

WELCOME to the 2026 Keystone State and Great Lakes Championships! The Keystone Gunslingers are excited to announce the first ever State Match in the Keystone State of PA. Thursday September 24th through Sunday September 27th at the Venango County Fair Grounds.

Located in the Historic Franklin PA. The Fairgrounds are located in NW Pa approx. 60 minutes North of Pittsburgh, 60 minutes South of Erie PA. Franklin was rooted in the American Revolutionary War, and later one of the major cities in the late 1850's Oil Boom after the first successful commercial oil well in nearby Titusville Pa. From the oil-era boom brought great wealth, with significant architecture including many Victorian era homes and commercial structures that still remain today. Franklin's downtown Liberty Street was named one of the "Great Streets of America" in 2010. It's truly small-town America and We welcome you to visit our proud region and experience Western Pa during its best time of year. The trees and river valley will be in full fall change, that simply provide some of the most beautiful scenery possible. The temperature will be in the high 60's to high 70's with low humidity. It just doesn't get much better than that.

Event Information

The events will be at Venango County 4H Fairgrounds. There is a full restaurant on location for lunch and dinner options. There is also camping available on location. All camping spots are \$20/per night and are paid directly to the Keystone Gunslingers, (Buffalo Joe). Sights have water and electricity with dump stations on location.

We will be shooting indoors with plenty of room for our participants and their guest. Tables and chairs will be available as well. No need for tents.

We will provide water for shooters and their guests in the shooter's area at no charge. We will not take a lunch break during the matches. Food and beverages will be welcomed in the shooter's area. There will be lunch options available provided by Country Grub located at the fairgrounds.

2026 Keystone State and Great Lakes Championships General Information

All matches will be shot on 17-3/16" targets at 15ft

We will be using two 6 Lane Ranges. Possible 3rd range if needed.

All CFDA rules will apply to all matches. You must be a CFDA member in good standing to compete in these matches as well as the side matches. Please be prepared to show either your CFDA membership card or your lifetime badge at registration.

We will supply all the ammo for all the matches. We will be shooting 209 shotguns Primers and Spitfire Flatiron wax in all the matches including the titled Championships. Also, at times the ranges may be open for practice. You will need your own ammo for practice.

All Billy the Kid and Annie Oakley Youth competitors (referred to as BK and AO) except level 4 shooting with the adults will shoot for free. Level 2 two handed and Level 3- and one-handed shooters will shoot together. BK and AO may shoot together depending on the turnout. There will be awards for both the top BK and AO shooters. Junior shooters and Level 4 Youth shooters shooting with the adults and will pay a portion of the adult entry fee because they will be eligible for the same awards as adults. There will also be separate awards for the top Junior Boy and Junior Girl.

Match will be 4X- (3 winning hits)

We will shoot down to the Mag 7 men's and women's. If we do not get to men's Mag 7 we will finish after the bracket match on Sunday morning.

Saturday Evening Banquet –5 pm social hour at the host site. 6pm -10pm Thursday and Friday award ceremony. Old Chuckwagon Dinner, and some live music entertainment. We ask that you register on the entry form to attend the banquet as this event is being catered. If you register for both the state and Territorial, the banquet is included in your combined entry fee. Any single event participant and any guest will be \$25.00 per person. If you should have any, additional last-minute request please contact us as soon as possible to be added. You do not have to be a shooter to attend the banquet.

Sunday Sept 27th

Bracket Match. Included in your entry Fee.

Number of Brackets will be determined based on number of participants.

The match will be a 2X (Nevada 8) format. All Territory registered shooters will be entered into the bracket match. Anyone not present for roll call will be removed from the bracket match. Entry fee included in Territory registration fee.

Our goal is to complete the bracket match by 12:30 setting the stage for the

Territory Mag 7 Shootout to determine our Territory Championships. If the men's Mag 7 has not been determined, we will finish the men's division to the Mag 7 prior to shooting the women's finals. When we have the Mag 7 set for both, The Women will take Center stage followed by the Men. Upon completion of the competition, there will be an award ceremony for the Bracket Match and The Territory Championships.
