#### 2026 CFDA New Member Recruiting Drive

At our November Meeting, our Board of Territorial Governors approved an idea that Alotta Lead came up with, our 2026 CFDA New Member Recruiting Drive. You can read the details about it on our social media assets and in this edition of the Gunslinger's Gazette.

CFDA lost a significant number of annual members over the past 6 years. There has always been a turnover rate of annual members. A general rule of thumb is that about 1/3<sup>rd</sup> expire after one-year, 1/3<sup>rd</sup> renew for several years as long as they're shooting, and 1/3<sup>rd</sup> stay committed for life, for which a number of them become Life Members.

What caused this? 2020 & 2021 were especially hard due to Covid. 2021 - 2024 was the highest inflationary period in over 50 years; average prices on everything increased over 20%. Inflation hit the travel & lodging industry even harder; which increased over Many folks struggle to have the discretionary funds to afford to travel to CFDA Titled Championships. This also affects those who commute sometimes hours each way to support club events. It's time that we as a non-profit organization work together to build both memberships and clubs!

The CFDA 2026 New Member Recruiting Drive! Here's the Twist!!! For every new member you as a member of CFDA sign up, you earn a ticket for a drawing for some very cool prizes at the end of 2026! This also counts if you bring back an expired member, if they have been expired for more than two years. So, give a call to a friend or family member that hasn't been active for a while and invite them back!

Just Think! If we all just sign up one New Member, or get an Expired Member to renew each year, we can double the size of CFDA, each year!



# CELEBRATING 20 YEARS! TIME FLIES WHEN YOU'RE HAVING FUN!

Vestled in the mountains about 30 miles north of Boise sits the old mining town of Idaho established in 1862. With this establishment. the Gold Rush of the Boise Basin came to life bringing in gold than the California and Alaska Gold Rushes combined! By 1864, Idaho City would

become the largest city in the Pacific Northwest. As with many mining camps, Idaho City was a raucous place and crime was rampant but conditions improved with the influence of women and the establishment of churches and a school. Idaho City endured four disastrous fires during the 1860's and 1870's. Despite the devastating loss, many of the city's brick buildings survived and a few are used as the courthouse and county buildings today.\*

In 2003, Blackjack and Curley Calhoun opened Growling Bear Outfitters, a sporting goods store, in one of the original buildings on Main Street in the heart of Idaho City. Tourism was big at this time and the two of them, along with Blackjack's family (Fannie Mae, Huckleberry Honey and little Sweet Pea), held a little gunfight show on Main Street and soon a few other merchants joined in. Then, in 2004, while Curley was at home laying on the floor, worn out from being shot down in the streets wearing full cowboy gear in 100-degree heat, a TV commercial came on advertising the U.S. Nationals of Cowboy Fast Draw. It was being held right here in the Treasure Valley. Whoa! Hold the horses! He took down the information and reached out to learn more. Curley soon received a reply from Chucky, the owner and publisher

of Shoot! Magazine. They spoke and days later Chucky showed up in Idaho City with a guy all dressed up, looking the part, by the name of Cactus Tubbs. Blackjack and Curley sat down with them and hammered out some plans for Blackjack and Curley to provide the shooting range and Chucky and his crew to provide the supplies, targets and timers. The CFDA club, the Idaho Shootists, was born and ready to shoot. After a few months of Town Folk Alleys (now called Come Try Cowboy Fast Draw) in Idaho City and matches in Shoot! Magazine's warehouse in Boise, we had over 40 shooters and were traveling to South Dakota to check out and compete in their State shoot and the World Championship. To say it was cool would be an understatement for sure. After returning, the club was buzzing and decided to hold our own state championship. What a turn out! We had people from all over show up, including SD, AZ, NM, NV, OR, UT and CA. Seriously, some of the legends of Fast Draw graced our event with their presence. Some of them had been shooting since the 1950's and some are still shooting today. Cowboy Fast Draw grew tremendously in Idaho over the next few years and clubs sprang up throughout the state with the Treasure Valley Gunslingers down in the valley, the Snake River Gunslingers in the Magic Valley, the Eagle Rock Outlaws over in eastern Idaho. Soon after forming, the Treasure Valley Gunslingers assisted the Snake River Gunslingers in hosting the first Great Northwest Territorial in 2009. Idaho is proud to have continuously hosted the State and Territorial championships and for nine years also hosted the U.S. Nationals. Idaho is extremely proud to be amongst the first to help set championship standards.

It's now 2025 and the Sawtooth Shootist Society is continuing the Idaho Cowboy Fast Draw legacy by holding the 21st consecutive Idaho State Championship.

This brings us to this year's Idaho State. Here we are at Mountain Air Ranch right between Boise and Idaho City, gateway to the Sawtooth Mountains. RVs and campers are rolling in and filling in the west pasture. The ranges are awaiting almost 100 gunfighters from near and far. Fall is in the air with crisp mornings but the coffee is hot and the Bolton Brothers have hot breakfast calling to the early risers. As



the day breaks, the Sawtooth Shootist Society is ready to kick off the Show Me the Money Jackpot. Bang! And we're off and gunnin'. The match goes off without a hitch. Congratulations to Lefty Lipscomb and Gambler, the Show Me the Money Jackpot champions!

In case that wasn't enough fun, after the Jackpot it was time for Quick & the Dead which is always a crowd pleaser. After a couple hundred misses, a few hits and plenty of laughs, Ry Dog Jones proves that fast is fine but accuracy is final, taking the top spot followed by Butch Cassidy in 2<sup>nd</sup> and Little Lady capturing 3<sup>rd</sup>. To close out the evening, we had a pizza party and enjoyed each other's company until dusk.

On Saturday morning, opening day for Idaho State, Curley started the shooter's meeting by handing out some club trophies and special recognition awards. This year's Top Hand awards went to The Texan and his lovely wife, Spirit Bear, and Ms. Hettie. Our thanks go out for everything they do for our club. Next, Curley handed out a couple of special recognition awards with the first going to C&R Wax for sponsoring Idaho State for 20 years with quality wax. The second award went to Ms. Hettie, our own little baker extraordinaire. She not only bakes good stuff for club matches

each month (approximately 10,364,148 calories), but each year she also bakes some amazing desserts for the live auction during the championship match. The last award went to Gunpowder Puff for being the 20<sup>th</sup> entry into Idaho State! She received her entry fee back but, true to form, she donated it back to the club. The meeting was then finished up with the safety meeting, Pledge of Allegiance and prayer.

The excitement was building as the gunfighters were ready to shoot. The scoring team was ready on time and shots rang out across the canyon. The first four rounds are always extra exciting with Cool Cash being at stake. What is Cool Cash, you ask? Show up in 2026 and you'll experience it first-hand. This year, we had a record number of 20 shooters earn their share of the \$500 bounty. Pretty cool since we were celebrating 20 years! Well, we shot down to the Magnificent 7 and prepared to settle in for dinner. Once again, Grubbin' BBQ brought their "A" game and the shooters feasted. The silent auction

closed and man, what a great variety of gift baskets, art and other goodies that were available for grabs. After dinner, Curley kicked off the live auction with one of the main attractions being a trademark denim quilt created for the anniversary by Chrysanthemum and Sawtooth Sweetie. The funds for the quilt went to Shoot for the Stars. Curley must be the worst auctioneer ever but even so, along with Old Drifter's poker night, almost \$4,000 was raised for Shoot for the Stars,

Happy Trails Children's Foundation and the club. The evening was in full gear with Old Drifter's poker game and others enjoying R Rockin Bar with laughter and B.S. as deep as the barstools.

Sunday starts off really crisp, so Curley lit up the fire pit drawing in early risers to huddle with their coffee and Bolton Brothers' breakfast. The sun finally peaked above the ridgeline and shots were fired as the Bracket Match took off. With two brackets per range, it didn't take long to settle up. The Deputy Bracket was won by Idaho Joe followed by Drifter in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> going to Bean Counter. The Sheriff Bracket champion was Rondo. No Name took 2<sup>nd</sup> place and Buckwheat James earned 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Gunfighter Bracket was led by Lefty Lipscomb with Underdog close behind in 2<sup>nd</sup>. Deadeye Dixie took home 3<sup>rd</sup>. The top



spot for Master Gunfighter was Stampede. Desert Dingo hung in at 2<sup>nd</sup> and QC Carver landed 3<sup>rd</sup>. It's almost noon so let's get settled in for the finals.

We started the finals with the Youth. With only three Youth shooters this year, it didn't take long. Ruby Roundhouse from ID faced off with Six Gun Shelbs from NV. Six shots later, all in the mid-5s, Six Gun Shelbs prevailed and moved on to face the top seed, Sniper from ID. After a couple of misses, Six Gun Shelbs hit three in a row, beating Sniper and earning the cat bird seat. Now Sniper and Ruby Roundhouse battle it out. And even with four hits in the 6s, it just wasn't enough for Ruby Roundhouse to beat Sniper's low 5s, putting her in 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The stage is now set for the final Youth showdown. But was it? Shiper quickly put three out of five winning hits on the target, letting him stay in the game. They swapped lanes, the nerves sank in and the battle went back and forth until Six Gun Shelbs finished it off to win the Idaho State Youth Championship. Hats off to the youth for their show of skill and sportsmanship!

Next up is the Ladies and what a lineup of ladies from AZ, NV, CA, TX and ID. To get it rollin', Snow Tiger (ID) shoots against Southwest KC (AZ) and, after four shots, Snow Tiger takes the bout. Gunpowder Puff (CA) steps up to accept

the challenge and after taking it two-to-two, hit a .523 to move on. This brings up Deadeye Dixie (ID) and once again going to two-to-two, G. Puff takes the win. Southwest KC and Snow Tiger were shooting for 7th place or to stay in the game. After

another two-to-two bout, Snow Tiger prevailed and Southwest KC took 7th place. Back on the "clean" side of the range, KK Kid (TX) stepped up but G. Puff, still hittin' the heck out of the target and speeding up to the high 4s, wins the bout. Deadeye Dixie was sent over to challenge Snow Tiger, who was also hittin' very well but just didn't have the speed to keep up with Deadeye Dixie's hits in the low 5s. Snow Tiger took 6th place. Philippines Red (NV) now steps up to challenge G. Puff and quickly put on her first three shots to win (where's Cool Cash when you want it?) and sent G. Puff over to the 1-X side. Meanwhile, KK Kid and Deadeye Dixie are battling it out. KK Kid put three hits on in the low 4s with her long gun, putting Deadeye Dixie in the 5th place spot. Whoa, it's really heating up now. Our top seed, Lefty Lipscomb (ID), comes to the line after watching the other ladies battling it out. Philippines Red takes the bout two-to-two and then wins to sit in the catbird seat. Over on the other lanes, KK Kid and G. Puff are in a rematch but KK Kid is on target with some more mid-4s, putting G. Puff in 4th place. Lefty Lipscomb steps over to challenge KK Kid, both wanting to stay in the match and challenge Philippines Red for the championship. KK Kid starts it off with a .435. Lefty Lipscomb answers with a .466. Two more low 4s from them both took it to two-to-two. Lefty Lipscomb finished it up and sent KK Kid home in 3rd place. Now, with Lefty Lipscomb feeling like she has some unfinished business, she lines up next to Philippines Red. Lefty Lipscomb, still in mid-4

mode, took the win over Philippines Red's four hits in a row and they swapped lanes. Philippines Red hit four more shots but was just not fast enough for Lefty Lipscomb's mid-4s. Lefty Lipscomb wins her fourth Idaho State Championship! Congratulations to Philippines Red on her stellar performance earning her 2<sup>nd</sup> place!

Boy, as if that wasn't enough, the men have been waiting patiently (kind of) to get their shoot off started. The men's Magnificent 7 had competitors from CA, NV, ID and OR. We start with Crosswired (OR), our 2023 Idaho State Champion, challenging Old Drifter (CA). After six shots, Old Drifter wins with some low 4s. Next up is Ambush (ID), who moves Old Drifter over and proceeds to layout some 3s, moving Old Drifter over to take on Crosswired again. Ambush welcomed Gambit (ID) to the line and after the two battle two-to-two (woohoo!), Ambush finishes with a .377 to take the win. On the 1-X side, Old Drifter prevailed and sent Crosswired home in 7th place. Buckwheat James, a great hitter from eastern Idaho, steps up but Ambush was on a roll (like butter and cinnamon) continuing with hits in the mid 3s to take the win. Back on the 1-X lanes, Gambit and Old Drifter are trying to stay in the game. Old Drifter hits four in a row to put Gambit in 6th place. Clint Reno (CA), the Patriarch of the Elliott boys, slides into the competition and quickly puts Ambush in his place by connecting with four hits in a row in the mid-3s. Meanwhile, Buckwheat James and Old Drifter are trading hits. Old Drifter takes the win and sends Buckwheat James home in 5th place. We have now reached our top seed, Quick Cal (NV), who was hitting well all weekend. He sauntered up to take on Clint Reno

for the catbird seat. After five shots, Clint Reno wins the decisive bout and steps back to settle his nerves while he watches to see who'll be coming

back to challenge him for the championship. On the other lanes, Old Drifter and Ambush battle to two-to-two and then Old Drifter hits his fourth shot to win and send Ambush off the line in 4th place. Quick Cal wasted no time choosing lane 3, putting Old Drifter on lane 4. Both shooters hit three out of four, but with Quick Cal being just a bit quicker, he put Old Drifter out in 3rd place. What a run Old Drifter had! Both Quick Cal and Clint Reno are now on center stage with Quick Cal having so many championships, it'd take a while to count them all, and Clint Reno looking for his first. With lane choice, Quick Cal stays settled on lane 3 and

hits four in a row but Clint Reno was battling for that title, taking the bout to two-to-two. Sudden Victory! Everyone is watching...will we swap lanes and do it again or will it all be over and in the record books? Clint Reno hits a .360 capturing his first championship title! Congratulations to Quick Cal on a great showing taking 2nd place.

The Sawtooth crew have the trophy table set up and Curley begins calling out the people to be recognized. We really had a lot of winners this year. In addition to the 20 Cool Cash winners,

No Name won the 50/50 pot and Risky Dame and Reno Dean won the gun drawings. There were many silent and live auction winners as well. It's

2:45 p.m. and we're all done.

But wait, we weren't quite done yet. That Monday, Labor Day, some of the shooters gathered up at Idaho Sporting Clays, one of our sponsors, and had a blast (literally) shooting sporting clays. Some of the shooters had never even fired a shotgun before and, in no time, the dozen shooters were bustin' clays and puttin' holes in the sky, all in good fun. Halfway through, we gathered at the clubhouse and enjoyed a hot lunch, arranged and covered by the Sawtooth Shootist Society, and then hustled back out to the course to finish up. At the end, Gambler handed out a few cool awards, crafted by Wild West Woodcraft, to the newbies in

the shape of a clay target. Finally, we all said our good-byes and are looking forward to doing it all again next year so bring your 45's and shotguns.

We thank everyone for coming and look forward to seeing you all next year as the Sawtooth Shootist Society will host Idaho State and the Great Northwest Territorial together over Labor Day weekend 2026.



Deaver Dam, Kentucky The 2025 Kentucky State Championship of Cowboy Fast Draw is in the books and what a great shoot it was. We had 77 competitors from 20 states to show up to compete for the Kentucky State Championship, 22 ladies and 55 men.

We had a great turn out of club members on Labor day to start setting up the ranges for the state shoot. By the end of day one we had two

ranges set up and ready for the electronics. The weather was near perfect, a little warm and a sprinkle of rain at times, a little wind on day two kept blowing the backstop into the targets and knocking them over.

Those who arrived on Thursday September 4th got to shoot in the Early Bird Charity Match. We started off with 29 competitors shooting in the early bird shoot. A total of \$600 was raised from this match for the Ohio County Veterans Honor Guard. OD Kate from Alabama took 1st place for the ladies, WildFire 2nd, Ms Cisco 3rd, Gun Shy 4th, Sassy Sparrow 5th, Hold on Julie 6th and Jane James 7th. Green River came in 1st place for the men, Run Fat Man Run 2nd, The Smoke Wagon Kid was 3rd, Shane 4th, Johnny James 5th, Buffalo Joe 6th and Long Colt 7th,

Friday September 5th we started



a brand new shoot that V.P. Johnny James came up with which is the 1st Annual Shane's Invitational. This match started with 18 Ladies and 46 men. The top 7 for this match for the ladies was Texas Rose 1st, Belle Star 2nd, Gun Shy 3<sup>rd</sup>, Pistol Pearl 4<sup>th</sup>, Wildfire 5<sup>th</sup>, Hold On Julie 6th and Tascosa 7th. For the men Big Ugly took 1st, Syxkiller 2nd, Flying B 3rd, Run Fat Man Run 4th, Johnny James 5th, Small Dawg Mason-Henry 6th, Pawnee Paul 7th.

Saturday September 6th started our overall Kentucky State Championship. The opening ceremonies started at 8:30 with The Ohio County Honor Guard posting the colors and Rowdy Rog leading with the pledge and a prayer. Several door prize's were drawn

with Appalachian Outlaw winning the gun for getting his registration in by August 1st, and Ladybug winning the Knife and sheath made

Recipe for all seasons but it's a nice change for the Christmas dinner table. Give it a try this year!


#### **Christmas Potato Casserole**

#### What you'll need:

- \*2 1/2 -3 pounds potatoes, peeled and quartered
- \*6 ounces (12 tablespoons) unsalted butter
- \*6 ounces cream cheese, softened
- \*1 1/2 cup cheddar cheese, sharp or mild, shredded, divided
- \*1 (2-ounce) jar pimiento, drained, chopped, or about 1/4 cup of finely \*chopped red bell pepper
- \*1 small green bell pepper, finely chopped
- \*6 green onions, finely chopped
- \*3/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese1/4 cup milk (either low fat but whole is the best)
- \*1 teaspoon salt & pepper to taste

#### How to Make It

- 1. Boil the potatoes in a large saucepan, cover with water & cook until fork tender. Drain, transfer to a large bowl and mash.
- 2. Heat the oven to 350- meanwhile butter a 2-quart baking dish.
- 3. Add butter and cream cheese to the potatoes. With an electric mixer, beat until well blended. Do not overbeat. Add 1/2 cup cheddar cheese and the <u>next 6 ingredients</u>, stir to mix thoroughly.
- Spoon the potatoes into the prepared baking dish. Bake in the preheated oven for 25 to 35 minutes, or until the potatoes are hot and bubbling around the edges.
- 5. Sprinkle with remaining 1 cup of cheddar cheese; bake for about 5 minutes longer, or until cheese melts. Good anytime of the year! Merry Christmas!

### CFDA FIRST AID VOLUNTEERS GUIDELINES

It all began a few years ago when Wench asked to place a Marshal's Muster Agenda Item with an idea of organizing Emergency First Aid Volunteers. The U.S. Marshals voted to proceed with such a program. About a year ago *Bigfoot (L3037)* stepped up and volunteered to lead the effort, for which he was appointed **Program Director.** 

**Bigfoot** is a retired law enforcement officer who has served as a Medical Trauma Responder. He gathered a team consisting of his wife, **Dazzlin' Daisy** (L3038) who recently retired as a law enforcement officer to help with research and author the program, and **Otto Matic** (L3054), a retired Firefighter Paramedic. Together they created the first-draft of the program and

offered it to CFDA.

It is now approved by the Board of Territorial Governors and known as the CFDA First Aid Volunteers and Match Director's & Range Master's Guidelines. We are looking for two levels of volunteers within this program.

First Aid Level- With past or present First Aid and CPR Training and /or Certificates, who would be willing to help, when a <u>Match Director asks for volunteers</u> for Emergency First Aid assistance for any CFDA Event. CFDA has <u>temporary</u> CFDA First Aid/Medical Emergency ID Cards that Match Directors can request from CFDA, that are handed out temporarily and turned back in, then returned to CFDA.

Advanced Level- Such as former or current Professional Paramedic/EMT, Medical (Doctor/PA/Nurse), Military, or Law Enforcement with Emergency Response Training. They can apply for a permanent "A" CFDA First Aid/Medical Emergency ID Card and can be of assistance at any CFDA Event.

**Important!** It's important to know that <u>volunteers are NOT covered by insurance</u>. However, they can lawfully offer their assistance under "The Good Samaritan Laws", that exist, but may vary, from state to state.

I suggest that all interested members, Match Directors & Range Masters read the entire 2-Page - CFDA First Aid Volunteers and Match Director's & Range Master's Guidelines, you can find it at: CowboyFastDraw.com, go to the Rules, Regulations & Guidelines, then scroll down to CFDA First Aid Guidelines. Match Directors & Range Masters should read this since they are engaged in part of the procedures.

If you're interested, please go to Facebook and find CFDA First Aid Emergency Response Team – Private Group and request to join. Bigfoot, monitors posts from members of the group. You can request for consideration to place your name as a volunteer. He will respond and probably have some questions regarding your level of training.



EVENTS WRITTEN IN THE HISTORY BOOKS CANNOT BE CHANGED, BUT

Marshal Virgil Earp's "What If" Could Have Changed History Forever. And The OK Corral Gunfight Might Have Never Happened...

When we look back and study tragic events that have occurred in our past which we wish had never happened, you may sometimes wonder about the proverbial "What If". "What if" something different could have taken place prior to the tragedy that could have changed history forever. For example, "What if" one specific person had not been there just in time to stop a situation from taking place that would have prevented a future catastrophic occurrence with its history changing results but yet would adversely affect that same specific person for the rest of their life.

Such is a "What If" case with the infamous Gunfight at the OK Corral in Tombstone, Arizona on October 26, 1881 involving members of the feuding Clanton and Earp families

It is well known that there was a bitter "no love lost" rivalry between the Clantons along with their ranch hands known as the "Cowboys" and the Tombstone lawmen Earp brothers as well with Doc Holiday.

In the 1880's, the Clanton Gang as they would become to be known were wrecking havoc in the southwest Arizona Tombstone Territory with their cattle rustling, armed holdups and even murder on both sides of the U.S.-Mexico border.

Ike Clanton was known to be a heavy drinker and quite the

braggart with a quick temper, much to his own future demise. And so here is where the "What If" of this story comes into play.

An ambitious Wyatt Earp was in pursuit of quickly moving up the ladder ranks of his lawman career. He thought if could arrest those who committed the robbery of the Benson Stage on March 15, 1881 resulting in the murder of the driver and one of the passengers, that bringing these robbers to justice would help his cause. On June 2, 1881, Wyatt was to have said that he offered Ike Clanton the Wells, Fargo & Company reward money if he would get him information that would lead to the arrest or deaths of the vicious men responsible for the stage robbery. Ike was having second thoughts about this arrangement with Earp especially if word got out of his betrayal to his fellow outlaws.

This indecision of Ike Clanton may very well have come to an abrupt end in the morning of June 9, 1881 on the streets Tombstone, Arizona where Deputy Marshal Virgil Earp's perfect timing may not have been so perfect in that it may have changed history, much to his own and his brother's future dismay.

Ike Clanton and gambler "Denny" McCann, (most likely a distant relative of this author), would have a "What If" encounter that did not but most assuredly could have rewritten history.

As reported on June 9, 1881 in the Daily Epitaph Newspaper:

"What came very near being serious shooting affray was prevented yesterday morning by the coolness and intrepidity of Virgil Earp, acting City Marshal. Ike Clanton, well-known in the San Simon and San Pedro valleys, and "Denny" McCann, a sporting man, had a difficulty in an Allen street saloon, when the latter slapped the face of the former. Clanton went out and heeled himself, and "Denny" did the same. They met in front of the Wells, Fargo's office about 9 o'clock and both drew their guns about the same

time, when Earp stepped between them and spoiled a good local item. They are

both determined men, and but for the interference of the officer, there would doubtless have been a funeral, perhaps two."

For had Virgil Earp not gotten wind of the forthcoming gunfight and put a stop to it before the triggers were pulled and the bullets fired, Ike Clanton's life was more than likely spared as Sporting Man "Denny" McCann was known to be quite adept at handling his Colt 45 revolver. Ike Clanton always talked a bigger game than he could back up and would have for sure been lying mortally wounded on the ground with a bullet in him from McCann's gun.

So in reality, Virgil Earp's perfect timing did alter the future lives of his brothers, Doc Holiday as well as his own. If "Cowboy" Ike Clanton had indeed been shot dead on the morning of June 9, 1881 in the streets of Tombstone, Arizona, the Gunfight At the OK Corral would surely never have happened and history would have been changed forever.

Ike Clanton would not have been alive to instigate the riled up "Cowboys" leading up to the famous gunfight. Morgan Earp would not have been later ambushed and murdered. Virgil Earp would not also have been severely wounded and left with a lifelong disability. And Wyatt Earp and Doc Holiday may not have become the Wild West legends they eventually became.


Unfortunately, all of the "what if's" in the world cannot and will not change history.

In my last report I mentioned that the Board Imade a decision regarding realigning and combining a few territories. As of January 1st, 2026 we will have 7 CFDA U.S. Territories. We are showing both the existing 8-Territory Map and new 7-Territory Map in this issue of the Gunslinger's Gazette for the last time to provide a useful reference for our members.





The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. A refund of the sale will be made, minus the original \$35 shipping fee and a 5% re-login/re-stocking fee.

#### THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

#### THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

#### Ammunition

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

#### TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center) 24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center) Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

#### Competition Timers

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

#### SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

#### CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.
