

Our 2024 CFDA Season has been very busy with 16 CFDA Titled Championships leading up to the season ending FGA at the end of July. The 2025 Season begins the weekend after FGA with our Louisianna State Championship leading off and an additional 7 Titled Championships to follow in September. Will there be more scheduled to follow, I hope so. October & November would be great months to hold championship matches, especially in the mid to southern parts of the U.S. There's word of an Arizona State in October, details to come.

For years we've crammed so many championships between March and June before it got too hot, humid or a combination of both in all but our northern states to hold outdoor events. Then, it would pick up again in September, only to have nothing scheduled in the Fall after FGA. This is only one of the reasons that were the basis for moving FGA to the end of July, since the 3C Arena is an indoor 70-degree climatecontrolled building.

The other major factor is what I stated in my Fall 2023 Column: "The 3C Arena is in big demand, especially for rodeo events after the mid-summer heat is over. After a meeting with 3C Arena Staff, it became obvious that we simply could not be guaranteed consistent dates for FGA during the fall months.". Plus, as an added benefit, we are in hopes that more Youth & Junior Shooters can attend since it's summer break for school in most parts of the country.

Most people don't like change, including me. But, sometimes changes must be made for good reasons and I sincerely hope that everyone understands. This year may seem a little strange, but I believe it will pay dividends for the future of CFDA.

Speaking of the Future of CFDA...

About 5 years ago I made a statement to our U.S. Marshals & Regulators at the Annual Marshal's Muster at the FGA about the future of CFDA. Of course, during 2020 & 2021 we were pretty much just trying to keep our sport going through the terrible Covid years. It's now time to make a very large and positive change that will ensure the future of Cowboy Fast Draw. The transition is now underway to transform Cowboy Fast Draw Association, LLC into Cowboy Fast Draw Association, Non-Profit Organization. There is simply not

U.S. CFDA National Championship

The is the 2nd year our National Championship is hosted by the Sundowners at Fowl Shot & Huckleberry Honey's beautiful Shelterwood Ranch. They do a fine job hosting one of our two major Class A Championship Tournaments with all kinds of associated activities. It's a first-class event and if you haven't been there for either the Western Territorial or National Championship, there still may be time to just make up your mind and go.

Years ago, we started moving our National Championship around the nation, with the intention that this prestigious event should only be at any one location for 1 or 2 years at a time. It's important that various clubs from all parts of our country can have a chance to host the Nationals. I sent an email to our U.S. Marshals and Club Contacts several weeks ago to let them know if any club is working on hosting our 2025 National Championship to let us know, but haven't gotten a response yet. We'll keep you posted on the Cowboy Fast Draw Society – Facebook Discussion Group, which is the best source to find the latest information on what's happening in CFDA.

FGA News!

The Outdoor Channel did run two additional feature segments covering our 2023 FGA – Magnificent 7 Shootoffs. They did a great job capturing the excitement! These shows will run many times over the years and eventually make their way to Youtube. I would like to thank Shooting USA for covering our signature event!

before the match. Can we finally reach our goal of 300+? In any case, we will have another great year to enjoy Fallon, our Host City in the comfort of Churchill County's 3C Arena.

While they are building a new section a little closer to the 3C Arena, it has been delayed as they have been waiting months for NV Energy to approve the electrical engineering. If our members reserve an RV Spot and at the last minute they have the new RV Park ready, they will be able to change to the new park.

The times were tallied up to set up the brackets immediately following our guest "celebrity" shoot.

This was a first in recent years, a "celebrity" shoot that included local notable locals; Becky Haas, the Mayor of Richmond, who also came Sunday for the finals and won the gun raffle, TV news reporter Jacob Rascon, who helped the shoot be featured on the local news; Constable Chad Norvell from Precinct One; and Susan Vanderford and Mike Madden from George Ranch, complete dressed in period clothing, looking great! They all shot like real cowboys. With some coaching we had several of them shooting into the 6's and 7's. We presented awards to them with Jacob

After some fierce competition and fun in the bracket matches the winners were; Master Gunfighter: 1st Lucky T, 2nd Old West, 3rd Ol Buckr'r. Gunfighter: 1st Texas Tornado, 2nd Rowdy Ron and 3rd El Tortuga. Sheriff: 1st HoJo, 2nd Burnet Bandit, and 3rd Kansas Belle. Deputy: 1st Sunset Rose, 2nd Texas Rattler, and 3rd Gun Fuy.

A silent auction was held throughout the event, raising more than \$890.00 for Shoot for the Stars Scholarship Fund. There were over 30 Texas-themed items for auction from handmade pillows, blankets, gun belts, metal work art, BBQ basket, wood work art and many knives.

The second day was the main match and guns were smoking in eight rounds of competition. There were over 60 shooters, including 2 Jr. Youths and one Annie Oakley. Although there were heavy rains, the large arena kept everyone and everything nice and dry and did not dampen our spirits.

Before the start of the main match the Lone Star Gunslingers recognized our members who are veterans of the armed forces. We truly are grateful for their sacrifices for our freedom. This was done by presenting each of them with a patriotic goodie bag put together by club members Willy Draw and his wife Sweet Honey Sunrise. Also 1 member of each branch won a custom patriotic themed knife handmade and donated by club member Gun Guy. We had 3 branches represented, Army, Navy and Air Force.

A few hiccups were overcome early on and with everyone's help with announcing, scoring, range officers and being ready to go when "in the hole" we shot down to the magnificent 7 in both men's and women's.





Our club Marshal Tennessee Tim put everything he had into this shoot with the assistance of our Section leader No Daisy to make sure everyone had a great time for the weekend. Hello, I am Lexi Olmsted aka Baby Beast. I am 14 years old and from Southern California. I have been shooting for three years. I am the 2023 Youth World Champion and I shoot with The Deputies. One of the things that has been difficult for me is that I am a world champion athlete but I am not allowed to talk about my sport at school.

When I was eleven I had been doing girl scouts for three years with my friend Jamie. She came to my birthday dinner and was telling me about this cool new sport she did. She invited me to try out fast draw at a Friday night practice and I fell in love with it.

I am a proud member of The Deputies. They are some of the best people I've ever met. I have been shooting with them almost every Friday for the past 3 years. The Deputies are like a second family to me. I have spent 2 birthdays shooting on my birthday and I loved it. I have spent so much time shooting in the corral whether it was monthly shoots, Friday night practices, or just one on one practices with JD or Cowboy Up. When I joined The Deputies they all took me under their wings and became like my shooting aunts and uncles.

I won the Youth World Championship title in 2023. It was a roller coaster of emotions. I think the part that made me most proud was when I was



shooting in the finals against Ry-Dog Jones. My winning shot was a 0.540 which was the fastest time I had ever shot. It was the most stressful finals I have been in so far, since we were so well matched we had shots that were just a few thousandths apart. One shot I hit a 0.565 and Ry-Dog Jones hit a 0.568. That worlds I had brought my grandma to see me shoot for the first time. I had always talked about how the CFDA was more than just a sport, it was a family. She didn't get it when I talked about it until she came with me to Worlds. That's when she understood how much the CFDA means to me.

When I started Cowboy Fast Draw I had no Idea how much it was going to be like an extra family. One thing I have learned since I started shooting with the CFDA is that you always have people looking out for you all the time. Another thing is that when you shoot with the CFDA it isn't just about shooting fast draw, it is also shooting side matches, hanging out with the other youths you meet along the way, watching your other club members shoot, and just having fun hanging out at the big dinners and auctions. I have realized that when you are shooting Cowboy Fast Draw, people who you have never met before will know your alias and will be cheering for you when you are shooting. I will always remember when I shot my first CFDA shoot, the Nevada State Championship in 2022. When I walked into the Bat Barn to register and for gun check I had a bunch of strangers who I had never met before shaking my hand and making me feel super welcome. I was walking to my table when this big guy, Curley Calhoun, came up to me and introduced himself and welcomed me to the CFDA.

One thing about me that might come as a surprise is what I want to do when I grow up. When I grow up I would like to study at Sonoran Desert

Institute in Tempe, Arizona. I want to earn a certificate in Firearms Technology and Gunsmithing. Then when I am older, own my own gun shop specializing in revolvers. I want to be a good person and be somebody that people can look up to and count on. I want to be someone who is known for how kind and supportive they are. Basically, when I grow up I want to be like all of you and carry on the CFDA tradition.

It's late April, and last weekend's trip to Superior, Wisconsin, to shoot in the Black River Bandits' "You're a Daisy if 'Ya Do" CFDA jackpot shoot marks my 5th anniversary of being in Cowboy Fast Draw. My involvement began when I saw a program about CFDA on TV. At the time, I was one year into recovery from a moderate stroke. I was almost blind and had great difficulty speaking and trouble following conversations. My doctors had told me that at 6-8 weeks post-stroke, "what you have is what you get" as far as recovery goes, so I was frustrated and had resigned myself to not doing much with my days. Cowboy Fast Draw looked intriguing, though, so I

decided to learn more about it.

Talking on the phone was difficult, but I

decided to try calling CFDA . I wrote down questions to ask and did my best to follow the conversation. My first contact was with Jackie Daniels, who was incredibly helpful and understanding. If she wouldn't have been as gracious as she was, I would not have pursued anything further. The next step, and probably the most important, was speaking with Quick Cal. He patiently answered all of my questions and helped me understand every aspect of what I was getting into, and he got me set up so I could try the sport to see if I could safely shoot. I can't thank him enough for his help—I called A LOT and asked many questions.

After a little more than a month of practicing (and getting the rest of my family involved), we headed off to our first CFDA match in Superior, Wisconsin. Before making the final decision to go to the match, I called for information and to touch

h, I caned for information and to touch base, and spoke with Lightnin (Debbie Stadin). I again asked many questions, and as talking over the phone was so hard for me, I'm sure I repeated myself a few times. Debbie gave me so much kindness and understanding that it convinced me to risk giving the whole thing a try.

I use the word "risk" because that is what it feels like when I go out in public—things go by me like a bullet train and it's difficult for me to keep up.





But I survived my first CFDA event and experienced firsthand how wonderful CFDA folks are. Although attending events remain incredibly difficult to me even five years later, I'm a bit more at ease. The incredible thing is how much my brain and body have recovered. Today, if you didn't know me five years ago, it would be difficult to tell I had a stroke which is something all survivors strive to say. I still have some anxiety when getting called to the line—so many things happening, safety, rules, the light, shooting. And sometimes late in the day, I just can't do it. But last year at FGA I attended every after-shoot function and for the very first time, I had a great time and felt almost normal. That is, to me, a miracle.

Thank you to all who have taken the time to help me, and if you see me at an event, know that you played a big part in me being able to attend. From my heart, thank you for the last five years. ~JC Dalton




SHERIFF NABOR PACHECO ARIZONA LAWMAN WITH MANY FIRSTS



Arizona Territorial Sheriff Nabor Pacheco (1904-1908), was truly a man way ahead of his time. In his ten plus years as a Tucson lawman, he was responsible for a number of performance firsts in the then early Wild West law enforcement era. In addition to being the first Arizona born Hispanic to be elected as Sheriff, he was also the first shield carrier to use a fierce canine named Jack that helped in taking down law breakers. For most of those years, he was one of the first lawmen to use an automobile in the performance of his duties. But one of his most whimsical firsts is that of being a matchmaker service.

As written in the Bisbee Daily Review on May 9th, 1906, 'The sheriff's office in Tucson has been turned into a veritable matrimonial bureau for a romantic set of society girls in Cohoes NY. A few weeks ago Nabor Pacheco, Sheriff of Tucson, received a sweet-scented missive, letter requesting him to hand the note to some young, bold and dashing cowboy. The writer, Miss Flourine Ford said that she and some of her friends had been reading about the Southwest and were dying to know a real cowboy. The Sheriff handed the letter to Will Coberly, who had charge of his father's vast ranches in the Arivaca County, and a lively romance was immediately set on foot. Hardly had young Coberly an opportunity to write his first letter, when a half dozen similar missives reached the Sheriff's office. They were all from the Cohoes' girls, who wanted to know real cowboys'. Although it took nearly three months, a successful match resulting in a marriage was achieved.

In a follow up article by the Bisbee Daily Review on August 10, 1906, titled 'Arizona Cowboy Weds A Pretty Eastern Girl, How Cupid Brought Together Pinto Creek Cowpuncher and New York Girl. "Foxey, scheming, irresistable Cupid has scored another victory and 'two loving hearts now beat as one' although three months ago they beat as two-one in Pinto Creek valley in Gila county, and one in Vahoes, New York, where theatrical attractions are frequently taken for baptism before being tried upon the New York public. Cupid has taken some queer turns and used diverse measures in mating couples, but his procedure in this instance was absolutely unique. His strongest weapons in this case were the United States mail and the Territorial press. Sheriff Pacheco of Tucson also assisted. It was three months ago that two young ladies of Cahoes, N.Y. wrote to Sheriff Pacheco and confessed that they longed to meet a real, live Arizona cowboy with his chaparejos, his spurs, his quirt and his ruddy face. The sheriff, willing to do all in his power, showed the letter to a reporter for the Citizen. The heart-yearnings of the young women were given to the public. Other Territorial papers took up the letter and



published it. Some made light comments; others were more serious. Bachelors the Territory over were suggested to the Cahoes young ladies and they received many letters. Riders among the cattle in Pinto Creek Valley, John Sanders one day met another cow-puncher, who showed him a clipping wherein was expressed the heart-desire of the young women. Sanders became interested. He "dropped a line" to New York, and received two in return. More letters were exchanged. Then came photographs. The real Arizona cow-puncher looked good to the Cahoes girl and the veteran of the range was dead in love with the photograph of the pretty girl. A proposal by letter was made. An acceptance came back. It is a long jump from Pinto Creek to Cahoes. Consequently each decided to part of the distance. They met at Marion, Ohio where the bride has relatives. There they were married. They will spend some time in Ohio and will come back to Pinto Creek to live."

So in a job that Sheriff Nabor Pacheco often was duty bound to separate loved ones by sending one of them to prison or worse the gallows, in this situation, he was able to bring together two young lovers.

Our family met and decided that if something should happen to me, they did not feel confident that they could continue managing the sport at its current level, but would be willing and able to manage the products we worked hard as a family to create over the years. Alotta Lead and I have discussed this in-depth and are very committed to seeing that CFDA will go on, should something happen to either one, or both of us. We are also not willing to sell CFDA to any one person or to a for-profit company.

You may be surprised to learn that I've always cringed at being called the "Owner" of CFDA. Instead, I created and hold the title of "Executive Director" or have also needed to be referred to as the CEO particularly in legal matters or documents. I've actually always considered myself more of a "caretaker" of something larger than anyone should ever have the right to own. My family knows this, just like many of my closest friends in our sport have come to realize. Not only am I passionate and love CFDA, but so do thousands of our members who rightly consider themselves as part of our CFDA Family. CFDA is more than a sport, it has become a lifestyle for so many. As both Alotta Lead and Jackie Daniels can attest, we've received many phone calls at CFDA Headquarters, where members have told us that Cowboy Fast Draw has literally saved their lives. So I ask, can you imagine what an awesome responsibility that is? Or, how can we ever let our members down?

What is Happening Now

Alotta Lead and I after much thought and consideration wish to "Grant" CFDA to its membership! It's our sincerest hope that CFDA goes on for future generations to

enjoy!!! However, we're not just "Riding Off Into the Sunset" any time soon. We want to make sure that CFDA develops its new course on the right path, so we are staying very involved for at least, God willing, the next four years, more on that shortly.....

On April 17th, 2024 – I submitted to the State of Nevada documents to form *Cowboy Fast Draw Association, Non-Profit Organization* (CFDA,NPO). The By-Laws are very detailed, it took several days to write and edit. I emailed a copy of these By-Laws in mid-February to our CFDA Regulator Posse for review, we got back some valuable comments and suggestions. These By-Laws will be published on the CFDA Website by the time this article is published for review of any member.

On the same day as above, documents were also filed to form Quick Cal's Gunslinger Emporium, a Nevada Corporation. This is a corporation that will continue to handle and sell the actual sporting products, such as, Timers, Guns, Holsters, Wax and CFDA Brass that our members depend on.

On January 1st, 2025, all of the assets, income, and liabilities associated with the management and administration of the sport of Cowboy Fast Draw will be transferred from Cowboy Fast Draw Association, LLC to Cowboy Fast Draw Association, Non-Profit Organization.

Also on January 1st, 2025, all income, assets, and liabilities associated with Cowboy Fast Draw sporting equipment will be transferred from Cowboy Fast Draw Association, LLC to Quick Cal's Gunslinger Emporium. A separate Gunslinger Emporium Website that our members use to acquire Cowboy Fast Draw products will be activated on or before this date. Cowboy Fast Draw Association, LLC will eventually be deactivated after all business is concluded.

Transitional Year

It takes time to set up things like IRS docs, bank accounts, websites, payroll services, and budgets. These are currently being worked on, with the goal of all being up and running on or before January 1st.

Members should notice little difference over the next few years, since both organizations will still be run out of our current home office. The main difference will be that there will be two separate websites. The main CFDA Website will be very similar to what we have now, except there will be links for products members need that are to be sold by the Gunslinger Emporium. There will also be links on the Gunslinger Emporium directing customers to the CFDA Website for Membership & Club Services.

The main thing that will be noticeably different is that members will not be able $\overline{GUNSLINGER'S GAZETTE}$

to purchase items sold separately by both organizations in one transaction. You will have to order and pay memberships, affiliation or sanction fees, and logo items from the CFDA Website; likewise, CFDA Brass, wax, timers, guns, holsters, etc. on the Gunslinger Emporium Website. Phone orders will also be taken on separate order forms and charged separately, since it is important that all financial matters be handled separately.

How Will CFDA, NPO be Managed?

While it's all laid out in the By-Laws, here's the short version. It's designed to operate much like a city government. Something that I happen to have a lot of personal experience with. **Beginning Initial Appointments**

As the "Grantors" of **CFDA**, **NPO**, Alotta Lead & I will appoint the first Board of Territorial Governors, who will in turn stand for election on schedule as stated in the By-Laws. I will serve as the first Chairman for a 4-Year Term, which will become an elected office in the Fall of 2028, for the term beginning January 1st, 2029. At which time I may choose or choose not to run.

Chairman of the Board

Instead of a Mayor, there is a Chairman of the Board. The Chairman is the CEO of the organization and will be eventually elected to a 4-Year Term by the entire adult general membership. The Chairman does not vote, except in the case of a tie. The Chairman may veto a vote of the Board of Territorial Governors, but the veto can be overridden by a vote of a super-majority of the Board.

The Chairman is the only member of the Board that can also serve as the Executive Director. The Chairman shall conduct all meetings of the Board and shall oversee that all policies, procedures, and decisions made by the Board are carried out. The Chairman or duly appointed representative shall have final authority over policy and rule interpretation at any CFDA event.

Board of Territorial Governors

There are currently 8 Territories recognized in CFDA. Territorial Governors have a 2-Year Term. Please refer to the Territorial Map in the Gunslinger's Gazette, where all CFDA Territories are numbered. Each Territorial Governor is also a member of the Board of Director, also known as the Board of Territorial Governors.

The Grantors shall appoint the first Board of Territorial Governors. Odd numbered Territorial Governors shall be appointed to a one-year term, even numbered Territorial Governors to a two-year term, beginning January 1st, 2025. Territorial Governors shall stand for election in the Fall before their term expires, according to the By-Laws, wherein, the CFDA adult members of each territory shall elect a Territorial Governor to represent them.

The Board of Territorial Governors vote and make all policies, budget, and major business decisions of CFDA, Non-Profit Organization. They also Chair appointed committees as approved by the Board, and approve all final rule changes, procedures, and drafts of rulebooks. They may re-align, add or reduce territories, based on membership numbers and club locations.

The Board shall also approve Marshal Muster agendas, minutes, and consider all discussions and straw poll votes at the annual U.S. Marshal's Muster.

The Board will vote annually to choose a Chairman Pro Tem, in the case that the Chairman of the Board is absent or cannot fulfill their duties.

Executive Director

The Executive Director is appointed by the Chairman of the Board, with the advice and consent of the Board of Territorial Governors. The Chairman may also appoint themselves as Executive Director. This is similar to how various city governments work some are "Strong Mayor", which means the Mayor is also the City Manager, others are "Council-City Manager" forms which means the Mayor mainly runs meeting and is otherwise ceremonial.

The Executive Director runs the dayto-day business operations of the organization. They may hire whatever personnel as needed to manage membership services, accounting, etc. They are also an official spokesman for CFDA, unless otherwise directed by the Board. They also prepare or cause to be prepared an annual budget. All expenditures must be conducted within the budget, unless approved by the Board.

There are six pages that explains many observations about clubs and organizations that I've been highly involved in.

It's our ultimate goal to establish our new Non-Profit CFDA in a way to protect it in the future from what many of us have learned has destroyed so many organizations started with the best of intentions.

When any shooting organization strays from its mission and goals, it loses not only its integrity, but also the integrity of the game it manages. It's now up to all of us to work together for those who follow. I'm convinced that together we can do it!

After receiving payment we will then ship the firearm to your FFL Dealer, who will then be responsible to have you fill out the appropriate forms and conduct a background check, according to Federal and your State Laws and Regulations. Please allow up to 2 weeks for CFDA to prepare your firearm for shipping.

The buyer is responsible to pay all transfer fees, background checks directly to their FFL Dealer of choice.

All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned to CFDA only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. A refund of the sale will be made, minus the original \$35 shipping fee and a 5% re-login/re-stocking fee. Available in the CFDA General Store or Call CFDA Main Office at 775-575-1802

THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center) 24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center) Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Westernstyle blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to <u>educate as many people as</u> <u>possible in the safe and proper use of firearms.</u> Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.
