doubt that traveling is even more fun when there's something you love to do and friends to share it with, upon reaching your destination.

The FGA (Fallon, NV)

Our World Championship is coming together nicely this year. We return to our new home, the fabulous 3 C Arena! Last year our new venue opened just a few months prior to our event and they've continued to make improvements to this beautiful facility. This year, we are planning to make much better use of the huge Jumbo-trons and sound system that weren't quite operating to where we could use them properly last year. We are also working on a new system of food vendors this year, so that at least one food truck will be there to take and fill early dinner orders. Many of our shooters might rather have the option to just hang out after the day's shooting and have dinner before the daily line-up of on-site evening activities begin.

We are again providing a Hosted Bar this year for our evening events, which is no small deal, thanks to our Sponsor, Breakthru Beverage Distributors, who are huge supporters of our 2nd Amendment. We would also like to thank in advance Ranger Reeves & Philippines Red who will head up and coordinate our Bartender Posse, with the help of Turd Herder, Honey Bucket, Perk, BA, and Slowpoke!

How About Some Range Master Stuff?

"A ONE, and a TWO, and a THREE"-, no I'm not going Lawrence Welk on you... What I'm talking

about is how Range Masters and Hand Judges call (Hits or Misses). I'll get into that a little further into my column. Efficiency- Running any match from club level on up to our largest championships efficiently keeps clearing times between groups consistent and running on time. There needs to be a shared sense of urgency to keep the rounds running smoothly. Not only from the officials, but also from our shooters, who need to be where they're supposed to be without having to be hunted down and called repeatedly to report to their assigned range and lane. Match Directors of matches using multiple shooting ranges should include in every shooter's meeting a statement about how to read CFDA Lane Assignment Sheets and how the shooters should report to their assigned range a.s.a.p. and expect to "posse up" and not leave until they're sure there is enough help to run everyone assigned to that range through the entire round.

The benefit at local matches is that we can all get more rounds and shooting in. It also prepares your club members better for competing in larger championship matches. I really believe that our shooters enjoy well-run and efficient matches, as opposed to slow-paced events with too much time between rounds. These same benefits apply to our largest championship matches as well. We can get more rounds in on the first day, without stretching into late afternoons, which makes Sundays easier days to get everyone back heading home on time.

Achieving Momentum and Good Timing, without making shooters feel like they are being rushed, takes talented teams of competent Range Masters, Announcer/ Timer Operators a.k.a. "Announcers" and Score Writers. Which is exactly why I've always felt that the best Range Masters also are good Announcers and visa-versa, with both also knowing how to accurately fill out score-sheets. Having experienced Score Writers is always a huge advantage, but many are volunteers or shooters with very little experience. Announcers are in the middle, they must team-up not only with the Range Master, but also with the Score Writer. This means that Announcers must be able to supervise and read score-sheets, then announce from them, which is really a method to double-check score-sheets before they are sent to the Stat Shack. The CFDA Scoring Program Staff should also double-check all score-sheets before entering them.

Golf Tee System- Recently, I noticed and commented on a thread on the Cowboy Fast Draw Society about a system that was once used in the Eastern U.S., wherein the Announcers placed golf tees on a specially designed board to keep track of winning hits. I attended a championship in 2019 and they had a lot of pride in using them, which I respected and tried to use myself, since I'm always interested in trying something new that might work on sport-wide basis. However, due to higher number of drawing errors than usual, I checked in with the stat shack. The program operator complained that there were a high number of score-sheets being turned in with numerous errors on them. It became apparent to me that Announcers were perhaps too busy placing and calling from their golf tees, rather than doing what I wrote about in the preceding paragraph. So, I recommended that they stop using this system.

Announcer/Timer Operators a.ka. "Announcers"- are the "drummer of their band", their job is to keep bringing up shooters and Hand Judges without losing momentum and keeping the tone light and fun for everyone.

At the beginning of a round, they should call the shooters to their lanes, always alias first, lane second. Then call the Hand Judges by alias & lane, then repeat it immediately! Then, as soon as the Range Master calls,

"Load and Make Ready", it becomes the perfect time to announce "Hand Judges in the Hole" by alias & lane.

Finally, introduce the **Shooters on the Line**, and confirm with the Score Writer that everyone is on their proper lanes. The key to maintaining momentum is to prioritize keeping Hand Judges informed and moving towards their positions.

Beginning with the 2nd Group, the Announcer should say, "Hand Judges to Please Move Forward to the Firing Line", then immediately call the Hand Judges to the line by alias & lane, then repeat it immediately.

Note: Announcing shooters first, rather than calling for Hand Judges, is a waste of time. If they have just finished hand judging, they already should be well aware that they are next shooter on the line.

The reason we always call the shooter's alias first and

then lane second, is because they are more likely to pay attention to the lane after hearing their name called first. The reason we also repeat immediately, is that if you don't they will soon begin to ask, "What lane am I on again?"

Range Masters- are in charge of the range itself and must keep the momentum going on the firing line, to oversee that targets are properly greased, the shooters and Hand Judges are all present and safety glasses are on, before calling "Load and Make Ready". When Range Masters and Announcers work as a coordinated team it is like poetry in motion.

Hand Judges Siting on Stools- A few years ago, we started recommending Hand Judges to be seated "so that the Range Master can easily identify that shooters are ready." (See Hand Judging Section "L.") But is that the only thing that Range Masters should be watching? The answer is NO!

A seated Hand Judge may be one indicator, but really the Range Master should be watching every shooter and should place themselves in a position that they can see every shooter and their holster, when possible. The Range Master should not only see guns in holsters, but also get a feel for if all the shooters are really ready before calling "Line is Ready" command. (Please review Range Master Duties #7.)

Hits or MissesSo, back to the beginning statement. On Page 17. in the Rulebook under Timer Malfunctions, please see #5. it mentions that targets must be, clearly hit, which is underlined. When going downrange to check a hit with the Hand Judges, everyone has already been looking for a hit for several seconds, and as they get closer a "clear hit" should be obvious in the matter of just a few seconds or not. If the Range Master cannot determine if there is a hit or not in about 3 seconds, it really isn't a clear hit, is it? It's time to call it one way or another and immediately report their findings to the Announcer at the score table. There really should be no downrange vigils lasting sometimes a minute or two inspecting every edge for evidence of slightly disturbed grease. "Clearly Hit" means exactly what it says...

But Wait There's More- Naw, just kidding.... Actually, there is, but I'm running out of space in this column. So, I just want to wish you all the best and I look forward to seeing you all soon at another exciting CFDA Event! Maybe you can even make it to the big show in Fallon! As of this writing we're already over ½ full!

As folks started trickling in from the Western Circuit of weekend shoots – all the way from Caldwell, Idaho down to Fernley, Nevada now to their final destination into Oroville, California for 5 great days of shooting. Those who showed up early were at large to be given last minute tasks... With that being said, we would like to give a HUGE "Thank You" to The Sawtooth Shootists Society!! All weekend long, and right from the start, Curley Calhoun, Cool Hand Suz, Gambler, Ladyhawk, Montana, Rossow, and Skinner were given tasks and without hesitation or a blink of an eye, got to it. You all showed your true Cowboy Way. Thank you!

High Noon, Wednesday June 7th with a perfect 82°, we held a Pot Shoot for those in town that couldn't wait to get the show started. Those being 22 ladies and 71 men, we had 93 shooters ready to start off with a bang! Awarding the Top 3 Men and Top 3 Ladies, it took 14 rounds for both groups to shake out the winners.

ESTERN BRRITIO RIVAN

Registration and equipment check were open 12p-6p for our shooter's convenience. Very well played as a majority of shooters took advantage and were ready to shoot come Thursday morning.

The Western Territorial Championship begins as we started our Shooter's Meeting at 7am, bright and early Thursday, June 8th as we had to get through 45 ladies, 88 men, and 10 youth, 143 shooters in all and we had to get through to a Mag 7 Final finish as promised. Loaded up with Spitfire Wax and Rio primers, we were ready!! Fowl Shot gave a 'Welcome' to all the shooters, a safety meeting by Short Keg, Pledge of Allegiance, prayer by Crosswired, and we were sent off to our ranges. Wild Shot in as Master Scorekeeper, he had us running non-stop and shooting. No complaints, no hiccups, as we shot all day smoothly as hoped.

With a FULL day of shooting, we whittled our way down to the Youth Fab 5 Finals. Lined up in their seeding order, we have 1st Baby Beast, 2nd Phoebe Ann, 3rd Night Hawk, 4th Little J, and 5th Miss Em. I personally think Night Hawk was loving it, being right smack dab in the middle of the girls (shhh)!!

Little J and Miss Em take lanes 1 & 2, taking it 2/2 but Little J gets the faster hit, winning that round. Little J then takes on Night Hawk. Hoping to ruffle her feathers by taking her winning lane, these two also take their bout 2/2 but Little J gets the faster shot again and takes another win. This is when I hear a dear shooter in my head saying, "Bring me another shooter", sounds fitting. We miss you Everett Hitch. Phoebe Ann steps up to take on Little J on lanes 1 & 2, but this only lasts 4 shots until Little J wins another round!! Over on lanes 3 & 4, Night Hawk and Miss Em bounce .7s back and forth at each other, taking it to 2/2 when Night Hawk has the final shot and kindly places Miss Em in 5th place. Now its Baby Beast who walks up to take on Little J on lanes 1 & 2. These two young ladies, from the same club - The Deputies, out of Southern California know each other very well. Little J has woken the beast in her club member as Baby Beast wins this round placing herself

in the cat bird seat. Over on lanes 3 & 4, Phoebe Ann and Night Hawk are duking it out as Night Hawk has hit his target four times but just not fast enough to send Phoebe Ann on her way. Instead, Phoebe Ann sends Night Hawk flying out in 4th place. Now we have Little J and Phoebe Ann shooting it off once more to see who will get 3rd place and who will shoot off with Baby Beast. These two girls want the win badly and take their bout 2/2, but it's Phoebe Ann who has the last shot, placing Little J 3rd. Then there was two... front and center we now have Baby Beast and Phoebe Ann. Phoebe Ann takes a commanding lead after two shots. The score goes 1-2 but Phoebe Ann takes the final shot

and gives Baby Beast her first X. Now they both are wounded with an X a piece. They switch lanes and go again. Phoebe Ann and Baby Beast both hit their first two shots, but Phoebe Ann is just a bit faster. Then the unfortunate event of a safety violation from Phoebe Ann, as she wants to be sure she has the faster hit, but her trigger finger is just a hair too fast and a boot shot happens, giving Baby Beast an automatic win for that bout, placing herself in 2nd place. A boot shot is something that we all hate to see happen but occasionally it does. It's our adrenaline, wanting to pick up our speed and it's a learning phase. Nothing to be embarrassed about, just something we must work on. Baby Beast takes 1st – The Western Territorial Youth Champion!!

Now on to the Junior Finals... We had two young ladies and two young men. Lined up in their seeding order, 1st Shell shock, 2nd Little

Miss Sunshine, 3rd Anytime Kid, and 4th Speedy James. The young gents start the crowd off with Speedy James on lane 1 and Anytime Kid on 2. It's Anytime Kid who takes that round with 3 out of 5 hits and sends Speedy James off to wait for an opponent on lanes 3 & 4. Next up is our 2nd seed, Little Miss Sunshine



to take on Anytime Kid. She bumps Anytime Kid from his roost and moves him to lane 1. Little Miss Sunshine gets the first hit on the target but then Anytime Kid comes back and hits 3 in a row to win that round. Next up is the 1st seed, Shell Shock. She also moves Anytime Kid by taking his lane, now moving him back to lane 2. Anytime Kid gets the





first two hits but then Shell Shock gets the next two. 2/2 now but the next shot comes from Anytime Kid to close the deal and now he's in the catbird seat, waiting. Meanwhile, we have Little Miss Sunshine and Speedy James on 3 & 4 not wanting to be the one who goes out in 4th place. It's Little Miss Sunshine who gets 3 hits on her target first, and that places Speedy James in 4th place. While Anytime Kid is watching from the corner in the catbird seat, the two young ladies take lanes 3 & 4 to shoot it out to see who will challenge Anytime Kid. These two ladies are hitters, and it goes 2/2, but Little Miss Sunshine gets the final hit. Shell Shock steps away gracefully and takes 3rd place. The final two Jr.s are now on lanes 3 & 4, front and center. It's Little Miss Sunshine who gets 4 to Anytime Kids 1 hit, giving him an equal X to hers, and they swap lanes and go again. Oh, the suspense!! This round lasts for 6 shots but it's Anytime Kids 3 hits that takes the win. Little Miss Sunshine places 2nd and Anytime Kid 1st – The Western Territorial Junior Champion!!

Time for the Ladies Mag 7 Finals... Lined up in their seeding order, 1st Flying Cowgirl, 2nd Jess, 3rd Deadeye Daisy, 4th Ricochet Rose, 5th QD Kate, 6th Lefty Lipscomb, and 7th Sierra Rose. First up, we have Sierra Rose and Lefty Lipscomb on 1 & 2. Sierra Rose gets two hits on to Lefty Lipscomb one hit and finishes the round with a third winning hit. Here comes QD Kate to shoot it out with Sierra Rose. These ladies take it 2/2 but it's QD Kate who gets the winning shot and sends Sierra Rose down to contend with Lefty Lipscomb on 3 & 4 once again. Ricochet Rose, our 4th seed steps to the line. Ricochet Rose and QD Kate take the score 1/1 but Ricochet Rose gets two more hits and takes the round. Meanwhile, on 3 & 4 we have Lefty Lipscomb and Sierra Rose at it again. One of these ladies will walk away in 7th place. This time both ladies are hitting right out of the gate. Both hit 1,2,3, but Lefty Lipscomb's hits are just a bit faster, winning that round as Sierra Rose exits the line after a hug from her opponent. Now on lanes 1 & 2 we have Ricochet Rose who challenges Deadeye Daisy, our 3rd seed. After four shots and 3 hits, Ricochet Rose wins that bout. While on 3 & 4, QD Kate and Lefty Lipscomb duke it out for 6th place. Lefty Lipscomb seems to have gotten her mojo back with another 1,2,3 hits to win that bout as QD Kate takes 6th place. Next on 1 & 2 is our 2nd seed, Jess, to take on Ricochet Rose. These ladies both get 3 hits on the plate, but it's Ricochet Rose that is just a bit faster and takes another win. Over on lanes 3 & 4

we have Lefty Lipscomb and Deadeye Daisy. Its 1/1 but Deadeye Daisy gets another two hits before Lefty Lipscomb can and takes the round placing Lefty Lipscomb in 5th place. Flying Cowgirl, our 1st seed steps to the line with Ricochet Rose on lanes 1 & 2. Both hitting at the same time, Flying Cowgirl takes control with 2/0 then strikes again with the final third hit. Still shooting on lanes 3 & 4, Jess and Deadeye Daisy take four shots at it but it's Deadeye Daisy who rises and wins that round, placing Jess in 4th place. Now we are down to 3 final ladies. Ricochet Rose and Deadeye Daisy both marked with an X, one of these ladies will be 3rd place. The round goes 1/1, 1/2, then 1/3 and done. Ricochet

Rose respectfully takes 3rd place. Now we have a mother and daughter left, but there is no love on the line, as we like to say. Deadeye Daisy has an X while Flying Cowgirl is clean. The last round of the ladies' finals ends within 6 shots, but only two of those were Deadeye Daisy's while Flying Cowgirl flies out on top as The Ladies Western Territorial Champion.

Finally... our Men's Mag 7 Finals... Lined up in their seeding order, we have 1st Master Gunfighter, 2nd Marshall Reaper, 3rd Witlock, 4th Tank, 5th Oregon Cowboy, 6th Tin Bender, and 7th Dead Eye Kid. We start with Dead Eye Kid and Tin Bender on lanes 1 & 2. Dead Eye Kid gets the first shot on his target, but Tin Bender comes back with a faster 1,2,3 hits and wins the round. Next contender is 5th seed, Oregon Cowboy who moves Tin Bender to lane 1 but that doesn't matter to Tin Bender because he gets three hits out of four shots to win another bout. Now it's Tanks turn to try to push Tin Bender off his perch, but again Tin Bender hits three out of four shots and wins another bout. Over on 3 & 4 we have Oregon Cowboy and Dead Eye Kid shooting it out for 7th place. It goes 2/2 but its Oregon Cowboy who gets the final winning hit sending Dead Eye Kid off the line in 7th place. Now we have Witlock, our 3rd seed, to tend with Tin Bender. This time Tin Bender has lost his mojo and it goes in Witlocks favor 2/0. Tin Bender is ready to "GO" a little too soon and 'anticipation'

is called, automatically giving Witlock the winning hit and ends their round. On 3 & 4 we have Tank and Oregon Cowboy fighting it out for 6th place. This round goes 2/1 but Tank gets the third winning hit. With a handshake, Oregon Cowboy walks away in 6th place. Our 2nd seed, Marshal Reaper slowly walks up to the line and moves Witlock to lane 1. These men get the score to 1/2, but Marshal Reaper hits another .314 and wins the round. On 3 & 4, Tin Bender and Tank have 1/2 on the scoreboard but Tank gets the final winning shot, placing Tin Bender 5th. Master Gunfighter, our 1st seed,

takes lane 2 and bumps Marshal Reaper to lane 1. Master Gunfighter gets two hits on the target, but his opponent gets 3 faster hits and Marshal Reaper takes that round. Still over on 3 & 4 we have Witlock and Tank shooting it out to see who walks off the line in 4th place. Tank, just a bit anxious, moves his gun before the light giving himself a PV (procedural violation), and Witlock an automatic winning hit. Tank bounces back from his PV with a .323. These men bring the score 2/2 but its Witlock who hits a .326 to Tanks .340. That puts Tank in 4th place. Then there were three... and all three of these men are teammates, being from the same club in Southern California, The Deputies. Actually, Tank is also a member of the Deputies. Master Gunfighter and Witlock both have an X, so one of these men will walk away in 3rd place. Witlock gets the first two hits on his target, then they both hit, but it's Witlocks .326 that gets the win to Master Gunfighters .336. With a hug and handshake from Witlock, Master Gunfighter walks away in 3rd place. Now the final two are left. Marshall Reaper takes lane 4 giving Witlock 3. Witlock cranks out the first two hits .325, .323, then Marshall Reaper cranks out his two hits .301, .316, then Marshal Reaper shuts the door on his teammate with a .338. Bam!! Witlock 2nd and Marshall Reaper is your Western Territorial Champion.

The Finals concluded about 5:30pm. Leaving everyone enough time to head out and enjoy a nice meal in town and get a good night's rest! We went through about 10,000 rounds of ammo and still looking forward to a long weekend of shooting.

Two lucky ladies of CFDA were the gun winners!! Night Hawk did a random draw and pulled Cool Hand Suz' name for a CFDA Prize Gun for her Early Entry by April 1st (after investigation, she was actually the 1st lady to have her entry in, January 20th!!) and Philippines Red won the other CFDA Prize Gun from the Shoot for the Stars Gun Squares.

Frontier Bob's Stagecoach Shootout was a crowd favorite again this year!! There were 158 attempts at this challenge and only the Fastest

Man & Lady would earn a trophy. An honorable mention to our runner ups... Slow Poke .602 & Cowboy Up .524. Congratulations to our Champion Lady, Little J .570 & Champion Man, Midnight Mexican .443!!

I would like to give a huge Thank You to Still Shot, Bandana Kid and anyone who held the camera in the Potter Family. I dropped my phone Thursday morning and missed every opportunity to take pictures. They thought it was no big deal, but it meant the world to me. Thank you!

Holy smokes, I seriously cannot thank everyone enough for participating in The Club Basket Challenge for Shoot for the Stars!! I had so many baskets in the scoring room, Fowl Shot and Wild Shot almost kicked me and the baskets out! It was GREAT to have so much participation for our scholarship program for our college kids. I must give props to Holli Day for the idea. In her absence, while touring the world with her family, she gave me the idea, as she usually leads the SFTS for us. Thank you, Holli Day and every club who participated. We will carry on this challenge next year. Thanks to Jess, Shady Lady, Kansas Belle, and Boulders Babe for helping clear out the scoring room and setting the baskets up. Our winning club with the most votes by the shooters was The Sawtooth Shootist Society out of Boise Idaho. Curley Calhoun and his club went way out for this challenge. It had so much in it, it had its own inventory list! This basket sold for \$650 to Ol Buck'r who couldn't wait to get his hands on it. The live auction started, and things got a bit crazy. We had artwork, custom cornhole boards, a shotgun, knives, hat stands, a quilt, an old hat, a banner, but then out came a 1911 gold plated Colt named Beverly (named by the So Cal Gals the night before). This gun went to Curley Calhoun and Cool Hand Suz, who will give it a very special home, I'm sure. By the end of the night the silent and live

auction brought in \$13,925 – WOW and THANK YOU! While the band played on, people danced and dispersed up to the saloon and over to Range D where Old Drifter welcomed the poker players. Over two nights of poker, Old Drifter turned in \$670 to Shoot for the Stars. He Awarded Oregon Cowboy 1st & Midnight Mexican 2nd with special medallions. Thank you to Old Drifter and all the poker players out there!

Sunday morning, we had a mix of 56 shooters out of the main match and wanted to keep shooting. So, give the people what they want and let them shoot. KK Kid ran a Pot Shoot while the main match continued to whittle down to the Top 7 men and ladies. Awarding the Top 3, of the group; 1st Rango (NV), 2nd Deadeye Daisy (MI), & 3rd Gambler (ID).

By high noon, the pot shoot had ended and the Magnificent 7 were determined. So on to the finals we go! The little ladies go first, and in order of their seeding we have 1st Little J, 2nd Phoebe Ann, 3rd Baby Beast, 4th Miss Em, 5th Pickle, 6th Sweet Melody, and 7th Six Gun Shelbs. On lanes 1 & 2 we have Six Gun Shelbs and Sweet Melody. Six Gun Shelbs is hot with a 1,2,3 hits and she's ready for her next opponent. Out comes Pickle and she gets one hit on to Six Gun Shelbs four hits and Six Gun Shelbs takes that round. Miss Em comes out to shoot it out with her cousin, but Six Gun Shelbs is still hot! Miss Em gets one hit on but Six Gun Shelbs gets three winning hits and takes another round. Over on lanes 3 & 4 Sweet Melody and Pickle are shooting for 7th place. It's Pickle that gets three winning hits on and Sweet Melody takes 7th place. In my head I hear, 'Bring me another shooter' as Six Gun Shelbs welcomes her fourth opponent, Baby Beast. Six Gun Shelbs does it yet again, hitting four winning shots to Baby Beasts one. Pickle and Miss Em are shooting on lanes 3 & 4 for 6th place. Pickle wins that round 3/1 and Miss Em is 6th place. Phoebe Ann comes out to lane 2 while Six Gun Shelbs is hoping her winning streak doesn't fail her, but this time it goes 2/2 but it's Phoebe Ann who gets the winning hit. On 3 & 4 Baby Beast and Pickle also go 2/2 but it's Pickle



who wins that round and Baby Beast takes 5th place. Little J walks over to lane 1 and Phoebe Ann on 2. These young ladies

take the round 2/2 but Little J prevails. On 3 & 4 Six Gun Shelbs and Pickle are shooting for 4th place. They both get a hit on the plate, but Pickles gets 3 winning hits on and takes that round leaving Six Gun Shelbs in 4th place, coming all the way up from 7th seed, and shooting 6 rounds in the finals!! Pickle and Phoebe Ann are front and center and it goes 2/2. Pickle gets the final hit and Phoebe Ann is 3rd place. Little J comes over to lane 1 and Pickle on 2. They both are hitting but Little J is just too fast for Pickle to catch her, and Little J wins the round. Pickle went from 5th seed to 2nd place and shot 7 rounds! Your Annie Oakley US National Champion – Little J!

On to our Billy the Kid in order of their seeding, 1st Night Hawk, 2nd Dink, and 3rd Marshall Tucker. Marshall Tucker and Dink on lanes 1 & 2 shooting it out. Dink gets it tied up, 2/2 but Marshall



Tucker gets the final hit and wins the round. Out comes Night Hawk to try his luck with Marshall Tucker. Night Hawk on lane 1 and Marshall Tucker on 2. Night Hawk gets the first hit on the target, but Marshall Tucker comes back with three hits taking the round. Night Hawk Bounces over to lane 3 to shoot it out with Dink on lane 4. Dink gets two winning hits on, but Night Hawk comes back with two faster hits making the score 2/2. Dink hits his fifth shot in a row and Night Hawk misses. Dink wins that round. A handshake and a smile from Night Hawk as he flies out in 3rd place. Marshall Tucker walks back up to shoot against Dink. The round goes 1/1 but then Dink finishes it off with

two more winning hits. That means they swap lanes as they both have an X. Dink on lane 3 and Marshall Tucker on lane 4. Both come out hitting, but it's now 2/1 in favor of Dink. Dink gets the final winning hit on the target and Marshall Tucker takes 2nd place and Dink is the Billy the Kid US National Champion!

Now we have three Junior Girls in order of their seeding 1st Flying Cowgirl, 2nd Little Miss Sunshine, and 3rd Shell Shock. On lanes 1 & 2 Little Miss Sunshine

and Shell Shock take the stage. These young ladies make it a battle, 2/2 but it's Shell Shock who will move on to battle with Flying Cowgirl. On lanes 1 & 2, Flying Cowgirl and Shell Shock make it a short round due to a boot shot on lane 2, giving the round automatically to Flying Cowgirl. A boot shot is a safety violation, and not intentional, this sometimes happens when we try our hardest to speed up and Shell Shock was giving it her all. Shell Shock took a deep breath and hugged it out with Flying Cowgirl. That puts Flying Cowgirl in the cat bird seat while Shell Shock and Little Miss Sunshine go another round. Both young ladies had three hits, but Shell Shock overcame her previous round and got three winning hits, taking the round, while Little Miss Sunshine takes 3rd place. Front and center on 3 & 4, Flying Cowgirl and Shell Shock. Flying Cowgirl was waiting on GO with 1,2,3 hits. This places Shell Shock 2nd place and Flying Cowgirl is your Jr Girls US National Champion!

We only had one Junior Boy, Anytime Kid, who is automatically placed as our Jr Boy US National Champion. Anytime Kid placed 18th overall shooting with 89 other men in the main match and was the 18th fastest man overall. Great shooting Kid!

Now for the ladies, in their order of their seeding, 1st Lefty Lipscomb, 2nd QD Kate, 3rd Huckleberry Honey, 4th Gunpowder Puff, 5th Shady Lady, 6th Cali Red, and 7th Texas Rose. Texas Rose and Cali Red starts the show off on lanes 1 & 2, but after five shots and three hits apiece, Cali Red takes the round. Now it's Cali Red and Shady Lady on 1 & 2 and it's 2/2. Cali Red hits a .566 to Shady Lady's .614 and wins the round. Now we have Gunpowder Puff and Cali Red on lanes 1 & 2. Cali Red gets two hits on the target, then gives a point to Gunpowder Puff with a PV, anticipation call. Gunpowder Puff comes from behind and takes the round. On lanes 3 &4 we have Shady Lady and Texas Rose, it goes



2/2 but Texas Rose takes it, placing Shady Lady in 7th place. Huckleberry Honey and Gunpowder Puff now on 1 & 2. It goes 2/1 and then they both hit. Huckleberry Honey just a bit faster and wins the round. On 3 & 4 Texas Rose and Cali Red once again, but Texas Rose hits three out of four shots leaving Cali Red still looking for it. This places Cali Red in 6th place. Our 2nd seed, QD Kate comes and takes lane 1 from Huckleberry Honey. Both getting three hits, Huckleberry just a bit faster and she takes the win. On 3 & 4 we have Gunpowder Puff and Texas Rose who take the bout 1/2 but Texas Rose gets the final hit, placing Gunpowder Puff in 5th place. Out comes the 1st seed, Lefty Lipscomb. This bout goes 2/1 in favor of Huckleberry Honey, then Huckleberry Honey gets the final shot to win the bout. On 3 & 4 QD Kate and Texas Rose only take three shots and that's all Texas Rose needs for a 1,2,3 hit to win the round. That places QD Kate in 4th place. Now Lefty Lipscomb and Texas Rose are shooting for 3rd place. Texas Rose gets the first hit on the plate, but Lefty Lipscomb comes back with a mean 1,2,3 hits to take the round placing Texas Rose in 3rd place, all the way from 7th seed! Now Huckleberry Honey walks back to the line taking on Lefty Lipscomb once again. This time Lefty Lipscomb gets five hits on the plate to Huckleberry Honeys two to win the round. Now they swap and shoot it out again. This bout goes 1/1 but Lefty Lipscomb cuts all ties and hits two more winning hits. This places Huckleberry Honey in 2nd place and Lefty Lipscomb, the myth, the legend, the shooter with the most CFDA Titles of all time, takes her FIFTH US National Champion Title!!

Now for the men's Mag 7 in order of their seeding; 1st Marshall Reaper, 2nd Witlock, 3rd Tin Bender, 4th Crosswired, 5th Vic Torious, 6th Bad Burro, and 7th Buzzard Cooper. We start on lanes 1 & 2, Buzzard Cooper hits twice but Bad Burro is just faster and takes the win. Vic Torious comes out to challenge Bad Burro. Vic Torious hits four out of five but Bad Burro has three faster hits and takes the round agan. This time it's Crosswired who is challenging Bad Burro but Bad Burro left his mojo on lane 1 where Crosswired hits three in a row and

wins the round. On lanes 3 & 4 Vic Torious and Buzzard Cooper are trying to stay in the game, but its Vic Torious who get three winning hits on the plate and that leaves Buzzard Cooper in 7th place. Out walks our 3rd seed, Tin Bender to contend with Crosswired. Crosswired gets the first hit but Tin Bender comes back with three of his own to win the round. Still shooting on 3 & 4 is Vic Torious and Bad Burro. This time Bad Burro checks himself, finds his mojo and strikes three winning hits. That places Vic Torious in 6th. Now our 2nd seed walks to the line to challenge Tin Bender who's on 2. The bout goes 1/2 and Tin Bender gets another winning hit and takes the win. On lanes 3 & 4 Bad Burro and Crosswired go their final round together. This time it goes 2/2 and Crosswired gets the winning hit and Bad Burro leaves in 5th place. Our 1st seed walks out to lane 1 leaving Tin Bender on his winning lane, but that didn't matter. Both men hit three out of four shots but Marshall Reaper is just a bit faster and wins the round, putting himself in the cat bird seat. Over on lanes 3 & 4 Crosswired and Witlock go 1/2 but it's Witlock who has the faster hit and wins that bout. Crosswired walks away in 4th place. Tin Bender and Witlock now take the center stage to see who will leave in 3rd place and who will take on Marshall Reaper. This round goes 2/2, they both decide to hit, but its Witlocks .329 to Tin Benders .361 that takes the win and Tin Bender takes 3rd place. Now the last two men... Marshall Reaper comes back up to the line taking lane 3 and leaving Witlock on 4. This round goes 1/2 but then Marshall Reaper has a PV, (procedural violationanticipation) giving his opponent a winning hit and the win for that round. Now that gives them an X a piece. Whoever wins this next round will

out but two were missed. At this time, I would like to announce our US National Championship -Spirit of the Game awards. It just happens that this year we chose two couples. First, we have Boulder Vaquero and Boulders Babe. We had a total of 148 shooters, 13 states from coast to coast, high and low. From California to Florida and as high as Michigan down to Texas. 

Michigan State & the Great Lakes Territorial Hosted by the Great Lakes Gunslingers

A the 1st Ever Indiana State

Hosted by the Cross Road Gunfighter

fter 4 days of shooting in early May coupled with excellent weather, the Michigan State and Great Lakes Territorial successfully concluded. Beginning early on Thursday, May 4th, the first rounds of the Michigan State Championship went off without a hitch. After 8 rounds, the Mag 7 for the ladies was determined: (from 1st to 7th) Sierra Rose, Flying Cowgirl, Slowpoke, Lightnin, Tishminga, Dead Eye Daisy, and Wildfire. After 10 rounds for the men, the Mag 7 was: 1st seed Speedy James, Green River, Destry, AZ Cactus Kid, Buzzard Cooper, Quick Cal, and Guy With No Gun.

Friday, May 5th began with a bracket competition. After a short 2x Nevada 8 match, the winners were declared: Sheriff - BA; Deputy - Tishminga; Gunfighter - Deadeye Daisy; Master Gunfighter - Green River. After the bracket match the finals commenced. After many rounds of tough shooting, Sierra Rose was crowned the Ladies Michigan State Champion, with Flying

Cowgirl coming in second place and Lightnin in third. Sierra Rose's victory makes her the first two-handed shooter to win 2 titled championships, since Angel Lady did in the earlier history of CFDA, with her first being the Four Corners Territorial in 2022!

After the ladies finals it was time for the men to shoot it out. After many rounds of fast shooting, Green River was crowned the Men's Michigan State champion, with Quick Cal at second and Speedy James at third. Due skies and warm weather welcomed shooters to the 14th Annual Great Northwest Territorial Championship at the Crazy Woman Range in Caldwell, Idaho. First up on the agenda on Friday were the category matches. Our category winners were Quick Freeze (Billy the Kid); Silent Shot (Junior Boy); Emberly (Junior Girl); Crosswired (Men's Traditional); Annie B Good (Ladies Traditional); Boulder Vaquero (Men's 49'r); Debbie Sioux (Ladies 49'r); Desert Dingo (Men's Senior); Shady Lady (Ladies Senior); Half Fast Eddy (Men's Super Senior); Kansas Belle (Ladies Super Senior); Red Ryder (Men's Old Timers); Texas Rose (Ladies Grand Dame); The Texan (Men's Golden Gun); Buzzard Cooper (Elder Statesman); and Tin Bender (Men's Shootist).

Saturday morning the main match began with 92 registered shooters all vying to be crowned this year's champions. We welcomed back longdistance shooters who have not attended for a while (Boulder Vaguero and Boulder's Babe and Mongo and Wench) and first time GNTC shooters who traveled long distances from Texas (Gentleman George and Texas Rose) and Kansas (Kansas Belle and Shady Lady). The states of California, Colorado, Oregon, Nevada, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Washington and, of course, Idaho were all represented. After the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer, PG Taylor and Legally Loaded honored our Veterans who we are so privileged to share the sport of Cowboy Fast Draw with. PG Taylor then sent everyone on their way for the first round. With Wild Shot in the Schoolhouse running the scoring system, we were able to complete eight rounds for the men and work our way down to the Magnificent Seven Ladies.

Dinner was provided at the range on both Friday and Saturday evenings. Boulder's Babe oversaw rousing games of Left, Right, Center adding to the camaraderie shared by shooters and their families and friends.

Shooting began bright and early Sunday morning with the Blast for Cash bracket matches. Congratulations to our winners: Sandy (Deputy), Shadow Rider (Sheriff), Lefty Lipscomb (Gunfighter) and Tank (Master Gunfighter). The main match then resumed as we worked our way down to the Magnificent Seven for the men.

First up in the championship shoot offs were our Annie Oakley shooters Ruby Roundhouse, Fire Dancer and M-n-M, all from Idaho. Ruby Roundhouse is our Annie Oakley champion with Fire Dancer following in second and M-n-M taking third place. Next were the Billy the Kid shooters Quick Freeze, Sniper and Kid Choctaw, also all from Idaho. Quick Freeze is our Billy the Kid champion with Sniper following in second and Kid Choctaw in third.

Next were our Junior shooters with Silent Shot (ID) winning the championship and Quick Brush (OR) taking second in the Junior boys. Emberly (ID) won the Junior Girl championship with Chaos Cass (OR) following in second.

Next to take center stage were the Magnificent Seven Ladies with Dancing Fish (ID) seeded first, Debbie Sioux (UT) second, Lefty Lipscomb (ID) third, Annie B Good (ID) fourth, Honey Bucket (CA) fifth; SlowPoke (UT) sixth; and Shady Lady (KS) seventh. After some fine shooting, Shady Lady placed seventh, SlowPoke sixth, Lefty Lipscomb fifth, Honey Bucket fourth and Annie B Good third, leaving Debbie Sioux and Dancing Fish shooting for the championship. Debbie Sioux prevailed and is our 2023 GNTC Ladies Champion with Dancing Fish taking second.

The Magnificent Seven Men were introduced next with Half Fast Eddy (ID) seeded seventh, Gambit (ID) sixth, Desert Dingo (UT) fifth, Bounty Hunter (ID) fourth, Boulder Vaquero (SD) third, Buzzard Cooper (ID) second and Tin Bender (ID) first. Gambit placed seventh with Half Fast Eddy coming in sixth place. Desert Dingo then proceeded to work his way from fifth seed to shoot it out for the championship with Tin Bender, leaving Buzzard Cooper in third place, Boulder Vaquero in fourth and Bounty Hunter in fifth. It was a very entertaining shoot off with Desert Dingo winning his first ever titled competition leaving Tin Bender in a very respectable second place.

Our Resident Champions are Tin Bender and Dancing Fish. The Top Couple Award was a tie between Debbie Sioux and The Bucknay Kid and Annie B Good and Half Fast Eddy. The Fastest Time awards went to Lacy Gone Wild for the ladies (.447) and Tank for the men (.359). Trinidad was the winner of the gun raffle. First out of the match award went to Gunpowder Puff.

Legally Loaded presented the Spirit of the Game award to PG Taylor. PG Taylor then presented it to Etta Mae who, although not a competitor, is always there to offer help and assistance in any way possible. PG Taylor also presented a special award to Legally Loaded for her years of service with GNTC.

One of Summer's favorite foods is strawberries. It's such a versatile fruit to work with making sweet or savory dishes with it. One of our favorite sweet desserts is the "drum roll please".........

Strawberry Mousse Pie! Super easy and it the best finish to a yummy summertime dinner! If you're one of the very few who has never made this dessert- well here's the easy version, & delicious! Enjoy!

Easy Summertime Strawberry Mousse Pie

1 6oz carton of strawberry yogurt

1 pack of strawberry gelatin (Jell-O)-4 serving size

2- extra ripe bananas -small to med size

1 cup boiling water

2 ½ cups of whipped topping

1 cup strawberries – frozen ones are great to use- sliced- thawed slightly.

1 9" prepared pie crust- frozen type work great (Needs to be slightly baked if raw)

Putting it together:

Take the boiling water and stir into the gelatin, stirring until the gelatin is completely dissolved. Place it in your freezer for about 20 minutes or until slightly thickened, stirring a few times.

Blend or use a food processor to "mush" the bananas until completely smooth. Should be about one cup. Then combine yogurt and banana in a large bowl. Next combine the gelatin into the banana mixture. Put in fridge until again, slightly thickened. Next gently fold the whipped topping and strawberries into mixture.

Spoon into your prepared pie crust and chill in fridge for at least 4-5 hours until firm. Extra whipped topping when served and a slice of strawberry on top and you'll be the hit of the show!

We've all had the pleasure to watch both Tank and Rango develop for over a decade, both winning Junior World Championships and multiple Overall CFDA Titled Championships along the way. So, it came down to a re-match between Rango and Tank as it did earlier that morning in the Master Gunfighter Shootoff, where Rango came out on top. These young men didn't disappoint as they traded sub-35 shots back and forth with mere thousandths between them! But this time, Tank took the Overall Championship!





Cowboy Fast Draw Association holds a Federal Firearms License (FFL). We only ship (usually USPS) and transfer firearms to other FFL Dealers, which costs \$35 per gun. It is up to the purchaser to choose their FFL Dealer and supply contact information when they order their firearm. CFDA will contact the FFL Dealer to obtain necessary documnts. After receiving payment we will then ship the firearm to your FFL Dealer, who will then be responsible to have you fill out the appropriate forms and conduct a background check, according to Federal and your State Laws and Regulations. Please allow up to 2 weeks for CFDA to prepare your firearm for shipping.

The buyer is responsible to pay all transfer fees, background checks directly to their FFL Dealer of choice.

All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned to CFDA only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. A refund of the sale will be made, minus the original \$35 shipping fee and a 5% re-login/re-stocking fee. Available in the CFDA General Store or Call CFDA Main Office at 775-575-1802

THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

Ammunition

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center) 24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center) Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Westernstyle blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to <u>educate as many people as</u> <u>possible in the safe and proper use of firearms.</u> Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.


