INSIDE THE CFDA

After almost 19 years, this is the last column I am writing as a business owner of the Cowboy Fast Draw Association. It seems kind of strange to write those words on one hand, but it doesn't on another. For those who have taken the time to read the 6-page letter that I published months ago on our CFDA website, along with the By-Laws of Cowboy Fast Draw Association, Non-Profit Organization, you may have a better understanding of what I am writing here. If you are not aware of the major transformation that is going on right now for CFDA, maybe its time that you do read for yourself what is happening. Please go to CowboyFastDraw.com and at the top of the page you will see the "CFDA Home" arrow, press it and the 2nd subject down select "CFDA Non-Profit". There you will find all 23 pages of our new "By-Laws", plus an article called "CFDA, The Next Generation". I suggest you read them, because on January 1st, we will all become in a sense "owners" of the Cowboy Fast Draw Association, and therefore share the responsibility for its future.

About 5 years ago I first shared my concerns about the future of Cowboy Fast Draw with our U.S. Marshals at our Annual Marshal's Muster at FGA, and that someday the path forward may be a non-profit organization. My family and I have been thinking about it for quite a while. The 6-Page Article, "CFDA, The Next Generation" I wrote several months ago covers just about everything and there certainly isn't room in this column to repeat it all here.

Transition at CFDA Headquarters

As most of you know CFDA's operations have handled all aspects of Cowboy Fast Draw for almost 20 years under one umbrella which included all membership, club, events, and products needed for our sport. We already have almost everything in place to separate the sporting functions from the products, but there is still so much work and details to complete, especially over the next few months during this transition with the coordination of the separate websites, banking, bookkeeping, budgeting, phones, and duties. Our team's goal is to make this transition as seamless as possible. We will have to separate and charge orders to the appropriate entities, since we will be operating both CFDA & Quick Cal's Gunslinger Emporium. It may take our team a few months to get the process sorted and smoothed out, and we would appreciate your patience during this time.

Our Initial Board of Territorial Governors

It's my honor to introduce our initial Board of Territorial Governors a.k.a. The Board of Director of Cowboy Fast Draw Association, Non-Profit Organization. If you have read our By-Laws, you will know that this first board has been appointed by me. It has taken all year to do so, because I chose them carefully and had conversations with each and every one of them. I appointed them based upon several factors, like how long they have been in the sport, were they committed enough to be life members, were club officers, contest hosts, etc.? I felt they should be seasoned and respected shooters, but not necessarily the fastest or titled champions. They also needed to be reasonable folks that would bring different perspectives and ideas to board discussions, which is why you will find various ages and genders on this board.

According to the Territory Map that we have published in the Gunslinger's Gazette for many years, the Territories have always been both named and numbered. So, according to our By-Laws the odd numbered Territories will have elections for Territorial Governors in odd numbered years and even numbered Territories in even numbered years. Therefore, half of my initial appointments will be standing for election only one year from now (2025) and the other half two years from now (2026). This means that there is the potential that half of the Board of Territorial Governors could change every year. The members of each Territory will elect their Territorial Governor.

God willing, I will serve the first 4-Year Term as Chairman of the Board and have already appointed myself as the Executive Director, in accordance with our By-Laws. Executive Director has actually been my official title since 2006, which is why our membership will not see much of a change in the near future. In 4 years, I will make the decision whether I will run again for a 2nd Term, as Chairman. We must never forget the ultimate goal of all of these actions, to provide a path forward for the future of CFDA.

I wish to express my deepest gratitude for our first board of Territorial Governors. They have stepped forward to help blaze the trail for the future of Cowboy Fast Draw! But, I must remind all of our members that our Board of Directors cannot do it alone, we must count on your support! We can do this together!

Your Board is Already at Work

Item #1. Elect Vice Chairman of the Board (1-Year Term)

Dead Eye Daisy was elected by the Board

Item #2. Top Gun Points Action (Approved by the Board)

Top Gun Points will go back to a Calendar Year Award for the matches held only within that year, with the (best 6 Point Total Counting) as before. Within 14 days of the last CFDA Titled Championship held each year, buckles will be ordered from the supplier and as an added benefit will contain the name of the winner of the buckle. They will be sent by mail to the winners. The winners will then be published on social media assets and in the next publications. For the 2025 awards only. The points for 2024 CFDA Titled Championships held after the 2024 FGA will be counted count towards the 2025 Top Gun Points Season. This means that some of these championships may be counted for both years in some shooter's point totals. Because of the added contests, the best 8 point totals will be counted, instead of the best 6. The number of required State Championships tallied in the total will be raised from the normal 2 to 3 for only for the 2025 Season only, since the count has been raised from 6 to 8.

Parting Shot

I'm asking all committed members of CFDA to please read my six page aforementioned article on our website "CFDA, The Next Generation", especially Part 3, on Page 6. It's all really right there... You the membership can either make this all work for everyone by following what I wrote, or you can destroy it all by playing self-serving political games, just like every Fast Draw organization that has existed for the past 70 years has done. I'm told that Alotta Lead and I could have sold CFDA, LLC and all its products recently, but there is just no way we could trust what they might do with it. We simply could not let all of you down by doing such a thing! Only God knows how much time any of us have on this earth, it's time do our best to provide for a future for CFDA that we can all be proud of. **For that, we are placing our trust in YOU, the members of CFDA.**

Fallon, Nevada- July may be HOT! But the 3C Arena was NOT, except for the World Championship level of shooting that was going on inside...

200 of the best and the most dedicated for the love of the game, gathered on the last weekend in July for not only the World Championship of Cowboy Fast Draw, but so much more. This gathering is truly the signature event of our organization. We have a meeting of our U.S. Marshals that we call the Marshal's Muster, a Life Member Reception, World Category Championship, the World Championship Main Match, the largest 2nd Chance Shoot, World Shootist & Junior World Championship Shootoffs, The Tournaments of Champions, CFDA Annual Awards Ceremony, World Bracket Match Championship, Top Gun of the Year Buckle Presentation, and the Magnificent 7 Youth, Ladies

and Men's World Championship Finals.

We also have vendors on the pavilion, including a food vendor, the CFDA General Store, a Live Band at the Gunfighter's Ball, a Free Bar – partially sponsored by *Break Thru Beverage*, and the Annual Shoot for the Stars Auction.

I do understand that some of our members were not entirely pleased with the changing of our dates from mid-October to late July. However, I also hope that our members understand that being able to rely on a facility such as the 3C Arena is truly a benefit for our entire organization and everyone who attends the FGA. For those of us who have been involved with CFDA for years, I think we can remember just about every kind of weather condition we've encountered over the years. From heat, to cold, to high winds, to rain, to dust, and mud, we had experienced everything but snow. Although, we did get numerous reports over the years from our members having to deal with snow and ice while returning home across the upper mid-west.

At our Friday Morning Opening Ceremonies, *Jesse Segura*, Operations Manager of the 3C Arena had some very kind and inspiring words to share with us. He told us just how important the members of the Cowboy Fast Draw Association were to their community. Jesse proclaimed that we were the best groups that they work with and that our members are so respectful not only throughout Fallon, but of their facility. It allowed him to negotiate a reduced rate for our group for the next 3 years for the 3rd weekend in July. This was no easy accomplishment when dealing with county and park commissioners, who have huge bond payments to make. He was able to secure this arrangement only for us since it is coordinated with their plan to work in some much-needed time off for their staff at that time of year. They feel they can practically turn the keys of the building over to us with minimal staff, since we manage ourselves well and do our best to leave this facility in the condition we found it. The only other event in that building in the month of July is a high dollar cutting horse event that pays \$40k for the weekend following us. Wednesday

Our **Annual Marshal's Cup**, which is a team building event that CFDA conducts each year for U.S. Marshals or Deputies. It's limited only to those who are voting representatives seated at the Round Table Discussion held at FGA each year. This year's the Top 5 were:

- 3rd *Tin Bender ID* Northwest Rangers

About High Noon we gathered for our **Annual Marshal's Muster**. This is always a very important meeting each year for representatives to gather from clubs across the country. Valuable insight is provided to the management of CFDA. Members can find past Agendas and results dating back many years on the CFDA Website to learn about the important discussions and the basis for the many decisions that are made to guide our sport.

Gathering of Gunfighters is a Social Meet & Greet where many of the shooters who have shown up get to meet and visit with their fellow gunfighters for the first time the night before competition begins. Many just hang out, some gather here to await the beginning of the Texas Hold'em Tournament.

Old Drifter's CFDA Shoot for the Stars - Texas Hold'em Tournament is always a popular event! There are usually several tables of gunfighters and family members having fun and playing in this event raising funds for our favorite charity.


Thursday

Even though so many show up and check-in or register on Wednesday, Thursday is also extremely busy first thing in the morning. However, our FGA Scoring & Registration Team is as sharp as they get and very efficient. Everyone is registered, checked in, and equipment is also checked and ready to go in no time!

Thanks to our **FGA Scoring Team** *Wild Shot, Ubet, Lady Heather, and Bean Counter* who manage the computers throughout all of our events, with *Guido B*, helping out at registration. Then, we had so much help with some of our non-shooter score-writers like *Etta Mae, Nya Sue, and Miss Betty*. Our Equipment Checkers were *Butch Cassidy, Diamond Jim, and Chisum*.

The Quick & the Dead – We begin with a fun event that we do each year. We bill it as, *"The closest thing you'll ever experience to a real gunfight!"* It's a 1-X Elimination Match. It's luck of the draw, just like real life is. You get on the line with your opponent, load your guns, and when the light comes on, you draw and shoot until you hit your target. Some hit it on the first shot, some take a few shots, some never hit it at all. Anything can happen! We lose ½ of the shooters each round, so it goes very quickly. ½ the money goes to the winner, ½ goes to **Shoot for the Stars!**

In the past, we've had a few 3-Shooters win it,

last year it came down between *Little J*, an Annie Oakley shooter and *Bandana Kid*, with *Bandana Kid* winning! This year it came down between two really fast shooters with *Stamper* taking runner-up, which we call 1st *Dead*, and *Gambit* winning a pocket full of cash & 1st *Quick – Gold Pan!* But then again, everyone is a winner, we all had fun and raised money to provide scholarships for our young'uns, now what can be better than that!

World Category Championship - Almost 200 shooters were spread out across 15 Categories in a 2-X (Nevada 8 Format) kept 4 of our ranges hopping for about 3 or 4 hours.

Side Matches - The fun doesn't end when shooters meet their fate of a 2nd X, since on the 5th Range there are Side Matches set up and ready to go. Double Trouble and the Triple 7 Test are always a hit!

Tournament of Champions – We added this event a few years ago which invites those who have won CFDA Titles in the past year to come together to compete in this prestigious event. We start it in mid-afternoon and get it down to the Fabulous 5 Men & Ladies, who will compete in the Saturday afternoon Championship Shootoffs.

Life Member Reception – We love bringing our CFDA Life Members together each year for a fun filled evening of camaraderie and celebration. This year was based on what was cool in the 1950's. Since it was left up to each person's interpretation, the coolest thing for me was Cowboy Heroes, so I wore my personally autographed *Roy Rogers* hat. My family had a completely different viewpoint. I sat in the audience watching *Hannah Calder* as the Host of their 1950's game show complete with *Little Miss Sunshine* & *Rango* holding up "Applaud Signs" and the almost non-stop laughter and fun reactions from everyone in their audience. Editor's Note: *Please forgive me in advance. As I write about the matches below from a mixture of memory and scoresheets, I get caught up in the excitement and sometimes jump between past and current tense.*

Junior Girls –

We begin with our 3rd Seed - *Little Miss Sunshine* (Last Year's Defending Junior Girl World Champion) & 2nd Seed - *Baby Beast* (Last Year's Youth World Champion). *Little Miss Sunshine* jumps out to a 2-0 lead, but *Baby Beast* wins the next 3 shots in a row to win the round, both were shooting around a ½ second. Next, **Top Seed**






and Current Overall Ladies National Champion – **Shell Shock** comes to the line to challenge the Winner’s Bracket. **Shell Shock** hits 3 winning shots in a row, the first two in the low 4’s with the last shot a .382!

In a semi-final round between **Little Miss Sunshine & Baby Beast**. **Little Miss Sunshine** prevails hitting 4 consistent shots in a row, **Baby Beast** ends up in 3rd Place.

In the final round, **Shell Shock** shows why she is the reigning National Ladies Champion hitting 3 out of 4 shots a .353, .394, and finishes with a .375, winning the Junior Girl World Championship. **Little Miss Sunshine** finishes in 2nd Place.



feeling the pressure and tries to pour on the speed, while **Ry-Dog Jones** is still on fire hitting 3 more in a row about the same speed!

Now, it’s our #1 Seed, **Ranger** out of Colorado and he takes a 1-0 lead with a .393, but that seems to just inspire **Ry-Dog Jones** who turns on the heat again and nails 3 more in a row a .33 pace! These kids don’t know how to shoot nothing but 3’s! **Ry-Dog Jones** works his way from 4th Seed to cat-bird seat in 3 quick rounds and earns a break.....

Meanwhile, in the 1-X Bracket on Lanes 3&4, **Anytime Kid** is taking care of business winning a 2-2 round against **Hits** sending him to 4th, and then a 2-2 round against **Ranger** sending him to a 3rd Place finish. Now he’s in the Championship Round against **Ry-Dog**

Jones! But, **Ry-Dog Jones** has not cooled down he is still as hot as ever and finishes with 3 winning shots in a row .346, .344, .337, winning his first Junior Boy World Championship!

Folks we have a new and exciting group of very impressive Junior Shooters!

Ladies Shootist- FGA always draws the most shootists of any CFDA Championship and we give them their own Fabulous 5 World Championship Shoot-off. Our 4th & 5th Seeds **Lady Hawk & Snickers** are up first with **Lady Hawk** hitting 3 out of 4 to take the win. That brought up 3rd Seed **K.K. Kid** to set up a rematch of last year’s championship round between **Lady Hawk** and **K.K. Kid**, who is our defending champion. **K.K. Kid** is on target with 3 winning hits in the low 4’s, she’s clearly the fastest Lady Shootist in the field!

Our #2 Seed, **Gypsy Girl** comes to the line with **K.K. Kid** and takes a 1-0 lead, but **K.K. Kid** finds the target again and wins the round in the next three shots. Meanwhile, in the 1-X Bracket on Lanes 3&4 **Snickers** is hitting and **Lady Hawk** isn’t and wins her round, **Lady Hawk** takes 7th Place.

Madam Clerk has been the Top Seed now 2 years in a row and comes to the firing line to go up against **K.K. Kid** who’s on a winning streak. That streak continues, as **K.K. Kid** hits another 3 in a row to win the cat-bird seat and earns a short break to await the Championship Round. Meanwhile, in the 1-X Bracket, **Snickers** and **Gypsy Girl** are tied 2-2 with **Gypsy Girl** winning the last shot with a .720, **Snickers** takes 4th!

In the Semi-Final Round it’s 2-2 between **Gypsy Girl & Madam Clerk**, **Gypsy Girl** wins the last shot again with a .726. Earning her spot in the Championship Round against **K.K. Kid**.

In the Championship Round **K.K. Kid** does jump to a 1-0 lead but misses the next two shots, **Gypsy Girl**

is not missing and makes it a 2-1 round. **K.K. Kid** ties it up 2-2 with a .424, then on the very next shot wins her 2nd World Ladies Shootist Championship in a row with a .415!

Men’s Shootist- Our 5th Seed - **Rossow** comes to the line to take on 4th Seed – **Muletrain**, and they take it to a 2-2 tie with **Rossow** winning the last shot with a .494. Next up, 3rd Seed – **Gambler** hits 3 out of 4 to take over the Winner’s Bracket with a final shot of a .395. Which brings up 2nd Seed – **Tin Bender** (Our Defending World Shootist Champion). **Tin Bender** starts out cold on the target, but **Gambler** is hitting nothing but 3’s and wins the round to maintain control of Lanes 1 & 2.

Over in the 1-X Bracket on Lanes 3 & 4 **Muletrain** sends **Rossow** to a 5th Place finish. Next in the 1-X Bracket, **Tin Bender** does finally find the target and from a 2-2 tie wins the round with **Muletrain** who ends up in 4th Place.

Our Top Seed, a fellow that seemingly came out of nowhere from Arizona who has only been shooting Cowboy Fast Draw for less than 6 months and caught everyone by surprise, by the name of **Dos Vaqueros** comes to the 1-X Bracket to challenge **Gambler**. **Gambler** takes a 1-0 lead, but **Dos Vaqueros** quickly ties it with a .376, but **Gambler** stays steady winning the next two shots with a pair of .38s and earns the cat-bird seat.

In the Semi-Finals an exciting round between **Tin Bender** and **Dos Vaqueros** goes down to the wire, a 2-2 tie, **Dos Vaqueros** wins the final shot, **Tin Bender** takes 3rd, **Dos Vaqueros** in the Championship Round against **Gambler**.

The Championship Round and **Gambler** jumps to a quick 1-0 lead and never looks back hitting 3 shots

in a row and winning the 2024 Men's World Shootist Championship!

Tournament of Champions

This was the 3rd year of this exclusive and unique tournament, only current overall and resident CFDA Champions earned the honor of an invitation to compete with fellow champions. There is no entry fee, it's all about the honor, the only actual prizes are some very nice buckles to commemorate the achievement.

We began with a 2-X – 3 Winning Hit Format on Thursday afternoon until we reached the Fabulous 5. The Championship Shoot-off is held on our CFDA's biggest stage, our Championship Range on Saturday afternoon. **T.O.C. Ladies Fabulous 5!**

5th Seed, Lefty Lipscomb – ID – She's a 5-Time National Champion, reigning Top Gun of the Year, and California State Champion. **Our 4th Seed is Honey Bucket - CA**, our Western Territorial Champion. **#3 Seed is K.K. Kid - TX**, winner of this year's Florida & Texas State Championships. **#2 Seed is Emberly – ID**, she won the Oregon State Championship. **Our Top Seed is Dead Eye Daisy - MI**, our Defending Fastest Gun Alive – World Ladies Champion, and 2-Time Defending Ladies Tournament of Champions – Champion!

Honey Bucket chooses Lane 1, putting **Lefty** on Lane 2 to set up our first Winner's Bracket Match. They both shoot in the ½ second range and get it down to a 2-2 tie, with **Honey Bucket** scoring the winning hit with a .522. **K.K. Kid** comes to the line and picks Lane 1. **K.K. Kid** quickens the pace to the low 4's with **Honey Bucket** still on target forces the match to another 2-2 tie, then closes with another winning hit of a .531.

It's time for our **#2 Emberly** to challenge **Honey Bucket** on 1 & 2, while **Lefty Lipscomb & K.K. Kid** battle it out on 3 & 4. **Honey Bucket** is still on target and takes a 1-0 lead, but **Emberly** counters back with a really fast .370 to tie it up. But, **Honey Bucket** wins again with a .479 & .488! Meanwhile, **Lefty** also takes a 1-0 lead, but **K. K. Kid** finds it and nails 3 in a row in the low 4's finishing with a .422 for the win, **Lefty Lipscomb** takes 5th Place.

Dead Eye Daisy comes the challenge **Honey Bucket** and doesn't waste much time finding the target and winning three in a row in the low 4's. While, in the 1-X Bracket **K. K. Kid** does the same and hits 3 out of 4 sending **Emberly** to a 4th Place finish.

While **Dead Eye Daisy** looks on from the catbird seat, **K.K. Kid** finds the target again and hits 3 out of 4 in the Semi-Final Round against **Honey Bucket's** just a little slower 4 out of 4 hits, **Honey Bucket** shot a great final and ends up in a very good 3rd Place finish!

We're down to Championship Round #1! **K.K. Kid** needs to win to force a Final Championship Round, she starts out winning the first shot with a .395 over **Dead Eye Daisy's** .408, but **Dead Eye Daisy** isn't fazed. She's on target and on pace with a .415, .411, and a .407 winning her 3rd Ladies Tournament of Champions Title in a row!

T.O.C. Mens' Fabulous 5 Finals!

5th Seed – Tin Bender – ID – He's our current Top Gun of the Year, Florida & Texas State Champion. **#4 Seed is Gambit – ID**. **Gambit** recently won his first CFDA Title, the Great Northwest Championship to earn his invitation. **Our #3 Seed is Rango - NV**, he's earned invitations the past 3 years, this year for winning the Nevada State Championship. **Tank – ID is our #2 Seed**, he's won the first two Men's Tournament of Champions and is our defending champion. **Our Top Seed is Oregon Ranger - OR**, he's the defending FGA – World Champion, this year's National, Western Territorial, and Oregon State Champion.

We lead off with **Gambit** on Lane 1 and **Tin Bender** on 2. **Tin Bender** takes the match with the last shot of a .377. Next up, is **Rango**, but **Tin Bender** nails 3 in a row while **Rango** is still looking to find the target. Which brings up **Tank** to challenge **Tin Bender** on Lanes 1 & 2, while **Gambit** and **Rango** try their best to stay alive on over on 3 & 4. **Tank** jumps out to a 1-0 lead over his Grandpa, that's right **Tin Bender** is **Tank's** Grandfather! But, **Tin Bender** is still on target and wins the round with a final shot of .369! He shoots a long-gun folks! Meanwhile, **Rango**, does find the target with a .351 to take a 1-0 lead, but **Gambit** wins the next 3 shots, winning the round, **Rango** takes 5th Place.

Next up is Top Seed, **Oregon Ranger** to take on **Tin Bender**. **Tin Bender** tries to look for some extra speed and drag races **Oregon Ranger** with that long-gun of his and does find some, getting his times down to the mid-3's. They take it to a 2-2 tie, on the last shot **Tin Bender** lays down a .363, but **Oregon Ranger** has found his pace with his second .331 in a row and wins the round.

Meanwhile, **Tank** and **Gambit** go at it very hard and fast in the 1-X Bracket taking it down to a 2-2 match, with **Tank** barely pulling out a win with a .345 beating **Gambit's** .355. **Gambit** ends up in 4th Place.

Next, it's **Tank vs Tin Bender** again, this time **Tank** prevails with a final shot of .347 earning his spot in Championship Round #1 and a chance to win his 3rd Tournament of Champions in a row! **Tin Bender** shot great finishing 3rd Place!

It's always special when we are treated to any match between **Oregon Ranger and Tank**, two of the super stars of our game. The first shot, **Tank** (.333) – **Oregon Ranger** (.329) just 4 thousandths apart! But, while **Tank** is trying to turn it up a notch, which we all know he is one of the few that can, **Oregon Ranger** just keeps going with, (.325) & (.323) **Oregon Ranger** wins his first Tournament of Champions Title!

Our CFDA True Grit Award is inscribed as follows:



Our 7th Seed is **Ruby Roundhouse**, 10-years-old from Star, ID. 6th Seed is **Gunslinger Jon**, he's 11-years-old and from New River, AZ. #5 is **Dink**, he comes from Tucson, AZ is 13-years-old and has won a National Billy the Kid Championship. Our 4th Seed is **Six Gun Shelbs** from Fernley, NV and is 11, she won the Deputy Bracket match at FGA at age 9 in 2022. #3 is **Night Hawk**, he's 10-years-old and is from Oroville, CA, he's won Oregon, California, and GNTC Billy the Kid so far this year. Coming in at 2nd Seed is **Sniper** from Middleton, ID, he's 10-years-old, and is our National Billy the Kid Champion. Our Top Seed is **Little J**, she's 14-years-old and from Rancho Cucamonga, CA, she has won 3 National and multiple State Youth and Annie Oakley Championships.

We start with **Ruby Roundhouse** on Lane 1 and **Gunslinger Jon** on 2. **Ruby Roundhouse** hits 3 good

shots winning the match with a final shot of a .666. Next up is **Dink** to take on the winner. **Ruby Roundhouse** takes a 1-0 lead, but **Dink** quickly catches and passes and wins the round with a final shot of a .630 to **Ruby Roundhouse's** .644.

It's #4 **Six Gun Shelbs**'s turn to take on **Dink**, but **Dink** takes and 2-0 lead. **Six Gun Shelbs** fires a .589 to win the next shot, but **Dink** barely edges out a win on the very next shot with a .602 to **Shelbs**' .610, close match! Meanwhile, in the 1-X bracket on Lanes 3 & 4 **Ruby Roundhouse** hits 3 winning hits in a row, sending **Gunslinger Jon** to a 7th Place finish.

#3 **Seed Night Hawk** comes and claims Lane 1 to take on **Dink** and wins the match with 3 winning hits right off all in the high 5's. We begin with *Kansas Belle* in Lane 1 and *Lacy Gone Wild* on 2, with *Lacy Gone Wild* winning the round with a final shot of .526. Next up, is 5th Seed *Ricochet Rose*, the match goes 2-2 with *Lacy Gone Wild* winning again with a final shot of .480.

#4 Seed *Dead Eye Daisy* comes to the line and picks Lane 1, *Lacy Gone Wild* is on 2. *Dead Eye Daisy* wins the round with 3 out of 4 hits with the last shot of a .454. While over in the 1-X Bracket, *Ricochet Rose* nails 3 winning hits just over a half second to end *Kansas Belle's* run, who finishes in 7th Place.

That brings up #3 Seed *Sierra Rose* to take on *Dead Eye Daisy*, but *Dead Eye Daisy* is on target and finds a winning pace in the low 4's hitting 3 in a row. Meanwhile, *Ricochet Rose* wins a close 2-2 round on Lanes 3 & 4, sending *Lacy Gone Wild* to a 6th Place finish.

Our #2 Seed *Honey Bucket* comes to try her luck against the reigning champ and opens with a 1-0 lead, but *Dead Eye Daisy* hits 3 in a row again in the low 4's to hold her position in the Winner's Bracket. While, *Ricochet Rose* holds onto to her claim over the 1-X Bracket winning the round with *Sierra Rose* with 3 out of 4 hits in the very low 5's.

Now it's time for our #1 Seed and National Champion *Shell Shock*, who may be the only challenger in the Ladies Mag 7 who has the speed to challenge *Dead Eye Daisy's* pace. *Shell Shock* picks Lane 1. From Lane 2, *Dead Eye Daisy* leads off with a deadly .429 to take a 1-0 lead, then follows with a .417 beating *Shell Shock's* .442. Now ahead 2-0 *Dead Eye Daisy* closes the round with a third shot of a .434, to win the cat-bird seat and a well-deserved break. Meanwhile, *Honey Bucket* finds herself up 2-1 against *Ricochet Rose* and wins the round with an off-pace hit, *Ricochet Rose* ends up in 4th Place after a really good hit run on Lanes 3 & 4.

In the Semi-Final Round it's *Shell Shock* on Lane 1 taking on *Honey Bucket* on 2. *Shell Shock* knows she needs to find the target and finds it on the first shot with a .457 to take a 1-0 lead, she also knows she needs to find her speed if she is going to earn a spot in Championship Round #1 against *Dead Eye Daisy*. Her next two shots are a .398 and a .397 to win the Semi-Final Round, she certainly found the speed! *Honey Bucket* takes 3rd Place!

The crowd is excited for Championship Round #1! They know what both of these top lady shooters are capable of. *Dead Eye Daisy* wins the first shot on Lane 1 with a .425, *Shell Shock* wins the next shot with a .403, it's a 1-1! *Dead Eye Daisy* wins the next shot with a .436, then *Shell Shock* ties it again with a .407, just like that it's 2-2!!! *Midnight Mexican* gives the commands, the start light comes on, *Dead Eye Daisy's* light is blinking! She wins her 3rd Fastest Gun Alive – Ladies World Championship in a row! A 3-Peat! The crowd erupts! Hats off to these two great champions for an exciting finish!

7th Seed- *Master Gunfighter* (CA) 2009 FGA World Champion, Multiple State & Territorial Championships; 6th Seed – *Crosswired* (OR) Current Idaho State Champion; 5th Seed – *Dos Vaqueros* (AZ) Amazing Story - Only been shooting CFDA about 6 months, really worked hard; 4th Seed – *Cowboy Up* (CA) Multiple FGA Mag 7, calls himself Professional 2nd Place, Runner-up 2017 FGA; 3rd Seed – *Arizona Cactus Kid* (AZ) Current 4 Corner & Great Lakes Territorial, Multiple State & Territorial, Top Seed 2023 FGA Mag 7; #2 Seed – *Dead Eye Kid* (NV) Current Great Plains & Nebraska Champion, Runner-up Deadwood

Nationals 2022, Multiple FGA Mag 7 Finals; Top Seed – *Oregon Ranger* (OR) 7-Time and Defending FGA World Champion, 2-Time & Current National Champion, Multiple State & Territorial Championships.

We begin with *Master Gunfighter* on Lane 1 and *Crosswired* on 2. *Crosswired* is known for his consistency and hits 3 winning shots in a row to win the round, while *Master Gunfighter* was trying to find his pace and the target. Next up, was *Dos Vaqueros* with the same result *Crosswired* won the match with 3 hits in a row.

Cowboy Up our 4th Seed came and picked Lane 1 and opened with a very fast .342, but *Crosswired* still hasn't missed a shot in these finals and hits another 3 winning shots in a row to win the round. Meanwhile, now the 1-X Bracket was going on over on Lanes 3 & 4 between *Dos Vaquero* & *Master Gunfighter*. *Master Gunfighter* opened with a fast .359, but after they both missed a few they brought the match to a 2-2 tie, with *Dos Vaqueros* winning the last shot with .399. *Master Gunfighter* ended up in 7th Place.

Our #3 Seed *Arizona Cactus Kid* was itching to get into the gunfight as he chose Lane 2 and opened with .360, but *Crosswired*, who still had not missed one shot in these entire finals and tied it 1-1 with a .496. *Arizona Cactus Kid* doesn't miss much either and nailed the next two, so did *Crosswired*, but about 10 hundreds of a second slower, *Arizona Cactus Kid* took control of the Winner's Bracket.

Meanwhile, over in the 1-X Bracket, *Cowboy*





Up won his round against *Dos Vaqueros* with a final shot of .347! By the way, *Dos Vaqueros* was not only a new shooter, but was also shooting a long-gun. I have to say, that making the Mag 7 Finals at FGA in your first year and taking 6th Place, is certainly a major accomplishment, I hope we see a lot more of *Dos Vaqueros* in the future!

Dead Eye Kid our #2 Seed comes to take on the now warmed up *Arizona Cactus Kid*. *Arizona Cactus Kid* doesn't miss a beat and hits three shots in a row in the mid-3's. While, in the 1-X Bracket, consistency wins again, *Crosswired* sends *Cowboy Up* to a 5th Place finish.

It's time for **Top Seed, Oregon Ranger** to face last year's Top Seed *Arizona Cactus Kid*. *Arizona Cactus Kid* lays down a .348 and a .355 to take a quick 2-0 lead, but it seems that it just took *Oregon Ranger* a couple of shots to warm up, and warm up he did. He answered with three .33's in a row, edging out the 3 hits that *Arizona Cactus Kid* had also laid on his plate! *Oregon Ranger* earns the cat-bird seat while he awaits his final opponent.

Over on Lanes 3 & 4 a very interesting match is developing between two of the most consistent and known "hitters" in our sport *Dead Eye Kid* & *Crosswired*! *Crosswired* jumped to a 2-0 lead just edging out *Dead Eye Kid*, but *Dead Eye Kid*, who was in the process of

hitting 5 in a row, won the last 3 shots. *Crosswired* ended up taking 4th Place with a very impressive run from 6th.

The Semi-Final Round featured *Arizona Cactus Kid* on Lane 3 and *Dead Eye Kid* on 4. It went back and forth, one hit and one missed until they were tied 2-2. On the 5th shot *Arizona Cactus Kid* nailed a .368 and beat *Dead Eye Kid*'s .469, who ended up in 3rd Place!

Championship Round #1, Arizona Cactus Kid needed a win to force a **Final Championship Round** and began with .352. However, *Oregon Ranger* was "*In His Zone*" and finished the championship off very quickly with a .330, .324, and .326! *Oregon Ranger* won a remarkable **8th Fastest Gun Alive – Men's World Championship!**

Well that's it folks! What another exciting FGA Finals! We hope you can all join us for the 2025 FGA – July 16th -20th in Fallon, NV at the Fabulous 3C Arena! This event is truly more than just a competition, it is CFDA's Signature Event! 


2024 TOP OF THE YEAR

One of my greatest honors each year is interviewing our Top Guns of the Year. It takes not only a commitment to our sport, but it's also a tremendous challenge to one's own competitive determination and spirit. Yes, we can never forget our **CFDA Motto: "Safety First, Fun Second, and Competition Third."** But just because Competition is third, **we can also never forget that our sport cannot exist without the spirit of friendly, fair and clean competition.**

Top Gun of the Year is certainly a High CFDA Honor and was never meant to be just an attendance award. While it doesn't require attending a majority of our titled championships, you must show up and perform well where it counts most, to have a chance of winning or even making the Top 10. Our World & National Championships are rightfully weighted the heaviest due to the increased level of competition at each.

Afterall, as race legend Dale Earnhardt famously said, "Half of winning is showing up." A few years ago, some of our members started referring to the Top Gun of the Year Buckle as the "\$10,000 Buckle".

Well, maybe it is... But, I think you can spend \$10k on something that means a hell of a lot less, than something that will have meaning for not only the rest of your life, but well after.

Here's a brief history of our CFDA Top Gun of the Year Awards which began in 2007:

In 2007, CFDA only had 7 CFDA Titled Championships. Since this high honor was not meant to be based purely upon attendance, it was originally the Best 4 Point Totals that counted. It was based upon 1 point for every shooter a shooter placed above, + 1, i.e. 1st Place for 50 Shooters = 50 points. However, we found it to be overweighted for World and National Championships and didn't give enough credit for smaller State & Territorial titles as our sport spread and grew.

Today we calculate using the Best 6 Point Totals and have over 20 CFDA Titled Championship from coast to coast to choose from. To learn more about CFDA Top Gun of the Year Point System, please go to: Page 31 in the 12th Edition of the Gunslinger's Guidelines.

2024 Men's Top Gun of the Year- ***Saltwater Cowboy***

QC: *Howdy Saltwater Cowboy! As you may be aware each year it's tradition that I interview our Top Guns of the Year. You did something special this year! You are the first person, man or lady, from our CFDA Eastern*

Territory to win Top Gun of the Year! How do you feel about that?

SC: I really feel great about winning Top Gun of the Year! All the practice really paid off. I was only about to make 7 CFDA Titled Championships and couldn't make the Nationals, so my consistent finishes really helped. I'm really proud to represent the Eastern Territory and be the first to do it. We have some really great shooters here and this is my third year at Fastest Gun Alive, there are so many great shooters out there, it's just almost unbelievable.

QC: *How did you get started in Cowboy Fast Draw?*

SC: My good friend Bayou Jim showed me his Ruger Vaquero and I got really interested how it would be to compete with. I had a lot of experience shooting various types of guns, mainly semi-autos. Then, I found there were several clubs in Central Florida and got really interested. That's where I met 2 Buck Chuck who taught me the fundamentals, he was really my mentor. Then, I went to my first Florida State and I couldn't believe it, I took 4th Place and I was hooked!

QC: *What do you love most about Cowboy Fast Draw?*

SC: Well, it's the people and the organization itself. It's all so welcoming and supporting, it's like one big family. I've never seen such a bunch of friendly folks, even though you might only see them once in a year







QC: *What inspired you to train to become a champion?*

SC: I would really like to win the Florida State Championship and of course winning the Fastest Gun Alive is the Ultimate Goal!

2024 Ladies Top Gun of the Year – Shell Shock

QC: *Howdy Shell Shock! I'll bet you've been waiting for this call since your Mom has won Top Gun of the Year before and probably told you I'd be calling.*

SS: Hi Quick Cal, yes she told me, how are you?

QC: *Thanks I'm doing Fine, well I've been looking forward to this call since you really did something special this year. QC: *What accomplishment are you most proud of?*

SS: Well, I'm really proud of winning some big contests especially the National Championship. But, I think I most proud of winning Top Gun of the Year.

QC: *What is your goal for 2025?*

SS: I took 2nd this year, but I really want to see if I can actually win Fastest Gun Alive!







Give it a try with your favorite dip or sauce, a side salad and you have a fantastic light meal! One of our FAMILY FAVORITES!!

Turkey Club Roulades ~ makes 8

1 lb. Fresh Trimmed Asparagus

Thin Sliced Leftover Cooked Turkey (about 1 lb)

8 Slices Each- Deli Ham, Provolone Cheese(Jack or Swiss works great too), Bacon Strips

½ teaspoon Each- Poultry Seasoning & ½ teaspoon black pepper

2 Tablespoons Dijon-Mayo Blend (Find your favorite at your local store)

Putting Them Together:

Cook asparagus until it's crisp-tender. Set it aside. Lay out turkey slices, layer with Dijon-mayo blend, then layer on top with a slice each of ham, cheese & a spear or two of asparagus (depending on how many you want to make) Sprinkle with a touch of Poultry Seasoning & pepper. Roll up tightly and wrap with a bacon strip, pinwheel style and hold with a toothpick if needed.

Cook Roulades in a large skillet over med-high heat for 13-15 minutes turning not to burn. Cooking it until bacon is nice and crispy and the cheese looks soft and melty. Carefully removing with tongs, laying each on a plate (lined with a paper towel to drain any bacon fat). Use your favorite sauce for dipping. Great any time of the year- just use pre-sliced turkey from the deli for a light quick appetizer for a summertime get together! Enjoy



THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.

SOME OF OUR GOALS

To keep our clothing & equipment such as guns and holsters true to form of the time period that we represent (1873-1899). 1873 is the year that the Colt Peacemaker was introduced.
