Ellicott, CO THIS IS A "NON-SPECTATOR" Venue (Guests are Welcome!) WELCOME to the 2025 Colorado State and 4 Corners Championships! Wednesday May 28th thru Sunday June 1st at the Star Ranch

Ellicott is about 30 minutes from downtown Colorado Springs and six hours north of Albuquerque. Since we are above 5000 feet it is extremely important for you to stay hydrated and rested while you are here. It may take a day or so for you to acclimate to our altitude if you are not used to it. Our events will be at the Star Ranch, **50 South Ellicott Highway, Ellicott, CO. 80808**.

Shooter's popups, tables and chairs will be allowed at the ranch. There will be tables and chairs under the tent for those who cannot bring their own. We will provide water for shooters and their guests in the shooter's area at no charge. A monetary donation will be welcomed.

We will not take a lunch break during the matches. Food and beverages will be welcomed in the shooter's area. There will be a food vendor Karen's Café or bring your own.

No alcohol, illegal, or illicit drugs will NOT be allowed on the range while events are in progress. Anyone who appears under the influence during the events while in progress or otherwise impaired will not be allowed on ranch property and will NOT compete.

June in Colorado can be both hot and rainy in the afternoons. Expect a shower or two on any given day, usually in the afternoons. They usually don't last long and are normally not heavy. Please bring your rain gear just in case.

2025 Colorado State and Four Corners Championships General Information

All matches will be shot on 17-3/16" targets at 15ft We will be using two 6 Lane Ranges

All CFDA rules will apply to all matches. You must be a CFDA member in good standing to compete in these matches as well as the side matches. Please be prepared to show either your CFDA membership card or your lifetime badge at registration.

We will supply all of the ammo for all of the matches. We will be shooting NobleSport 688 209 shotgun primers and C & R wax in all the matches including the titled Championships. We will provide all the ammo for all the matches. **Exception, if the current primer shortages continue be prepared to provide your own ammo for the non CFDA events, we will update in advance to the event.** Also, at times the ranges may be open for practice. You will need your own ammo for practice. If you did not bring ammo, we will have ammo available for sale at the same price that our club members pay for wax and primers.

All Billy the Kid and Annie Oakley Youth competitors (referred to as BK and AO) except level 4 shooting with the adults will shoot for free. Level 2 two handed and Level 3- and one-handed shooters will shoot together. BK and AO may shoot together depending on the turnout. There will be awards for both the top BK and AO shooters. Junior shooters and Level 4 Youth shooters shooting with the adults and will pay a portion of the adult entry fee because they will be eligible for the same awards as adults. There will also be separate awards for the top Junior Boy and Junior Girl.

SCHEDULE

Wednesday May 28^{th:} Shoot for the Stars jackpot Match for early arrivals. Entry fee will be \$25.00. 2X – 3 winning hits. May add a 3rd X, depending on attendance.

Shooter's meeting at 9:30 am Match begins at 10:00am

Shooters will provide their own CFDA Approved Shotgun Primer Loads. The match will begin at 10am in the morning and will be open to all. All registered shooters in the Jackpot Shoot will shoot together regardless of Division or Category. Prizes and or awards will be given to the top five shooters. Shooters not shooting in the Jackpot match may be able to practice with their own ammo during the Jackpot match if a range is available. If you do not have your own ammo, then ammo will be available to purchase at the same price that our club members pay.

Colorado State Championship Match - Thursday May 29th & Friday — May 30th Roll Call and Shooter's Meeting at 8:30am each day. Match begins at 9:00am each day

The Colorado State Championship match will be a 4X - 3 out of 5 (3 winning hits) match. There will be a Fabulous Five Men's and Ladies Championship Shoot-off on Friday. Our goal is to complete a minimum of seven rounds of the main match on Thursday.

Bracket match on Friday morning, before the conclusion of the State Championship. Your entry fee is included in your registration fee. All ammo is supplied. It will be a 2X - (Nevada 8) format. Bracket match awards will be given out during the State championship awards ceremony.
