INSIDE THE CFDA

Howdy Folks!

Summer is here and what a run of CFDA Titled Championships we've had! This year we began with our Florida State & Eastern Territorial Championships in early February. Our season resumed in mid-March with our Texas & Oklahoma State Championships, held one week apart. Then, beginning in late April the Western U.S. went on a run of California, Oregon, and Nevada State Championships, plus our Great Northwest Territorial Championship all held within a 5-week period! With our Louisiana State & Southern Territorial taking place on the same weekend as the Great Northwest Territorial, both being followed a week later with the Colorado State & 4 Corners Territorial, while a week later our Virginia State Championship happened in our Eastern Territory!

The point is, we held 11 of our 18 CFDA Titled Championships all within 13 weeks, with 11 of them happening within 7 weeks of each other! The run in the Northwestern U.S. with 4 Championships all held within 5 weeks of each other were especially challenging for many of our members since they were all in the same basic geographical region of Northern California, Nevada, Oregon and Idaho that count on the same general area of CFDA members for support.

I receive many comments from our members on a regular basis. Some want things one way and some want the same things completely opposite. That's because we have all types of wonderful members who walk different paths of life. When it comes to the spacing of our championship tournaments, some members like it when they can travel from one match to another with less than a week between, these are most likely retired members who can spend time away from home. While others work for a living and/or are raising children and cannot afford the time and/or expense of traveling to consecutive events.

When CFDA Host Clubs are planning a Titled Championship they must consider who their shooter base is and what kind of other events on CFDA's schedule are planned around it. There are also other critical considerations like facilities, weather, other local events that could cause conflict, holidays, etc. The

three main goals of a successful CFDA Titled Championship are.

1. To run a quality event, so folks will want to come back next year.
2. Draw as many shooters as possible.
3. Balance the Budget – Giving both value to the shooters, while making it a worthwhile and fun experience for the members of the Host Club.

So, how can a Host Club draw the most shooters to their event? They have to consider what type of members make up the majority of the Shooter Base that is in their region. You have to understand that you cannot please everyone, since there are so many lifestyles to consider, you must think of the majority of members. Please don't think that everyone is retired or will plan to attend only your event.

You should try to run your event over the fewest days and tightest schedule possible. Then, especially on Sunday, it's a great idea to schedule your event to wrap up no later than early to mid-afternoon, so not only working folks can get headed back to their busy lives, plus your local members are more likely to help with tear-down and clean-up.

There are basically 4 types of members in our sport.

Type A: (Totally Committed) Some are retired comfortably enough to afford the time and money to travel. There are also those who've become successful enough by either running their own business or have achieved a management position and can plan their time and work schedules around attending our events.

Type B: (Really Committed) These members try to make all our events they can by planning their vacation time and family events around our CFDA schedule whenever they can. They try to make it to enough CFDA Titled Championships to earn points with the goal of making into the Top 10 of CFDA's Top Gun of the Year Awards. They will also likely plan to compete in National & World Championships almost every year.

Type C: (Committed) These folks really love CFDA, but have jobs, economic conditions, or personal commitments that do not allow too much travel. But, they do support clubs, local competitions and do plan their schedules to attend their State and/or Territorial Championships, with the goal of also competing in a National or World Championship whenever they can.

Type D: (Dedicated Local Members) They love CFDA and there is usually a CFDA

Affiliated Club within an hour or two of their home, and they become loyal and supportive members of that club. They attend almost all club functions and may also support other clubs within a few hours of their home club. They often hold an office in their club and when a CFDA Titled Championship is near, they may or may not compete in it. They enjoy it when they do well in a contest, but love our sport, the people, and always have fun no matter how they place.

Type E: (Come and Go Members) They like our sport but are mainly local members. They are supportive at times, but not really that committed to our sport and the principles it's built upon. In most cases they have not competed in a CFDA Titled Championship. They may join a club or CFDA, but if they are not shooting, they will let their memberships expire. They usually don't hang around and help with setup or clean-up. They often became interested in the sport and thought they could really become good at it. But then discovered Cowboy Fast Draw actually requires dedicated practice to achieve success and soon lose interest.

What Type of member are you? Only you can answer that question. Many times people plan and hope to become a more committed member, but life is life for all of us. The important thing is that we should respect and value all of our fellow members, no matter what path they are currently walking through life. There is a special bond that holds us fellow gunfighters together, that only those of us who play our game can understand.

FGA Update

In this Summer Edition of our Gunslinger's Gazette you will find a very important schedule and information on our signature event, the Fastest Gun Alive – World Championship of Cowboy Fast Draw! If you hadn't planned on coming, there is still time to make those plans. Even though it's in the middle of July the FGA is held in a beautiful temperature-controlled building, with non-stop activities from beginning to end. Fallon, NV is a great host city with plenty of reasonably priced motels, quality restaurants and several casinos. Hopefully, we'll see you there!







The historic George Ranch in Richmond, Texas set the stage for the 2025 Texas State Cowboy Fast Draw Championship, a thrilling event that combined competitive spirit, camaraderie, and rich Texan history. Friday: Celebrating Talent Through Category Matches

The event kicked off with the Category Matches on Friday, where participants competed in divisions tailored to age, experience, and skill. Highlights included:

- **Women's Winners:** Golden Girls - Texas Rose, Grand Dame - Grasshopper, Super Senior - Tascosa, Senior Pistol Pearl, 49er's - Still Shot, Traditional - KK Kid, and Junior - Shell Shock, who displayed her shooting prowess despite her age.

- **Celebrity Shoot:** A Taste of the Wild West Friday's Celebrity Shoot brought star power to the range, featuring Richmond's Mayor, Becky Haas, and social media sensation Oli Pettigrew, better known as "That English Man in Texas." Oli, experiencing fast draw for the first time, proved a natural and celebrated his victory with a viral video that introduced new audiences to the excitement of the cowboy fast draw.

Saturday: The Main Match Begins

As Saturday dawned, approximately 60 competitors gathered to begin the Main Match in a 4X format.

Shooters faced off in intense rounds, vying for the top spots. The day ended with a lively banquet at Rudy's Sugar Land, where

participants shared meals, swapped stories, and celebrated the winners of the Category Matches.

Sunday Morning: Bracket Matches Heat Up

The competition intensified on Sunday morning with the Bracket Matches. Divided into four brackets—Deputy, Sheriff, Gunfighter, and Master Gunfighter—the matches resulted in thrilling victories:

- **Deputy Bracket:** 1st place - Blue Moon Rising, 2nd - Moonshine Jack, and 3rd Sunset Rose.
- **Sheriff Bracket:** 1st place - Rebel Yell, 2nd - Das Turdley, and 3rd Rowdy Ron.

The culmination of the championship was the Magnificent 7 Shoot-Off, where the top shooters from the Main Match competed for the ultimate titles. The seeding for the women's magnificent 7 were; 1st Shell Shock, 2nd Scarlett Bandit, 3rd Blue Moon Rising, 4th Still Shot, 5th KK Kid, 6th Tascosa, and 7th Yankee Belled. For the Men our top 7 seeds were 1st Arizona Cactus Kid, 2nd Chief Rn a Muck, 3rd Whip Lash, 4th Marshal Dylan, 5th Old West, 6th Desert Dingo and 7th Ringo Kid.




The backdrop for the event, George Ranch, added a layer of historical significance.

Alotta Lead's Family Favorite Recipes

Are you camping this summer? Whether your Dutch Oven meal is cooked in the oven or over a campfire, nothing is as good as a tasty, delicious casserole. Here's a great one- easy, quick and so good!

"The Works" Campfire Casserole

Here's what you'll need:

- 2 1/2 Cups corn ~ either fresh off the cobb, or frozen
- 1 Cup Peas~ either fresh or frozen
- 1 Cup mushrooms ~ sliced
- 1 Medium Onion ~ diced
- 1 Medium Bell Pepper ~ diced and seeded
- 2 1/2 Cups of Colby-Jack Cheese ~ grated
- 2 lbs. Ground Beef-lean.....or you can use ground chicken or turkey or a little of each!
- 1 Package Egg Noodles ~ at least a 10-15 oz bag of Noodles Uncooked!
- 1 Can Stewed Tomatoes- 28 oz. size can
- Salt & Pepper to taste
- 1/8 teaspoon of garlic powder or granulated garlic
- 1 1/2 Teaspoon Sugar

What's Next:

Get your 5 qt. size Dutch oven heating up over a medium high heat on your stove top. Throw the ground meat in and cooking it thoroughly. Drain any grease off from the meat. Add the corn, mushrooms, onions, bell peppers, and peas, sugar, and salt,pepper, & garlic, stirring well to mix all ingredients. Even out the goodies in the bottom of your Dutch oven. Next take the uncooked noodles and spread them all over the top of the meat mixture. Next, sprinkle all the cheese all over the noodles, then evenly pour the large can of stewed diced tomatoes all over the top of everything! Holy Cow! What a yummy dish. Next you'll put the lid on the pot, turn the heat down to medium-low and cook for about an hour. When the noodle are soft and the pot is bubbling hot and the cheese is melted through, take the lid off, wait a few minutes for it to set a bit and then dig in.. Enjoy!







INTRODUCTION OF THE BOARD

This is the first CFDA Board of Territorial Governors Report that we are publishing. For those new to CFDA or to some of our long-standing members that may not be aware of a major change that has occurred with our Cowboy Fast Draw Association, please allow me provide a brief explanation. For the next 5 paragraphs I will refer to myself in the 3rd person to avoid any misunderstanding.

Since CFDA was founded by Brad Hemmah a.k.a. Kemosabi in 2002, CFDA has been operated as a Limited Liability South Dakota Corporation. First by Kemosabi, until 2006, when a partnership between Quick Cal & Shoot Magazine purchased the organization, soon followed by a buyout by Quick Cal & Alotta Lead in 2007 when Shoot Magazine announced it was going out of business. CFDA, LLC has been run as a family-owned business since 2007.

A few years ago after a family meeting to discuss what would happen to CFDA if something were to happen to Quick Cal or Alotta Lead, or both, it was decided to plan for the future of CFDA. Not only does our entire family love CFDA, but so do our members who have dedicated so much of their lives to help build our sport in so many ways. The fact is, it's the wish of so many that CFDA go on forever!

In early 2024 Quick Cal began the process of forming Cowboy Fast Draw Association, Non-Profit Organization, a Nevada Corporation under the laws of the State of Nevada. On June 6th, 2024 the Domestic Non-Profit Corporation (NRS 82) Charter was issued. Leaving much more work to complete like setting up a new bank account, web-page, registering with State of Nevada employment and tax divisions, and setting up new accounting and payroll services. Also, since CFDA had developed, created and branded crucial products needed to support the sport of Cowboy Fast Draw, these products needed to be separated from the non-profit organization. The Gunslinger Emporium was created for this purpose, so as not to disrupt the primary source of equipment that is so vital to our membership and clubs.

On January 1st, 2025, Quick Cal & Alotta Lead irrevocably granted all membership operations, assets, and intellectual property from CFDA, LLC to CFDA, Non-Profit Corporation. It was also Quick Cal's responsibility to appoint the 1st Board of Territorial Governors, which was carried out by the end of the year. Even numbered Territorial Governors were appointed for only 1-Year and odd numbered Territorial Governors were appointed for a full 2-Year Term. Beginning, in late 2025, the process will begin to bring about a Board that is totally elected by the general membership of CFDA. The Chairman's Term is 4-Years, for which Quick Cal will decide in late 2028 if he will run for election.

It's Quick Cal & Alotta Lead's intention and wish that CFDA will go on in perpetuity for generations to enjoy in the Spirit of the Cowboy Way and keeping the Romance & Legend of the Old West alive in the hearts of so many.

Alotta Lead and I would like to Thank those who are named at the top of this page, who volunteered to serve as our 1st Board of Territorial Governors and who are contributing a great service for the future of OUR Sport of Cowboy Fast Draw.

BOARD OF TERRITORIAL GOVERNORS REPORTS

Initial Setup Board of Territorial Governors Meeting - November 16th, 2024

Quick Cal called for a Initial Meeting to develop some basic procedures for conducting Zoom Meetings and to take action of some a.s.a.p. items.

Item 1: (Action Taken)The Board elected Dead Eye Daisy as the Board's 1st Vice Chairman.

Item 2: (Action Taken) Top Gun Points will Return to a Annual Calendar Format.

For the 2025 awards only. The points for CFDA Titled Championships held after the 2024 FGA will be counted towards the 2025 Top Gun Points Season. Some of these championships may be counted twice. Because of the added contests, the best 8 point totals will be counted, instead of the normal best 6. The number of required State Championship tallied in the total will be raised from 2 to 3 for the 2025 Season only, since the count has been raised from 6 to 8.

For 2026 and Beyond. Top Gun Points will return to the previous Calendar Year Award System for the matches held only within that calendar year, with the (best 6 Point Total Counting and requiring that 2 State Championship Points counts be included in the final total) same as before. Since the season will be ending with the final CFDA Titled Championship of the calendar year each year, within 14 days of the last CFDA Titled Championship, final points will be tallied and published on the CFDA Website and buckles will be ordered. As an added benefit, Top Gun Buckles will now contain the names of the winners. The Top Gun Buckles will be sent

by mail to the winners. The winners and photos will be featured CFDA's Social Media Assets and in the following publication of the Gunslinger Gazette. Since the 2024 Top Gun of the Year Award ended with the 2024 FGA. Points for the 2025 Season will begin with the 1st CFDA Titled Championship.

Item 3: (Discussion Only): Bad Ammo at Contests

The Board agreed to have it placed on the 2025 U.S. Marshal's Muster Agenda for discussion. The Board also recommended that Quick Cal write an article on this subject.

CFDA Territorial Governors Meeting (12-22-24)

Item 1: (Action Taken) Established monthly meetings on 3rd Tuesday of the month at 5 p.m. Pacific Time Zone

Item 2: (Discussion Only) Update on FGA and Quick Cal presented an Event Budget, Board recommended keeping a similar schedule to the 2024 event, but ending the seminars, due to lack of attendance.

Item 3: (Discussion Only) The Board discussed how the CFDA Insurance Policy works, Membership Retention, and Organizational Fund Raising.

Item 4: (Action Taken) Logo Item Sales

After discussing sales tax responsibilities and distribution the Board approved the following motion...

“Quick Cal’s Gunslinger Emporium may sell, either by website or physical retail, CFDA Logo Items beginning January 1st, 2025. With a 10% Royalty on the specific items of Hats, Apparel, Patches, Badges, Decals Cups, License Plate Holders, Round Drawing Cards, Towels, of Flags.

As per CFDA, NPO By-Laws, Gunslinger Emporium shall donate 10% of all retails sales for these products on a quarterly basis to Cowboy Fast Draw, Non-Profit Organization.”

CFDA Territorial Governors Meeting (01/21/25)

Item 1: (Action Taken) Alotta Lead, Director of Club Affairs reported on Annual Club Affiliation & Insurance Program. This is a very busy time in the CFDA Office each year. A number of clubs seem to ignore sending in the Affiliation Agreements until the last minute and with holiday mail a number of them end up late or are not sent until called. A motion was made, seconded and approved as follows:

“Reminder emails will be sent by the CFDA Office to Affiliated Clubs on or before October 15th each year. Affiliation Agreements not received by the CFDA Office by December 1st will be subject to a \$50 Late Penalty.”

Item 2: (Discussion Only) Preliminary CFDA Annual Budget - Executive Director, Quick Cal presented the first CFDA, NPO Preliminary Annual Budget. An update on this preliminary budget will be presented at the end of the 1st Quarter.

Item 3: (Action Taken) CFDA First Aid Program & Policy

From an item and idea that was first initiated by **Wench** at a Marshal's Muster a few years ago. Arizona member **Big Foot** has volunteered to coordinate and develop an official CFDA First Aid Volunteer's Guidelines Program. Big Foot has been appointed Program Director. With the help of his wife **Dazzlin' Daisy and Otto Matic** they have developed the CFDA First Aid Volunteers & Match Director's & Range Master Guidelines, which will be formerly introduced at the 2025 FGA. Board Voted to Approve the CFDA First Aid Program.

CFDA Territorial Governors Meeting (02/18/25)

Item 1: (Action Taken) Approved \$200 for CFDA First Aid Program Identification Cards.

Item 2: (Discussion Only) Report by the Chairman on the Shot Show

The Shot Show is the largest event in the Firearms Industry held annually in Las Vegas. Had meetings with both Ruger and Pietta reps. Pietta has agreed to continue their sponsorship. Ruger has agreed to and signed the CFDA Sponsorship Agreement.

Item 3: (Action Taken) Now that CFDA awards Resident Champions with Official CFDA Buckles, plus back when CFDA used to award FGA Entries to Resident Champions, it has sometimes become an issue to determine the actual residency of some of our members. A motion was made, seconded and approved:

“A valid current state issued Driver's License shall be used to determine residency for the purposes of awarding Resident Championships.”

CFDA Territorial Governors Meeting (03/18/25)

Item 1: (Discussion Only) Discussion regarding limiting exaggerated stances. It's been a common complaint for years by some members that feel there should be some limits to how far a shooter can lean back while in a Firing Line stance. Quick Cal explained the history of trying to regulate stances decades ago in the sport of Fast Draw. Since there are many types of bodies it proved impossible to regulate. The Board's discussion turned to asking Range Masters to be more persistent in checking holster angles and enforcing the rules that already exist.

Item 2: (Action Taken) Blocker Targets at CFDA Affiliated Clubs

A discussion regarding the fact that some affiliated clubs have Blocker Targets, including those clubs that are dual-sanctioned by CFDA & other Fast Draw organizations.

A motion was made, seconded, and approved.

“A CFDA Affiliated Club shall not use Blocker Targets for any CFDA Class C or D event. Clubs may use Blocker Targets for practice, but shall do so while following and enforcing CFDA Safety Rules. According to CFDA’s Club Affiliation Agreement, if a club is dual sanctioned with any other Fast Draw organization, they shall supply their own Insurance Policy since they do not qualify for CFDA’s Insurance Policy. CFDA Targets and Distances are aligned with CFDA Guidelines & Goals, which emphasize the importance of the proper balance of speed and accuracy.”

CFDA Territorial Governors Meeting (04/17/25)

Item 1: (Action Taken) Board Approved by emergency email vote to Approve the 2026 National Championship Agreement for St. Augustine, FL to be held in conjunction with the Florida State Championship (February 5th - 8th)

Item 2: (Action Taken) 1st Quarter Budget Report

Quick Cal presented a review of the 1st Quarter Budget. At this point we are within the Preliminary Budget’s Goals. Board Voted to Approve the 1st Quarter Budget Report.

Item 2: (Discussion Only) Golden Spike Awards have always included Gift Certificates from the CFDA General Store, which no longer exists. The Gunslinger Emporium has agreed to Sponsor the Gift Certificates this year.

Item 3: (Action Taken) Review and Approve the Marshal’s Muster Agenda Item for CFDA Cartridges vs 209 Shotgun Primer Loads. **Marshal’s Muster Agenda Item – Submitted By CFDA Board of Territorial Governors**

“The Board of Territorial Governors would like to initiate a discussion among CFDA’s U.S. Marshals regarding continuing the use of Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges that are loaded using pistol primers and Triple 7 Black Powder Substitute as provided for in CFDA Guidelines, as opposed to phasing in using only 209 Shotgun Primers & CFDA Brass at all CFDA Titled Championships.”

CFDA Territorial Governors Meeting (05/20/25)

Item 1: (Discussion Only) Discussion about establishing a formal procedure for the enforcement of Rule 18. The Board recommended that Quick Cal submit an Agenda Item on this subject to the Marshal’s Muster.

Item 2: (Discussion Only) Alotta Lead proposed a new type of Membership Drive that not only rewards clubs for recruiting members, but also rewards Individuals who Recruit Members. More to come on this proposal.

Farewell to John August Taffin (1939 – 2025) a.k.a. Six Gunner - CFDA Life Member #24

John Taffin was an American author who wrote numerous columns for Guns, Gun Digest, Sixgunner, American Handgunner, and Shoot Magazine. He was a math teacher for 31 years, between 1964 to 1995, his math skills lead to his love of the study of firearm ballistics.

He lived in the Boise, ID area and was invited to his first Cowboy Fast Draw contest in 2004 by the Editor of Shoot Magazine, Andy Fink a.k.a. Chucky (CFDA Life #3). He attended and competed in some of the local CFDA events with his 7-1/2” Revolver, his favorite gun. Reports are that he never missed a shot. He was a pleasant man who always loved to talk guns. CFDA members should know that our Shootist Category was created in his honor.



THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western Cowboy, Rodeo or Working Cowboy, Victorian Steam-punk clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Cowboy Hats for Men. No short-sleeve or t-shirts, tennis shoes, or baseball style hats are allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live

ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.

SOME OF OUR GOALS

To keep our clothing & equipment such as guns and holsters true to form of the time period that we represent (1873-1899). 1873 is the year that the Colt Peacemaker was introduced.
