- 2. Per our agreement with the Prineville Police Department, Prineville Ordinances, and the Crook County Fairgrounds there will be *NO ALCOHOL* at the Pavilion Tent where the shooting ranges are located.
- 3. Due to the style of the facility, if there is a shot over the top of the backstop, it will be an automatic MATCH disqualification.
