### Inside The CFDA

with very limited connections.

We decided to move it to Fallon, NV in 2008 after considering 3 other locations and Fallon has been a great Host City ever since! We began holding FGA at the Churchill County Fairgrounds Rodeo Arena, then suddenly moved it to their park in 2014 after the rodeo grounds flooded. We also moved the event from July to October because it's just too darned hot to hold outdoor events like ours in July in Fallon. For about half the years we enjoyed some weekends with perfect weather. Although, some years we had a mixture very cold mornings, high winds, extreme heat, thunderstorms, and sometimes enough rain to the point we had to bail out ranges with buckets. To everyone's credit, we would just "cowboy up" and get through it.

I believe everyone who has been to FGA during the past 4 years really do enjoy shooting and participating in our evening events all within a first-class indoor temperature-controlled facility. Our 2022 & 2023 FGA events were in October and turned out great! We never planned on changing the dates from early October.

Then, about six weeks before the 2023 FGA, Dead Eye Kid and I were there having a planning meeting with 3C Arena Management. When I mentioned securing the dates for our 2024 FGA, they told us that they could no longer guarantee us dates in the Fall, because they were under negotiations with several Rodeo events that pay around \$40k for 4-day events. Apparently, the 3C Arena had become a very sought after venue, especially during the Fall months leading up to the National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas every December. We knew we could not afford a \$40k venue and were very disappointed. We needed time to consider a new date that our members could depend on and plan their schedules well in advance.

Now that we are a Non-Profit Organization, I don't mind sharing some facts about producing FGA. I think everyone can agree that we are not willing to leave the 3C Arena and go back to being an outdoor event at the fairground park, unless we can no longer afford the rent at the 3C Arena. Raising Entry Fees hundreds of dollars in order to afford a \$40k facility, is also a non-starter.

Our members should know that the total budget for FGA is almost \$70k. <u>Here are Some of the Expenses:</u>

Over \$24k in Prize Money, 140 Category Buckles, 10 Prize Guns, over 50 Main Match Buckles, about 200 Gold Pan Awards, 30,000 rounds of Wax Ammo, providing and setting up 5 – Six-Lane Ranges, the 3C Arena's rent is \$5,500, plus rent for tables, chairs and trash that costs about another \$2k for a total of \$7,500., key-staff support, and many other things.

The City of Fallon's Convention & Tourism Authority heavily supports CFDA with a generous \$14,500 Grant! Grants are not just handed out, you have to work for them, fill out the applications, attend meetings and hope that they are awarded by the board of commissioners. Then you must file follow-up reports to receive the funds. The City of Fallon is a

pleasure to deal with since we've established a long track record with them, plus they love our event.

Anyone with a simple calculator can figure out that even with this grant and entry fees collected there is not enough income generated to entirely fund this event, especially when we end up with less than 225 paid Entry Fees. So, how does it happen?

With the help and support of a lot of dedicated volunteers who love our sport including every member of my family, the Great Basin Gun Hawks, and a number of CFDA members from across our country, who show up and help out in many ways. It also takes dedicated Sponsors like Pietta of Italy, Ruger, Mernickle Holsters, DOH Leather, Break-thru Beverage, Gunslinger Emporium, and the Holiday Inn Express. I believe every member of CFDA should consider supporting not only our FGA Sponsors, but also advertisers in our Gunslinger's Gazette, whenever choosing to purchase any item you use for our sport. Please support those who support

Back to 2023, after learning that we could no longer count on dates in the Fall and giving it a lot of thought, we first tried to announce the 2024 FGA for early August, but after considering comments about conflict with college and school-years beginning in some states, we changed it to 4th Weekend in July. Just before the 2024 FGA, Jesse, the manager of the 3C Arena, proposed an idea to bring to the Board of the Churchill County Fairgrounds. Please understand that this board is responsible to make huge bond payments that made this facility possible. The Board agreed to not raise our rent because Jesse proposed an agreement that was only available to CFDA. Why? It was based upon two very important factors:

First, our longstanding relationship with the fairgrounds and how we are a highly responsible group, have always respected their facilities and leave them in as good of condition as we find them.

Second, the 3C Arena Staff works sometimes weeks in a row with very long hours and hardly any days off, especially during the Spring. Most of their staff wanted to take time off for 4th of July Weekend and the few weeks after to plan vacations and spend time with their families. This provides a muchneeded break just before getting into a long-run of events that begin later in July that stretch through most of the Fall.

Jesse explained that his entire staff believes that we are the only group that they feel they can trust "hand the keys of the place to" and not have to worry about the facility. They just keep a minimal cleaning crew and a few key staff members on call in case they are needed. The Board of Commissions approved a 4-year contract for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Weekend in July. So now, "That You All Know the Rest Story." Please plan your schedules and support CFDA's Signature Event!

Now, we look forward to our 2025 CFDA National Championship, Hosted by the Sundowners at the beautiful Shelterwood Ranch in Oroville, CA. If you haven't taken part in this event over the past few years, you should consider going.

The 2026 CFDA National Championship will be held in St. Augustine, FL along with the Florida State Championship February 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>. We're excited! This will be the first CFDA National Championship held East of the Mississippi River! If any CFDA Affiliated Club or group of Clubs are considering hosting the 2027 National Championship they might want to contact our office and let us know.

#### Top Gun of the Year Points

After this year's National Championship in Oroville we have no more CFDA Titled Championships scheduled for the rest of this year. This will bring our 2025 Top Gun Point Season to a great ending! We'll then order the buckles for the Top 10 Men & Women, however this time as an added benefit, the winner's aliases will be engraved onto the buckles. From now on our Top Gun Points are on an annual basis, which means after the last championship of any calendar year the Top Gun Results will be published and buckles will be ordered and sent directly to the winners. This year we are also able to go back to awarding Ruger Vaqueros to the our Men's and Ladies' Top Gun of the Year, since Ruger came back as a sponsor this year.

#### Fastest Gun Alive 2026

The date has been set for July 15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 once again at the Fabulous 3C Arena, in Fallon, NV. We still receive some comments from some of our members who would rather have the FGA moved back to October again. I do understand how none of us really like to change from something that has become a tradition. Therefore I would like to take this opportunity to explain why this change was necessary. First, I would like to share a little history about how FGA ended up in Fallon, NV in October in the first place.

CFDA's World Championship was originally held in Deadwood, SD for 5 years, in conjunction with the annual Wild Bill Hickok Days, during the month of July. As much as we all love any opportunity to visit Deadwood, the season there is very short for outdoor events which resulted in expensive hotels, even then. Also, the nearest airport in Rapid City is 90-minutes away, airline tickets were also high priced

For instance, some of the most requested sites are: CFDA Titled Sanctioned Event Agreements, also CFDA Club AFFILIATION forms. You'll find the results of a CFDA Titled Championship, the Hall of Recognition, also the CFDA LIFE Member/Alias list. This is just a small sample of what you can find on our CFDA website. However, if you have exhausted all avenues trying to find something and you're at wits end, please feel free to contact us. We're here if you need us.

To navigate where you want to go, please let me explain. First jump on the CFDA Website, you'll see across the top of the home page different "Departments" to explore i.e., Match Results, Hall of Recognition, Upcoming CFDA Titled events, Forms to Download, etc. Figure out where you want to go, put your mouse curser on the heading-don't click on it, as a box will drop down - go into that box and click on what you want to explore. SCROLL **DOWN** from there and you'll find everything in that section, from top to bottom. Some folks don't scroll down all the way to the bottom of the page, where they might find what they're looking for. Same with "Upcoming CFDA Events" put your curser on that heading, (don't click) the drop box will drop down, click on what you want and SCROLL down. **Pallon, Nevada** – The Fastest Gun Alive is more than just the World Championship of Cowboy Fast Draw, it's the gathering of the very essence of our sport. It's as much of a convention as it is a competition for many reasons.

#### Wednesday

We begin on Wednesday by gathering the leaders of our sport to first compete in a team-building event called the Marshal's Cup, only open to voting U.S. Marshals or their Deputies, CFDA Regulators, and the CFDA Board of Territorial Governors. Afterwards, we spend the afternoon in a series of three very important meetings.

#### U.S. Marshal's Cup Standings

- 1st Tin Bender (AL)-Bender's Bandits
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Cowboy Up (CA) The Deputies
- 3rd Ranger Reeves (NV) Great Basin Gun Hawks
- 4<sup>th</sup> Saltwater Cowboy (FL) The Open Range Regulators
- 5th Desert Dingo (UT) Promontory Point Posse

Annual U.S. Marshal's Muster - Where U.S. Marshals discuss and vote on various published agenda items mainly having to do with rules and procedures for competitions. We also discuss various sport-wide matters like building club and CFDA memberships. CFDA Regulators and Territorial Governors are also invited to attend to observe and advise and do not vote, unless they are also a U.S. Marshal representing an affiliated club.

CFDA Regulators - At the conclusion of the Marshal's Muster, the CFDA Regulators gather to discuss various Range Officer Program Training issues and ideas. They discuss and comment on various opinions mainly about competition and safety rules that they heard from the U.S. Marshal's Muster and then state their opinions regarding changing any rules.

CFDA Board of Territorial Governors – At the conclusion of the CFDA Regulators Meeting, the Board of Territorial Governors meet to discuss everything they heard during the prior two meetings. 2025 marks the first year of the Board of Territorial Governors, which is now the ultimate decision making committee of CFDA. Although we meet monthly by Zoom Meetings, this is our only scheduled face-to-face meeting of the year. This year there was no agenda, since it was mainly to discus and deliberate about what we learned from the two previous meetings.

Gathering of Gunfighters – is our opening evening social event where gunfighters from across CFDA meet friends and celebrate their arrival at the Fastest Gun Alive!

Old Drifter's CFDA Shoot for the Stars – Texas Hold'em Tournament – Where many of our gunfighters and families gather for a fun evening and to raise funds for our favorite charity, Shoot for the Stars Scholarship Foundation.

#### Thursday

Registration - This is no doubt the busiest day and the best time to acknowledge our CFDA Scoring Team. Wild Shot, Ubet, Lady Heather, and Bean Counter do a remarkable job throughout our tournament! With the help of Guido B during registration they get everyone entered or checked in and ready to go! Then, we have volunteers like Etta Mae

and Crystal J, who even though they didn't shoot, help out full-time at Scoring Tables. Plus, we always appreciate all of the shooters who step up to Range Master, Announce and Write Scores through our entire event as needed. This is the essence of what makes any tournament run efficiently and on time!

Quick and the Dead – We start Thursdays each year with this fun event! It's a 1-X – "Shoot Till You Hit" format that we bill as "The Closest Thing You Will Experience to a Real Gunfight!". This year it came down to two of our fastest gunfighters squaring off in the final

round with *Perk* (TX) winning 1<sup>st</sup> Place Quick and half of all of the entry fees, with the other half going to Shoot for the Stars.

In the spirit of perhaps the most famous 20th Century gunfighter, *Bill Jordan*, who named his most noted book, "*No Second Place Winner*", we presented *AZ Cactus Kid* with a Gold Pan Award named 1<sup>st</sup> Place Dead. For folks who have questioned why an award would bear such a name, *now* 

you know the rest of the story, since according to Mr. Jordan there is no second place winner in a gunfight.

**World Category Championship** – We had 15 aged-based categories this year competing for Top 10 Buckles and 3 Gold Pan recognized places in a 2-X – Nevada 8 Format.

**Side Matches** – Our Triple 7 Challenge & Double Trouble Side Matches opened late morning, more fun for those wanting to shoot for more FGA Gold Pans and even some cash, in another Shoot for the Stars Fund Raiser. Nevada Smith was our Side Match Director.

**Tournament of Champions** – The Category Match ran so efficiently we were able to begin our Tournament of Champions preliminary rounds an hour earlier, so we made it a 3-X, 3 Winning Hits Format. The rounds went quickly since these are all champion shooters and we were down to our Fabulous 5 Men's & Ladies in a short time in preparation for our Championship Shoot-offs on Saturday afternoon.

**Our Annual Life Members Reception** - began with a theme of Western TV and Hollywood Heroes. There were a number of folks that really dressed their parts as we enjoyed an evening of fun!

Friday

Opening Ceremonies – Always a special event at FGA, beginning with our Color Guard from *Marine Corp High Desert League 762*, based in Fallon. During the presentation of our National Flag, we were treated once again with our National Anthem, sung by our very own *Shell Shock* (TX)! Then as we removed our hats again and bowed our heads, *Yosemite Sean* (CA) led us in our morning prayer. Next, the Shooter's Meeting, followed by lining up for our annual photo, by our Official Photographer, *Still Shot* (AZ).

Day 1 of FGA Main Match – We call it, "Pick'em up and Put'em Down Day!" Our goal always is to make 7 Rounds and be done in time so folks can get ready, go out for dinner, then come back to the 3C Arena for our evening events. So, we have no scheduled lunch, but have Sissy's BBQ standing by to serve lunch to shooters on the run. We have 5 – Six Lane Ranges running continuously to get it done. This year things ran so smooth that we were easily done by about 3:30.

**Awards Ceremony** – On Friday Night, the first thing at 6:30 we award are our shooters for the results of our Category World Championship & Side Matches. We awarded over 130 Buckles and over 80 Gold Pans.

**Shoot for the Stars Annual Auction** – We had another great evening of fund raising by auctioning off many wonderful items donated by generous members and supporters of CFDA. *Montana* volunteered to be our auctioneer with several members standing up and helping out.

Long Branch Saloon – Sponsored in part by Breakthru Beverage and managed by *Ranger Reeves & Philippine Red* of DOH Lightning Speed Holsters. The drinks are free, all we ask for is donations for Shoot for the Stars.

**Gunfighter's Ball** – Back by popular demand we had for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year the **Southern Rock Group** – **Battleground!** Who rocked us with great music until 10 p.m. We also had **Northern Nevada Imaging** on-site taking and processing immediately available photographs for a nominal fee for all of our gunfighters dressed in their finest.

Saturday

**Day 2 of FGA Main Match** – We began the action with Round 8 and for those who received their 4<sup>th</sup> – X during that round, they were invited

to sign-up for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance Match.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance Match - Began soon after on Ranges D & E where we also installed 11' Firing Lines. We shoot our 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance Match with 17" Targets @ 11', which is almost identical to the 24" Targets @ 15', which was a very popular distance in the past for what we called "Grip-it & Rip-it" Side Matches. These targets and distances are both published in our rulebook as "Exhibition Distances.".

The Main Match continued down to our Magnificent 7 Men & Ladies. Since our Mag 7 Youth are usually determined on our Friday rounds, all Youth Shooters are invited to compete in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance Shoot, free of charge.

Saturday Shoot-offs - After our 2nd Chance Match is completed, it's time for our Saturday Main Match Sub-Category World Champion Shoot-offs which feature our Top 5 Junior Boys & Girls and our Top 5 Men & Lady Shootists. We also conduct the Fabulous 5 Shoot-offs to crown our Men & Ladies Champions of the Tournament of Champions. We had a good crowd of spectators this year for these exciting events.

#### Saturday Night - CFDA Annual Awards

This is a very special evening where we gather to recognize and honor the achievements of our CFDA Family. We also have a few drawings for six-guns that were provided by our sponsors Pietta of Italy and Ruger.

Top Hand Awards – These special awards are presented by CFDA to those who are nominated by their CFDA Affiliated Clubs across the country. These are the folks that make our sport possible by contributing their time and talent to support their local clubs. Not only do the recipients receive these awards, they are also enshrined each year into our online Hall of Recognition.



This award goes to a special person or couple that have had a major impact on our sport on a regional or national level. The recipient of this award is chosen by a poll of past recipients.

Both Wild Shot and Lefty Lipscomb are gracious competitors and always willing to help out wherever they go. Wild Shot has contributed his dedication, time and talent to so many matches with his

knowledge of the CFDA Scoring Program. Wild Shot also graciously oversees the calculating and recording of the Top Gun Points. Not only does he volunteer to do the actual scoring at many events, but always can be counted on to help and give advice wherever he goes.

Lefty Lipscomb is the most winningest shooter in CFDA history having won over 40 CFDA Championship Titles. She's also a Range Master and always willing to help wherever needed.

Awards for Top 25 Men & Top 20 Ladies – We then present Gold Pans and Prize Money for our recognized Main Match Placing. Followed by the Official Announcement Magnificent 7 Men, Ladies & Youth

#### Sunday

Cowboy Church - Many of us join Yosemite Sean for services to start our final day at FGA

Bracket Matches - We begin our competition with what we call the "Blast For Cash" Bracket Match. We had 4 Brackets that are set-up based upon actual times recorded in the Main Match. This year we had just under 50 Shooters in each Bracket. We award Gold Pans and Cash down to 5th Place, with a Pietta Great Western II & \$250 for 1st Place.

Bracket Matches are the key to providing everyone who attends FGA no matter what their speed level, a competitive opportunity.

#### **Magnificent 7 Finals**

We had a great crowd and live streamed the Magnificent 7 Finals. While I won't write a play-by-play account this year, here are some of the highlights.

**Youth-** *Gunslinger Jon* (AZ) began the shoot-offs as 7<sup>th</sup> Seed and won his first two rounds

and lost his 3rd Round against Six Gun Shelbs (NV), which moved him to

the 1-X Bracket on Lanes 3 & 4. He then went on an amazing run all the way into the Championship Round(s) with Top Seed *Night Hawk* (CA) who had won the "cat-bird seat".

**Gunslinger Jon** won the first Championship Round to extend the match into the Final Championship

Round, they switched lanes, where *Night Hawk* jumped to a 2-0 lead, then with a final shot of a .477, he won his first **Youth World Championship!**

Ladies – Dead Eye Daisy (MI) has won amazingly the last 3 FGA's and did make the Mag 7 as our 7<sup>th</sup> Seed. She displayed her typical champion level of calmness under pressure, but in the

end she took a notable 6th Place. But never count her out, she'll return next year.

4th Seed – *Honey Bucket* (CA) came into the shoot-offs and won her first two rounds, then lost in her third round to *Bandana Kid* (AZ). Then *Honey Bucket* went on a run holding onto the 1-X Bracket where she met *Bandana Kid* again in the Semi-Final Round. This time *Honey*

Bucket prevailed placing Bandana Kid in 3<sup>rd</sup> Place and earning her spot into the Championship Round(s) taking on #1 Seed Shell Shock (TX).

Shell Shock is our current National Champion and Top Gun of the Year, she was also runner-up at FGA last year, can she hold all 3 Major Titles in our sport at the same time? How rare is that?

Honey Bucket won the first Championship Round hitting 3 out of 4, averaging in the low 5's, with Shell Shock hitting only one shot. They switched lanes for the Final Championship Round. Honey Bucket jumped to a 1-0 lead with a .492. But then, Shell Shock found the target nailing two

.397's in a row, then winning her first Fastest Gun Alive - World Championship with a final hit of a .426!



Men – The Mag MAGNIFICENT 7 MEN'S SEEDING

7 Finals at FGA usually has 2 or 3 shooters that shoot in the 4's. This year, almost all of our finalists were shooting 3's, except for one, that was me *Quick Cal*. Plus, for the first time ever we had two Shootists that made the Top 7.

We began with last year's runner up *Arizona Cactus Kid* (AZ) and the winner of the **Quick and the Dead** *Perk* (TX), with *Quick Cal* taking on the winner. We all ended up in 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> which is still a great honor. 4<sup>th</sup> Seed, *Dos Vaqueros* (AZ), who surprised everyone last year as a new shooter who made the Mag 7 Finals as a Shootist,

didn't disappoint, he came in shooting consistent mid-3's and won 3 rounds in a row sending *Rango* to a 4<sup>th</sup> Place Finish, and then sending 2<sup>nd</sup> Seed **Stampede** (CA) to the 1-X Bracket.

Our Top Seed and defending FGA Men's World Champion *Oregon Ranger* (OR) stepped to the firing line, who for the first time ever was competing with a long-gun as a **Shootist!** *Dos Vaquero* jumped to a 1-0 lead, but then *Oregon Ranger* found the target the next 3 our of 4 shots at a .35 average, winning the "catbird seat"!

**Dos Vaqueros** then moved to Lanes 3 & 4 to take on one of our fastest, **Stampede**, once again. **Stampede** won the first shot with a .335 to **Dos Vaquero's** .343, but **Dos Vaqueros** nailed the next 3 out of 4 and won the honor of competing in the

Championship Round(s), *Stampede* ended up 3<sup>rd</sup>.

This has never happened at any CFDA Titled Championship in history! Both shooters in the Championship Round(s) were Shootists, shooting those "Big Irons on Their Hips"! Dos Vaqueros won the first shot with a blazing .352 to Oregon Ranger's .354, the crowd roared with excitement! But then, Oregon Ranger won the final 3 shots .344, .344, .339, to win his amazing 9th CFDA FGA World Championship, and he did it with a Long Gun!!!

## The Original "DIRTY HARRY"

### **Arizona Lawman Harry Wheeler**

You would be hard pressed to find anyone who has not seen or at least heard of the classic movie character Inspector Harry Callahan, better known as "Dirty Harry". Portrayed by the handsome and renowned actor Clint Eastwood, he lit up the big screen with his many bold, loud and incredible shootouts, most performed with his now famous Smith & Wesson Model 29 SA/DA revolver chambered in the hefty 44 magnum caliber. It was considered at the time to be "the most powerful handgun in the world!"

The famous character provided numerous highlighted one-liners that we have all heard that are hard to be surpassed from this series of four intriguing movies. Critics and fans alike found his portrayal of a ruthless San Francisco lawman to be both troubling yet exciting at the same time.

I propose for your consideration that the Eastwood character was not the

original "Dirty Harry", at least not in real life. There is one specific historical figure that should be considered for this "honorary" title with that being Arizona Lawman Harry Wheeler. However, there was nothing "dirty" about how this officer performed his duties but his similar results were no less as deadly as those of Inspector Callahan's. One of Wheeler's most famous quotes is that "I will never be the first to fire", which undoubtedly put his life in extreme danger in each of his several lethal-ending confrontations.

Harry Wheeler started his Arizona Law Enforcement career in July, 1903 when he joined the Arizona Rangers with a force consisting of only 26 men. This bold and daring group of officers was formed in 1901 to help quell the out control crime that was engulfing the state at that time. Harry was a very proper, handsome former military man who performed his duties with

integrity and by the book, only exerting lethal force when absolutely necessary.

The first time he had to draw his weapon in self defense while protecting the innocent happened in Tucson, Arizona on October 23, 1904. Wheeler, who had risen through the ranks to the position Sergeant, was dining at Wanda's Restaurant when two men approached the nearby Palace Saloon

intent on holding up the place as well as its customers. One of the would be victims M.D. Beebe escaped out the front door and came across the young lawman as he left the diner on Congress Street just before the clock struck midnight. Beebe informed the Ranger that a robbery was taking place inside the saloon owned by future Deputy U.S. Marshal Marcus Navares and advised the officer "Don't go in there". Wheeler promptly blurted out his own famous line "It's all right, that is what I am here for!"

The fearless Arizona Ranger swiftly entered the saloon drawing his Colt Single Action 45 Colt revolver which at the time was one of the most powerful handguns in the world. With one highwayman outlook stationed outside, the insider robber Joe Boswick attempted to shoot the entering Wheeler before the officer was able to fire his gun as they both proceeded to trade multiple rounds with each other. However, the ill-fated outlaw wound up getting the worst of their fiery exchange. A first glazing shot struck him on the forehead and then the gunfight finished with the eventual fatal Ranger bullet to his chest. I guess this dead robber wasn't a "lucky punk" in this case after all. The other robber lookout escaped and was never captured. When questioned after the incident, Wheeler expressed sincere regret about the occurrence and told a local newspaper reporter that "it was either his life or mine!" Unfortunately, this would not be the last time this real life "Dirty Harry" would have to discharge his weapon that would end the life of a wanted criminal.

A second deadly incident would befall our "Dirty Harry" hero in Benson, Arizona on Thursday, February 28, 1907 with the aggressor meeting his eventual demise. Arizona Ranger Lieutenant Harry Wheeler was in Benson in assistance to his Captain when he was approached about a personal matter. D.W. Silverton and his wife were being stalked by his wife's disgruntled ex-lover, J.A. Tracy. Wheeler was shown a photograph of Tracy and began his search for the man immediately and saw the man sitting on the steps of a dining car at the train station. As Wheeler walked toward him, Tracy saw Silverton and Wife come out of the hotel and began threatening them and pull out a wicked looking revolver. Wheeler yelled "Lieutenant Wheeler arrests you. Give me that gun!" Tracy began shooting at the lawman with the Ranger returning fire and telling the crazed man to surrender. Wheeler's aim was direct and harsh hitting the assailant four times with one under the heart, one in the neck, one in the arm and the last one in the thigh. Unfortunately, Harry did not escape unscathed being hit in the upper left thigh near the groin. Back then Colt 45 revolvers were only carried with fives rounds with an open round over the cylinder for safely reasons. Wheeler approached to make his arrest, Tracy fired off two more rounds hitting Harry in the left heel. Out of bullets in his gun, Wheeler hurled a couple of nearby rocks at his assailant until his gun too was empty. The limping severely wounded officer was able to subdue the would-be assassin and place him under his arrest. J.A. Tracy would not survive his wounds but said that "he held no

ill will toward the determined Ranger."

While recovering from his wounds, Wheeler expressed his thoughts on the Benson gunfight in a letter to his good friend and fellow officer, Pima County Sheriff Nabor Pacheco. "It comes back plainly to me, more plainly now, but though I was right and could not have done otherwise, still there is sorrow in my heart at the thought of Tracy that will not soon wear away."

Captain Harry Wheeler later was said to have taken another life when he

and a fellow sheriff were ambushed at night by illegal liquor bootleggers. He used his Winchester lever action 30-40 Krag rifle to return fire at the flashes from the rifles of the outlaws, whose bullet filled bodies were discovered the next day.

Lawman Harry Wheeler would own and use a precursor to Inspector Callahan's iconic Smith and Wesson model 29 44 magnum revolver when joined the World War I fight as Captain in the United States Army in March 1918. He carried a blued 6 1/2" Smith & Wesson SA/ DA action revolver in the British caliber of 455 Eley or also named 455 Colt which his heirs still have today.




Lawman Harry C. Wheeler's World War One Smith & Wesson SA/DA 455 Eley/455 Colt revolver circa 1918

So there you have it. Was there a real life "Dirty Harry" in Arizona history? I believe so and his name was Harry C. Wheeler, one of the most revered and respected lawman in the state's history and undoubtedly able numerous times to "make his day!"

It's been a busy year here at CFDA Headquarters during our first year of CFDA, Non-Profit Organization. This year is all about learning the best methods of how to manage both our current and future of our sport. I would like to thank our first Board of Territorial Governors, we should all appreciate their commitment to step up and play a major role in providing experience and guidance in this reformation of CFDA.

#### Marshal's Muster Recap

Since my last report in the last issue of the Gunslingers' Gazette we had our annual Marshal's Muster at FGA. At our August Board Zoom Meeting we reviewed and discussed the "Draft Minutes" and the Board made some Final Decisions, Actions in "Blue" have been Approved by the Board

Here is a brief of the results: (The full Marshal's Minutes are available for review at CowboyFastDraw.com)

Item 4A. Holsters are considered damaged when the Front Cut of the Boot fails to meet the 1-1/4" Rule. Damaged Holsters may be repaired with permanent material similar to the holster's original material. Repairs must not add another layer to the original contour of the holster.

Item 4B. Event Wrist Bands shall be the official method of marking holsters during Equipment Checks. Try to use colors that blend in as much as possible so as not to detract from our western-theme.

Item 5. RE: Audible or Visual Start Signal Indications. No Action Taken

Item 6. Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges (Powder Behind Wax) will be Phased Out in 3-years, 2028 will be the final season.

Item 7. RE: TV Rule 18. Warnings for the same TV Violation will be suspended after 2 Warnings, when it comes to the attention of Match Officials. Afterwhich, it will immediately become Loss of Shot, then Loss of Round.

Item 8. RE: CFDA mandating certain Youth Awards. Although Youth Shooters certainly deserve recognition, it should always be left to the Host Club to determine what the awards should be. Reason: Some areas have active Youth Shooters and some have very few or none at all, and that CFDA should not mandate certain Youth Award Requirements.

Item 9. Wide Triggers may now be installed in any single action revolver, as long as the triggers stay within the place of both sides of the trigger guard.

Item 10. RE: A round cannot be won with a TV Warning. No Action Taken

#### **CFDA Territorial Map Changes**

At the August Board of Territorial Governors Zoom Meeting, the Board approved changes to the CFDA Territorial Map. This map has been adjusted in the past to keep up with both territorial membership counts and affiliated club locations. Please See: The new 2026 Territorial Map that will take affect beginning on January 1st, 2026.

These changes will better balance the travel miles and membership counts in each territory. The main changes are the Eastern Territory has been divided into the Great Lakes and Southern Territories, since we have some new clubs and activity in the Northeastern U.S. and Lake Michigan was considered a better line of division. The High Plains and Great Plains have been combined into the Great Plains Territory where we also included Minnesota, Wisconsin and Illinois. We also moved Montana & Wyoming to the Great Northwest.

#### **Elections for 2026 Board of Territoiral Governors**

The month of September is our official Nomination Period for our Annual Board of Territorial Governors Elections. According to CFDA, NPO By-laws, odd numbered Territories will have elections for their Governors during odd numbered years. While even numbered Territories will have elections for their Governor in even numbered years.

Therefore, the Nomination Period for Territorial Governors representing Odd Numbered Territories, according to the New Updated 2026 Territorial Map, begins on September 1st and will end on October 1st for Territories #1, #3, #5, and #7.

Please read the following sections for details on both Nominations & Elections.

#### Nomination & Voting Procedures (Per CFDA, NPO By-Laws)

- 1. Odd Numbered Territories shall hold Territorial Governor Elections during odd numbered year. Whereas, Even Numbered Territories shall hold their elections during even numbered years.
- 2. The term of all Territorial Governors shall be 2-Years, beginning on January 1st following their election.
- 3. The Executive Director or appointee shall administrate both nominations and elections as follows:

#### A. Nominations

- 1. Nominations will begin on September 1st and end on October 1st.
- 2. General Voting Members are defined as Life Members, Primary Members and Spouse or Significant Other Members, that are at least 18 years old.
- 3. A Territorial Governor Candidate must be a CFDA Life Member and reside in the Territory they will represent.
- 4. Territorial Governors must be both nominated and elected by General Voting Members who reside in the Territory that they seek to represent.
- 5. Each nominee shall be contacted and must sign a Pledge to uphold Article 7 Goals and Mission as published within the By-Laws of CFDA, NPO and, verbally or in writing, accept the nomination before being placed on any ballot.

#### **Important: How to Nominate (Two Methods)**

1. Send a Letter of Nomination to CFDA Headquarters addressed:

- 2. Or: Email a nomination to: Info@CowboyFastDraw.com Include on Subject Line: Official Nomination
- 3. You must State your Alias, CFDA #, and Territory on nominations.

#### **B. Elections:**

- The Executive Director or appointee shall prepare ballots and mail ballots to General Voting Members for each Territory by October 15th each year.
- 2. Official Ballots must be returned and received to the appointed mailing address by no later than November 30th.
- 3. The Executive Director shall appoint 2 CFDA Members in good standing and reputation to count the Official Ballots, under the supervision of the Executive Director. The count will then be certified by the Executive Director and stored for not less than 2 years.
- 4. Results will be published on CFDA Social Media Assets, including Facebook and CFDA Website, and then published in the next edition of the Gunslinger's Gazette.
- 5. If an elected Territorial Governor changes residence outside of the Territory they were elected to represent during their term, upon notification or knowledge by other means of this fact, the Chairman is authorized to announce that the office is vacated. Then, within 2 weeks the Chairman shall appoint a replacement Territorial Governor with the advice and majority consent of the Board.

Thank you to each and every club that worked so hard bringing in new members. We appreciate you all. It takes time, dedication and effort to grow your club. The bigger, the better, right?



We hold a Federal Firearms License (FFL). We only ship (usually USPS) and transfer firearms to other FFL Dealers, which costs \$35 per gun. It is up to the purchaser to choose their FFL Dealer and supply contact information when they order their firearm. CFDA will contact the FFL Dealer to obtain necessary documents. After receiving payment we will then ship the firearm to your FFL Dealer, who will then be responsible to have you fill out the appropriate forms and conduct a background check, according to Federal and your State Laws and Regulations. Please allow up to 2 weeks for CFDA to prepare your firearm for shipping.

The buyer is responsible to pay all transfer fees, background checks directly to their FFL Dealer of choice. All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. A refund of the sale will be made, minus the original \$35 shipping fee and a 5% re-login/re-stocking fee.





#### THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

#### THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

#### Ammunition

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

#### TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center) 24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center) Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

#### Competition Timers

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

#### SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

#### CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.
