

We take a short time to relax a little as we turn our attention on publishing the Gunslinger's Gazette you're currently reading and administrating our affiliated club renewal season. I'm writing this column on Thanksgiving weekend as Hannah Calder is putting her finishing touches on the layout, she does such a wonderful job! Plus, I know it's time to get this last one-page column done when she begins mentioning something about photos she could publish... 3

### FGA 2023

I could write many pages about so many things that happened at this year's FGA, for that there are several pages in the article appearing later in this Gazette, but even those are truly not enough. Thank You to everyone who played a part in CFDA's Signature Event, and for those who couldn't be there, we missed not sharing it with you.

### CFDA Social Media (Facebook & Website)

Facebook- Most of our active and traveling members follow our Cowboy Fast Draw Society - Facebook Discussion Group. A number of members have told me, "I just don't do Facebook". That's fine, I get that, Facebook can consume your time if you allow it to, but if you learn to use Facebook, it can become a very powerful up to the minute communication tool for our sport. If you use it for nothing else except than keeping yourself informed, you'll be glad you did, and it costs nothing. If you depend on the Gunslinger's Gazette or the CFDA Website for all of your information, there is a lot there, but it's just not updated enough for truly active members. Plus, if you need an answer for a question you might have, just post it on the Cowboy Fast Draw Society and it will usually be answered in just a few hours or even minutes by our CFDA member community.

CFDA also has a main Facebook Page where information threads can only be initiated by our administrators, but it does have a lot of followers and a larger audience.

CFDA Website- What's going on with our website? Mid-Summer our website provider informed us that the platform that our website was built upon was no longer being supported and due to now uncontrollable security would be deactivated within several months. The new website is built on a newer Word Press platform, which we had already converted our General Store Shopping Cart to a few years ago. We thought we had until after FGA to deal with this conversion, but we got a call late in the week before FGA, telling us it had to happen right then! Since ours is not a simple website and is jam packed full of many layers of information. We suddenly discovered

hundreds of links not working and the information that was ported over was 5 months outdated. Hannah Calder who is our internal manager of our website had made hundreds of updates since May which reverted to outdated information. Plus, now she had to learn how to operate an entirely new back office.

The good news is we are making progress. By the time this article is published we hope to make it more smart-phone friendly, get the sound back on the main page video, and get all information updated. We think in the long run it'll be better than what we had, especially after we all get acquainted with it and learn how to use it. FGA 2024 (Change in Dates)

In the weeks leading up to our recent FGA, if you weren't following Cowboy Fast Draw Society you probably missed a major change in our sport. In mid-September, it became necessary to move FGA out our traditional early October dates. The 3C Arena is in big demand, especially for rodeo events after the midsummer heat is over. After a meeting with 3C Arena Staff, it became obvious that we simply could not be guaranteed consistent dates for FGA during the fall months. We had a discussion at CFDA Headquarters and also had to coordinate these discussions with the City of Fallon and Churchill County Fairgrounds. Then we initially announced on Cowboy Fast Draw Society - Facebook Discussion Group that we were moving the 2024 FGA to the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend in August. While this decision was based on several factors, one of the main goals was to try to attract more Youth Shooters during traditional school summer vacations. We then received a number of comments, some in support and some not for various reasons. However, one subject did move us to reconsider and make an adjustment.

We as an organization have raised and dedicated over \$200k through our CFDA Shoot For the Stars Scholarship Foundation, to fund College and Trade Schools for our young members. Since most colleges now start in early August and attendance is extremely important, especially during the first few weeks, early August was simply not acceptable.

Mark your calendars, FGA will take place July 24th - 28th, 2024! Stay tuned for more information. I will also add, if we are not successful in attracting youth and college-aged shooters, we may reconsider a minor adjustment to the dates for 2025, possibly to the first weekend in August. This will be announced at the 2024 FGA.

### CFDA - Top Gun of the Year Points

### The 2024 Top Gun Season begins with Florida State in early February and will end with the 2024 FGA. The 2025 Top Gun Season will begin with the Louisiana State August 2-4th and will end with the 2025 FGA.

We've had a few inquiries regarding reducing from counting the best 6 tournament points again to 5, like we did during the 2020 pandemic season. Since 80% of our scheduled titled championships occur before the 2024 FGA, there are plenty of opportunities for our Top Gun contenders from all over the nation to attend more than enough tournaments. On behalf of our clubs, we want to support attendance at our tournaments. We are staying with our standard system of the best 6.

It is our hope that since FGA is now in late July,

that we may see a lot more CFDA Titled Championships in the Fall months. For years, due to weather concerns, we have squeezed too many contests between March and June, now we may see them spread out dates more evenly, especially in the warmer states.

### All Shooters Are Responsible to Learn & Follow **CFDA Rules**

I had a phone conversation a few weeks ago with an approved CFDA Range Master. He wanted to confirm that the call he made was correct. I'll spare the details, but it involved a Technical Violation, for which the shooter was penalized a Round DQ. I asked the RM to open his copy of the Gunslinger's Rulebook and turn to Pages 23 & 24, where we found the actual violation that he described. I then asked him to refer to the black penalty section on Page 23, where he discovered that the shooter should have received a "Verbal Warning" rather than a Round DQ. He felt terrible and immediately wanted to call the shooter to apologize for his mistake and find a way to make it right.

The above paragraph resulted in a very interesting discussion that I wish to share with You...

Cowboy Fast Draw is based upon both a fun and fair game wherein our rules must be both followed and enforced by "We the Shooters". Please turn to Page 10 and read the 5 bullet points under section "II. Competition Rules & Spirit of the Game.", plus the top half of Page 11. These sections mean that by being a member of CFDA we have all agreed to learn the rules of our game and play by them! We depend on our members to step up and become Match Directors, Range Masters, Announcers, Hand Judges, Line Judges, and Scorers as needed. We provide basic training for all of these positions in our CFDA Range Officer Course, which every club should make sure they teach at least once a year, which can be instructed by any Range Master. We also provide a more advanced class for Range Masters, which can only be taught by Regulators or Approved Instructors. But no such classes, in the time we can allocate for them, can begin to provide all the training we need. The remaining training must rely on experience. In other words, we cannot expect all calls and penalties to be perfect, we are part-time officials and do this for each other out of the love of our game. But, think about it, even professional officials in the NFL, MLB, NBA, etc. are not perfect, are they?

We also have "A Shooter's Right" built into our self-regulating game that the other above major sports do not. Please turn to Page 21. Arbitration Committee. Every shooter should read and understand this important aspect of our game. If any shooter feels that they want to appeal a decision of any official, they can. This "right" changes everything! It puts the responsibility back upon the shooter who has agreed to read and understand our CFDA Rules. If they fail to know the rules and do not implement their "Right" provided within our rules, then any claim made by them, that they were not treated fairly, should not be taken seriously. Other than the fact, that all Shooters and Officials can learn from these experiences.

# 2023 FASTEST GUN ALIVE OF COWBOY FAST DRAW

Dead Eye Daisy Wins Her 2<sup>nd</sup> Consecutive World Championship Title and Oregon Ranger Ups His Record Number of World Championship Titles to 7!

**Fallon, Nevada-** In 2022 CFDA Hosted our first FGA inside the Fabulous 3C Arena! It was called the

greatest event in Fast Draw History by some of our members that dated back to the 1950's and 60's! Many asked, "How could we ever outdo the 2022 FGA?" Well, CFDA Staff had a number of discussions based upon not only what we learned from shooting in our new venue, but to also consider the many comments we heard from our members. The result? **The 2023 FGA was even better!** 

So how did we make FGA better?, you ask..... With almost 300 Shooters! We added a sixth 6 Lane Range and repositioned the layout to not only accommodate the two new ranges, but also created enough space to have two separate Lane Assignment and Match Standing Posting Boards. We also created two separate Shooters Areas with adjoining Dry Fire Areas and plenty of Cleaning Tables scattered about. The result was a more efficiently run match that allowed more time after each day's shooting to get ready, go out for dinner, and return to the 3C Arena for our evening events.

Between a number of shooting and evening activities there seemed to be non-stop fun for 5 days. Our goal is to produce a FGA Week that is as much a "Cowboy Fast Draw Convention" as it is a championship shooting competition.

### **Arriving At FGA**

Upon arriving to Fallon, our FGA Host City, our shooters experienced a community that welcomes our event. From welcome banners hung over highways to businesses who are glad



to see us, it's no secret why Fallon has been FGA's Host City since 2008! What I personally admit I enjoy most, is seeing the expression of excitement and awe on the faces of our members as they walk beneath our welcome banner hanging over the main entrance of the 3C Arena, walk through the front doors and take it all in. This vast 75,000 sq/ft facility is jam packed with vendors and an area for our evening events on the upper pavilion. Then, as they approach the main arena they walk to the railing that overlooks all six Cowboy Fast Draw 6-Lane Ranges set up ready to go! To those of us who love our game, it's nothing less than the Madison Square Gardens of Cowboy Fast Draw! <u>Tuesday</u>

For the second year, 2021 World Champion *Rodeo Romeo*, started the day off with the first of the six classes of his Cowboy Fast Draw Shooting School that are conducted on both Tuesday and Wednesday. He pledged all of the proceeds from his classes to the CFDA Shoot for the Stars Scholarship Foundation.

Windmill Kid & Miss Betty teamed up to teach a complete Range Officer Course in the morning, Miss Betty then taught a CFDA Scoring Program Class after lunch. Followed by Windmill Kid conducting a Range Master Course on one of the ranges.

#### Wednesday

We began with our Annual Marshal's Cup competition that is only open to actual U.S. Marshals who are representing their clubs at that afternoon's U.S. Marshal's Muster and CFDA

Regulators. CFDA Sponsors this as a team building event for the leaders of our sport. Congratulations to *Short Keg*!

At 12:30 we began our Annual U.S. Marshal's Muster where our representatives from clubs across our sport join a Round Table Discussion with CFDA Management regarding important agenda items.

**Dead Eye Kid** conducted his Caring for Your Six-Gun Seminar where shooters can learn many things about how their six-guns operate and how to care for them properly.

At 5:00 p.m. the Long Branch Saloon opened as we hosted

a welcome event called our "Gathering of Gunfighters". This is the first event where our team of volunteer bartenders, *Ranger Reeves, Philippines Red, Turd Hurder, Honey Bucket, Perk, BA, and Slowpoke*, begin to entertain us all with their spirited approach to having fun and showing off their bartending skills.

*Old Drifter* held his annual Shoot for the Stars Texas Hold'em Tournament raising \$1,000!

### Thursday

**Tournament of Champions-** At 3:00 we began a 2-X Match for our 2023 Titled & Resident Champions. It took about two hours to reach our Top 5 Men & Top 5 Ladies, for the Finals to take place on Saturday.

This year was no exception and through the generosity of our members we raised thousands of dollars to help our younger CFDA members seek higher education through either colleges or trade schools. Gunfighter's Ball- After the auction we all get ready for some great music and fun with our friends. This year again we were pleased to book a return performance by Jakata Wass, this really cool band was a "Hit" with our members both last year and this year!

### Saturday

**Main Match Continues-** We began with Round 8 using all of our ranges. Then condensed the main match to Ranges A - C and continued until we reached our Magnificent 7 Men & Ladies, we achieved just after noon.

**Second Chance Match-** The main match loses over half of our shooters by the end of Round 8 and since we don't like to leave anyone sitting around FGA with nothing to do. We open the 3 available ranges for our Second Chance Match that we had also installed 11' firing lines upon, 11' is a published exhibition distance for 17" targets in our CFDA Guidelines, which is similar to the 15' distance on the 24" plates. We just wanted everyone to have a fun day!

Saturday Top 5 Shootoffs- We began with our Main Match Sub-Category World Champion Shootoffs (Juniors & Shootists) with our grand finale being our Tournament of Champions - Top 5 Finals. Please see results elsewhere, but here's some highlights.

Junior Girls- Top Seed, Little Miss Sunshine, the defending Junior Girl World Champion, lost to Flying Cowgirl and Shell Shock to settle for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. Flying Cowgirl faced off with Shell Shock in the Finals shooting nothing but 3's, Flying Cowgirl won her second World Junior

Girl Championship.

**Junior Boys-** All four of our Junior Boys could shoot in the 3's, they were pushing maximum speed for every shot, out of a combined 62 shots fired there were only 19 hits (31%). *Silent Shot* was the last one standing and won his first Junior Boys World Championship.

Ladies Shootist- Lady Hawk moved up and defeated 2<sup>nd</sup> Seed K.K. Kid, and then won the Catbird Seat from Madam Clerk. Meanwhile K.K. Kid recovered and went on a run winning 3 rounds in a row to set up the final round rematch with Lady Hawk. K.K. Kid went on to win the Ladies Shootist World Championship with shots in the mid 4's!

Men's Shootist- Syxkiller started out with an incredible run hitting 9 out of 12 shots at a .379 average, with his fastest being a .339! Tin Bender ended Syxkiller's initial run taking it to a 2-2 tie and winning the last shot with a .369 against Syxkiller's .386. Syxkiller wasn't done yet, defeating Gambler to get into a rematch for the final rounds against Tin Bender, which went to another 2-2 bout with Syxkiller winning with a .357 against Tin Bender's .371, forcing a switch of lanes for the final bout. The Shootist Championship went to Tin Bender hitting 3 out of 4 at a .370 average. In my opinion, those of us that were there witnessed the best the Shootist Long Gun Shooting ever to take place in a championship shoot-off!

### **Tournament of Champions**

Ladies- Our Top 5 Ladies were Honey Bucket, Prairie Rose, Ricochet Rose, K.K. Kid, and Dead Eye Daisy. K.K. Kid took the lead shooting mid-4's with her long-gun hitting 6 shots in a row, but when she came to Dead Eye Daisy, Dead Eye Daisy hit 3 in a row just a little faster, securing the Catbird Seat. Meanwhile, Ricochet

Rose was dominating the 1-X Bracket on Lanes 3 & 4 defeating K.K. Kid to move into the final round. Dead Eye Daisy and Ricochet Rose took it to a 2-2 tie, with Dead Eve Daisy persevering to win the Ladies Tournament of Champions, for her 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row!

Men- Our Top 5 Men were Rango, Arizona Cactus Kid, Tank, Marshall Reaper, with the Top Seed being Witlock. Every one of these gunfighters were sub-35 shooters! Arizona Cactus Kid took out Rango, Tank took out both Arizona Cactus Kid & Witlock. It ended up Tank with 1-X versus the undefeated Marshall Reaper in the championship round(s). Tank struck first, wining the round to force Marshall Reaper to switch lanes for a final round. Marshall Reaper jumped to a 2-1 lead, but Tank countered it to a tie and then firing a .330 won the Men's Tournament of Championship, also his 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row!

Gunslinger Jon emerged from the initial bouts to retain his seeded position and finished 4<sup>th</sup> Place Overall with Six Gun Shelbs finishing 5<sup>th</sup>; Little J 6<sup>th</sup>; and Nigh Hawk 7<sup>th</sup>, Phoebe

Ann also retained her position to finish in 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.

The final bout came down to our Top Seed, **Baby Beast**, taking on **Ry-Dog Jones**. Both were shooting very close times mainly in the 5's with **Ry-Dog Jones** hitting 4 shots in a row, making the match tied 2-2, then the final shot won **Baby Beast** the Youth Overall World Championship with a .540!

Ladies-Ladies Magnificent 7 Finalists... Top Seed–Lefty Lipscomb (ID); 2<sup>nd</sup>–Little Miss Sunshine (NV); 3<sup>rd</sup>–Shady Lady (KS); 4<sup>th</sup>– Madam Clerk (ID); 5<sup>th</sup>–Dead Eye Daisy (MI); 6<sup>th</sup>–K.K. Kid (TX); 7<sup>th</sup>–Kiss-n-Tell (CA).

K.K. Kid won the first round with Kiss-n-Tell, then 5<sup>th</sup> Seed FGA Defending Champ, Dead Eye Daisy, came to line and went on an amazing run defeating K.K. Kid, Madam Clerk, Shady Lady and Lefty Lipscomb all the way to the Cat Bird Seat and her place in the final round!

*Lefty Lipscomb* won the final bout in the 1-X Bracket to earn her spot in the final round. *Shady Lady* finished 3<sup>rd</sup>; *Little Miss Sunshine* 4<sup>th</sup>: *Kiss-n-Tell* 5<sup>th</sup>; *Madam Clerk* 6<sup>th</sup>, and *K.K. Kid* 7<sup>th</sup>.

In the final round, against *Lefty Lipscomb*, *Dead Eye Daisy* hit 3 shots in a row averaging .425 to defend and win her 2<sup>nd</sup> Ladies FGA – World Championship in a row! Only the 2<sup>nd</sup> Lady in CFDA history to win back-to-back FGAs!

**Special Note:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Seed, *Little Miss Sunshine*, had to make the difficult decision of withdrawing from the finals. Her high school golf team made the state finals in Mesquite, NV just a few weeks before FGA. She wanted a chance to repeat her Junior World Championship which took place Saturday, she shot the match not expecting to make the Top 7 Shootoff. Her coach insisted that team spirit required riding the bus together on Sunday, so she could play her prelimenary round on Monday. She decided not to let her team down to pursue a personal accomplishment. CFDA rules provided that she forfeited the two rounds when called, which automatically placed her 4<sup>th</sup>. By the way, her golf scores contributed to her team to

un place as the Top Team of Northern Nevada!

Men- Men's Magnificent 7 Finalists... Top Seed-Arizona Cactus Kid (AZ); 2<sup>nd</sup>-Tank (ID); 3<sup>rd</sup>-Perk (TX); 4<sup>th</sup>-Cowboy Up (CA); 5<sup>th</sup>-Oregon Ranger (OR); 6<sup>th</sup>-Tin Bender (ID); 7<sup>th</sup>-Rodeo Romeo.

Tin Bender & Rodeo Romeo took it to a 2-2 tie, with Tin Bender winning the round. Then, Oregon Ranger came to challenge and nailed three hits in a row at a .328 average, sending Tin Bender to the 1-X Bracket! Next, Cowboy Up came up hot and deadly putting Oregon Ranger into the 1-X Bracket. While Rodeo Romeo kept his hopes alive in the rematch to win his second FGA, by out shooting Tin Bender who took 7<sup>th</sup> Place. Note: Tin Bender shot his long-gun as a Shootist

throughout this entire tournament and season!

Now it was *Perk's* turn to take on *Cowboy Up*, but *Cowboy Up* kept right on rolling to win the round. While over on Lanes 3&4 in the 1-X Bracket all eyes were on two past FGA World Champions, *6-time champ Oregon Ranger & 2021 champ Rodeo Romeo, Oregon Ranger's* game got hot hitting 3 out of 4 averaging .317, placing *Rodeo Romeo* in 6<sup>th</sup>!

Next it was *Tank's* turn to face *Cowboy Up*, *Tank* won the first shot by just one thousandth of a second with a .345 and hit two more even faster, moving *Cowboy Up* over to Lanes 3&4. While *Oregon Ranger* was continuing his run with hits in the low 3's, *Perk* ended in 5th.

Finally, it was our Top Seed Arizona Cactus Kid, who was clean the entire match with incredibly fast and accurate mid-3 shooting, to take on Tank. They took it to a 2-2 tie, Tank won the last shot and a spot in the finals in the coveted Catbird Seat. Over in the 1-X Bracket Cowboy Up hit 3 in a row at a .360 average, but Oregon Ranger still hot nailed 3 out of 4 at a .325 average, Cowboy Up took 4<sup>th</sup>! Oregon Ranger then went to Lane 3 to take on Arizona Cactus Kid on Lane 4, the winner would earn a spot against Tank in the final round. Oregon Ranger still on target and fast hitting 3 out of 4 in the low 3's, Arizona Cactus Kid end in 3<sup>rd</sup> Place!

It was down to *Tank vs Oregon Ranger*, two of the fastest shooters in our game! *Oregon Ranger* still hot, jumped out to a 2-0 lead, but then missed 4 in a row! *Tank* is one of the few that can make *Oregon Ranger* push and he evened the bout 2-2, just before *Oregon Ranger* won the bout with a .328, giving *Tank* his 1<sup>st</sup> X! The two shooters switched lanes for a final round since they both now had an X! The crowd was cheering and stomping the bleachers, as the *Shooting USA* cameras turned to catch the excitement of the spectators, which they have told us they've never seen in any other shooting sport! We were about to witness one of the most amazing final rounds in FGA history!!!

Tank nailed his Lane 1 Target with a .322, but Oregon Ranger's light was blinking with a .319! Next shot, Tank evened the score with a .314 against Oregon Ranger's .327! Oregon Ranger wins the next shot on Lane 2 with a .323 to *Tank's* .339, for a 1-2 lead! Then, the next shot is fired and the crowd goes wild as *Tank's* light comes back on blinking with the timer showing a time faster than *Oregon Ranger's* .328, **but wait!** *Tank* raises his hand as he takes a deep breath and lets it out, he just noticed the pole hit just under his target and calls it a miss! *Oregon Ranger wins his* 7<sup>th</sup> FGA!!!!

<u>Director's Note:</u> After being involved in shooting sports for over 55 years, I have never witnessed a more exciting final round than this one! I also believe this was the fastest Magnificent 7 Finals in CFDA history! We will post all 3 of our Magnificent 7 Final score sheets on the CFDA Website.

The day started with Curley Calhoun welcoming competitors to the Mountain Air Range. Friday's schedule kicked off with the Show Me the Money Jackpot Shoot. This competition went pretty quickly with Honey Bucket and Tin Bender taking first place, Huckleberry Honey and Crosswired second, Lefty Lipscomb and Old Drifter third, Chrysanthemum and Turd Herder fourth, and Lady Hawk and Silent Shot taking fifth place.

Next up on the agenda was the Quick and the Dead competition and, as the name implies, it was pretty quick! Our champion is Sandpoint Slim with Buckshot Luther following in second and Half Fast Eddy in third. This competition raised \$520 with 50% going to the Sawtooth Shootist Society's chosen charity, the Happy Trails Foundation, and the rest split 50/30/20 with the top three competitors.

But wait, Friday's fun was not yet done! Throughout the day, shooters signed up for the Hit It competition by naming their Hit It time. This competition was a fundraiser for Shoot for the Stars, specifically benefiting Sawtooth Sweetie, the first Sawtooth Shootist Society Shoot for the Stars recipient (wow, that's a lot of Ss!) and raised \$570.

After a great day of shooting fun and camaraderie, shooters and their family and friends made their way to the Mountain Air Barn for the Friday evening dinner which was hosted by the Sawtooth Shootist Society club members. A great big thanks to Philippines Red of the Great Basin Gun Hawks who brought her delicious Lumpia (Filipino spring roll) to contribute to the dinner. Day One was in the books.

The Idaho State Championship began Saturday morning with the presentation of Top Hand awards to Gambit and Drifter for their help and contributions as club members throughout the year. Curley then presented the Spirit of the Game award to Red Lead Slinger. Red travels to many CFDA competitions and is a great ambassador for the Sawtooth Shootist Society and the State of Idaho. After the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer, it was time to start sending wax downrange. Once again this year, competitors had the opportunity to win Cool Cash. This is a challenge from Curley Calhoun and Cool Hand Suz. If a shooter puts three winning hits in a row on the target in the first four rounds starting from the first command light, they automatically earn a share of the Cool Cash pot. This year's 15 shooters who earned a share of the pot were Honey Bucket, Ricochet Rose, Skinner, Old Drifter, Gambler, Inveterate Thorn, Butch Cassidy, Gambit, Midnight Rose, Shadow, Tin Bender. Shadow Rider, Buckshot Luther, Red Ryder and Deacon Dan, all winning \$30 each.

At the end of the day's shooting, we had established the Magnificent Seven for both the men and ladies. Curley then recognized the Cool Cash winners as well as Friday's contest winners. Did someone say dinner? Yup, Grubbin' BBG once again set out an all you can eat feast for our shooters, family and friends. Brisket, chicken, sausage, salad, their special recipe corn and a yummy cornbread., all topped off with cheesecake for dessert.

> This year Ms Hettie donated several commemorative tumblers for purchase. Each tumbler contained a raffle ticket for a chance to win a free entry to the 2024 Idaho State Championship and Dangerous Dave was the lucky winner. We drew for door prizes and then moved on to the live auction for several items including a Colt Walker black powder pistol and a beautiful denim quilt made by Chrysanthemum. This quilt was pretty special as she embroidered the names of the clubs that were represented at the 2022 championship. Many thanks to all who donated items for both the live and silent auctions and to those who opened their wallets to purchase items. Old Drifter soon had his





poker tables up and running, raising a total of \$610 for Shoot for the Stars. At the request of some of our attendees, Curley presented his "Call of the Wild" which is always entertaining. Day Two was officially in the books.

Shooting began bright and early Sunday morning for the Bracket Matches, only it wasn't too bright outside. Yup, our luck had run out on the pleasant weather we had enjoyed for two days. The raindrops began to fall midway through the first round and those raindrops soon turned into a full-on raining cats and dogs deluge putting a complete halt to shooting. While we huddled under pop ups and the big tent, Curley entertained us by demonstrating his fly fishing casting skills in the rain. Since the rain showed no signs of letting up, the decision was made to move the competition into the barn doing one bracket at a time since there were only four targets. Finally, the rain stopped and we were able to get Range B back up and running and with everyone being on their toes helping range master, score, announce and hand judge, we were able to wrap up the Bracket Matches. The top three in each bracket are as follows: Master Gunfighter ~  $1^{st}$  – Crosswired,  $2^{nd}$  - Tank,  $3^{rd}$  – Old Drifter. Gunfighter ~  $1^{st}$  – Turd Herder,  $2^{nd}$  – JD,  $3^{rd}$  - Ricochet Rose. Sheriff ~  $1^{st}$  – Dead Eye Dixie;  $2^{nd}$  – Red Lead Slinger,  $3^{rd}$  – Smokin Joe. Deputy ~  $1^{st}$  – Chaos Cass,  $2^{nd}$  – Nighthawk,  $3^{rd}$  – Butch Cassidy.

Throwing caution to the wind and saying a little prayer that the rain would hold off, Range A was prepared for the championship rounds. First up were our youth shooters Sniper from Idaho (seeded first), Nighthawk from California (second), Sweet Melody from California (third) and Ruby Roundhouse from Idaho (fourth). The youth shooters are always entertaining to watch and cheer for. Sweet Melody went home with the fourth-place prize with Nighthawk taking third leaving Sniper and Ruby Roundhouse to shoot for the championship. Sniper prevailed and is the 2023 Idaho State Youth Champion with Ruby Roundhouse placing second.

Our Magnificent Seven ladies were next to take center stage. Ricochet Rose (CA) was seeded seventh, Texas Tornado (TX) sixth, Emberly (ID) fifth, Huckleberry Honey (CA) fourth, Midnight Rose (OR) third, Gunpowder Puff (CA), second and Lefty Lipscomb (ID) first. After some fine shooting, Texas Tornado took seventh place with Ricochet Rose following in sixth place. Midnight Rose took home the fifth place award with Gunpowder Puff placing fourth and Emberly third. This left Huckleberry Honey and Lefty Lipscomb to shoot for the championship. It's always entertaining to watch these two ladies compete against one another because, well, they have done this more than a few times! In the end, Huckleberry Honey claimed the 2023 Idaho State Ladies Championship. Congratulations to Lefty Lipscomb on her second place finish.

Next up were the Magnificent Seven men with Gambit (ID) seeded seventh, Butch Cassidy (NV) sixth, Quick Cal (NV) fifth, Tin Bender (ID) fourth, Dangerous Dave (ID) third, Tank (ID) second and Crosswired (OR) first. During the men's finals, we began to have some equipment issues from all the moisture we received that day, so the decision was made to move inside to finish. Once again, after some fine shooting, Gambit went home with the seventh place prize with Butch Cassidy following in sixth place, Dangerous Dave in fifth, Tin Bender in fourth and Quick Cal in third leaving Tank and Crosswired to shoot for the championship. Did I mention there were a lot of two to twos in the championship rounds? And that's what it came down to with Crosswired and Tank being tied at two to two. Crosswired put the third winning shot on the target, having accomplished shooting the Idaho State Championship clean! Congratulations to Tank for taking second place and to Crosswired for winning his first ever titled championship.

Our Resident Champions are Tank and Lefty Lipscomb. Our Top Couple(s) are Gunpowder Puff and Red Ryder, Dead Eye Dixie and Gambit and Madam Clerk and Tin Bender, a three-way tie! The Top Shootist awards went to Madam Clerk and Tin Bender. Fastest time awards were claimed by Huckleberry Honey (.390) and Tank (.339). Our Top Juniors are Emberly and Silent Shot. A total of \$5,596 was raised for our fundraisers with \$3,311 of the amount raised donated to Shoot for the Stars.

Even with the extended rain delay and moving ranges three times, we were able to conclude shooting and awards by about 3:30 p.m. This reflects on all the competitors who helped keep things moving along throughout the day despite the weather.

Thank you to all our sponsors and supporters of the 2023 Idaho State Championship. A big thank you to the Bolton Bros from Bolton Brother's Kitchen who provided breakfast and lunch items throughout the three days of competition. And last, but not least, thank you to the Sawtooth Shootist Society club members and especially all the shooters who made this year's championship a huge success. We look forward to welcoming you back next August 30-September 1 for the 2024 Idaho State Championship!







Please allow up to 2 weeks for CFDA to prepare your firearm for shipping.

The buyer is responsible to pay all transfer fees, background checks directly to their FFL Dealer of choice.

All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned to CFDA only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. A refund of the sale will be made, minus the original \$35 shipping fee and a 5% re-login/re-stocking fee. Available in the CFDA General Store or Call CFDA Main Office at 775-575-1802

### THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

### THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

### AMMUNITION

34

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

### TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center) 24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center) Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

### **COMPETITION TIMERS**

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

### SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

### CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Westernstyle blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.
