Here we go! The 2026 CFDA Season is Officially under way! And what a start already! There is a great line up of Competitions throughout the nation from jackpot shoots all the way to

the World Championship from Coast to Coast!

If you take a look on page 32 of the Gunslinger's Gazette you will notice the 2026 Event Schedule. How do you get your club "Class C" event listed here? Funny you should ask! When you send in your dates for your Sanctioned CFDA event (Class A, B, or C), the dates will be posted on the CFDA website and printed in the Gunslinger's Gazette. Your "Class C" registration forms and schedules can also be posted on the CFDA website. This is great exposure if your club happens to have an annual club match you are hoping to get out of town members to. On page 29 of the 13th Edition of the Gunslinger's Guidelines, you can view the criteria for a Sanctioned CFDA Event.

* **REMEMBER** Class A & B Titled Events **MUST** submit the Sanctioned Event forms back to CFDA headquarters before your dates will be posted on the CFDA website. If you don't see dates listed for a Titled event your club puts on, it is because we have not yet received that paperwork.

RESULTS - It's that time again to give out the **REMINDER** to be sure to send in your **OFFICIAL RESULTS** for your Titled Match event ASAP so they can be posted on the CFDA Website and entered into Top Gun

Points in a timely manner.

I usually try to wait 3-4 days before I start bugging clubs if I haven't received them yet, and I have to say, I think I had to send out the LEAST amount of reminders to clubs in 2025. BRAVO! Let's keep it up! BUT, I also know people get busy, and real life gets in the way, and sometimes a helpful reminder is needed. PLEASE be sure to save your Final results in the Scoring Program as an .rtf (Rich Text Format) file to send them into CFDA Headquarters. Not only does it make it so much easier for me to put all your results into one PDF file, but there have been many times where club hosts or CFDA staff have had to go back and re-adjust the placing by hand.

DID YOU KNOW? You can also include additional results & special awards with your results and I will gladly include them with your official results. This can include categories, brackets, top couple, fastest times, etc. ***NOTE - Please DO NOT send in a cellphone photo or a scanned copy of the results. Unless you had a catastrophic computer failure and lost your files, we cannot post these as official results. If you in fact DID have a catastrophic computer failure (it happens), I will try my best to work with you and what you have. So Send it in!**

And it's a great way to promote your event for the following year!

STATE OF THE COWBOY FAST DRAW ASSOCIATION - NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION -

This issue's column is titled differently since it's our first issue of the Gunslinger's Gazette for 2026. We recently had our February CFDA Board Meeting. At this meeting our board reviewed and discussed my 2025 CFDA Budget Report. The board agrees that after we review the Budget Report a little further we will then publish this document on our CFDA Website to make it available for all members of CFDA.

I'm pleased to announce that the State of CFDA, NPO is Strong!

As our members will learn, if they choose to review the Budget Report, that the reason I have declared that the "State of CFDA, NPO is Strong" is not so much about money. It's no secret that for any worthwhile organization to exist it does take money, which cannot be ignored. My statement is based upon the "Spirit and Generosity" of our members, which I believe will bring CFDA forward for years to come. "Spirit and Generosity" are substantially more than just members paying dues and entry fees. "Spirit and Generosity" in their highest form means that we all work together to support a common mission. We contribute to that mission by volunteering our help and support in so many ways. It's that **spirit of giving** within CFDA that really makes it an organization worthy to be part of, and in turn what makes CFDA Strong!

Volunteering is Crucial

Some of our members may not travel to many events very far from home due to financial, employment or physical reasons, but they can contribute their time, talent and support to their local CFDA Affiliated Club. Clubs will always be the very foundation of CFDA. Local Shooters that just show up, shoot and leave are appreciated. But those who really get involved with helping to Set-up, Tear-down, Score, Announce, Range Master, provide lunch, sweep-up, and serve as club officers are really what makes any club thrive.

Some of our members are able to crisscross our nation to support CFDA Titled Championships. Those members understand

that our Host Clubs spend months planning all parts of our championships and do most of the match set-up and tear-down. I've noticed that most of these members tend to jump right in and help Announce, Keep Score and Range Master, they understand that very few clubs have enough members that are trained to cover all of those duties, especially in larger multiple range matches. Besides, many of us have discovered that it's actually more fun to help out than to just sitting around waiting for the next round to be posted.

The fact is: CFDA couldn't exist without volunteers who contribute in so many ways. We are so fortunate to have so many members with a wide range of individual talents.

Fund Raising Charities

We, the members of CFDA also like to raise funds for worthy causes. CFDA Shoot for the Stars Scholarship Fund has been our favorite charity for years. We've also raised funds for wonderful charities like the Happy Trails Foundation, and other local charities.

Something to Consider: CFDA is now a 501(c)3 which is a Non-Profit Charitable Organization. You'll find that when our Budget Report becomes available that there are many other programs that we could be implementing, but funds are limited. We should strongly consider having more fundraisers for CFDA, which can be in the form of raffles and outright donations. We've received many phone calls at CFDA Headquarters for years from members thanking and telling us that CFDA has literally changed their lives for the better. Some have even told us that, "CFDA has saved their life." If our members truly feel that way, perhaps they should consider setting aside an Estate Bequest in their will or trust, I personally plan to do just that.

13th Edition of the Gunslinger's Guidelines, Rules, Regulations & Handbook

It's our goal to update our Guidelines & Rulebook about every 3 years, which you have probably received by now. The editing process is rather lengthy and after initial updates it is first submitted to our Board of Directors for proof-reading and review. Once findings are edited, we then distribute it to our CFDA Regulators for another proof-reading and review. Then Hannah Calder makes a final review and clean-up before sending it for publication and distribution.

We do sometimes hear from members

who would prefer "cliff notes" of changes. With all of the processes involved that would be a bit complicated. However, I really hope that our members might commit the time once every 3-years to just sit down and re-read our entire defining document, it's not really all that long.

CFDA 2026 Scoring Program Update

We are currently updating our CFDA Scoring Program, since it was last updated six years ago. We are making all kinds of improvements that will offer a lot more options, including a much better back-up system. There will also be new instructional videos made. I know there's a lot of questions, which will all be answered once everything is in order. We are not going to distribute the 2026 Program until we are confident in its reliability, which may take a few more months.

If you really want to know the history of our Scoring Program I suggest you turn to Pages 31. & 32 of our Gunslinger's Guidelines and read about its history. There were a number of good CFDA members involved in its evolution.

CFDA originally depended on the same scoring system used by the World Fast Draw Association. It was designed for far less shooters than CFDA draws and took one Scorekeeper for every two Shooters. At the 2006 Deadwood World Championship we had 104 shooters. It took almost an hour between each round to draw and organize score sheets for the next round. The first day lasted until almost 6 p.m. and we were only able to complete 5 rounds. If a shooter X'd out, there was no time or facilities for a Second Chance Match, you were just out.

Brad Hemmah took me aside and asked, "What are we going to do if 150 Shooters showed up?" That's when Mississippi Marshal and I invented what we now know as the Round by Round Scoring System, a much faster and efficient system that only required one Scorekeeper for an entire line of shooters. Of course, there were some who complained, because they no longer got a personal score sheet showing every shot they and their opponents fired for each round. Where would we be now if we didn't create our CFDA Scoring Program?

Evolution of CFDA

Some folks just don't like change. Some say, CFDA should be "The Way it Was". Well, I don't much like change either, unless there's good reason for it.

The sport of Fast Draw has been evolving for over 70 years, it has moved away from the way it was in the beginning. The beginning for me in Fast Draw goes back way beyond 2002, to the 1970's. Since then, I've always been looking for ways to improve the Sport of Fast Draw.

Before CFDA was ever in existence, I invented things like putting white lithium grease on targets and started using Progressive Elimination for Championship Shoot-offs, clear back in the 1970's, which we now call the Magnificent 7 Shoot-offs.

For CFDA, it was me that brought the use of Aliases into CFDA in 2007 and created the Top Gun of the Year point system to add continuity to our annual championship seasons. I've been hosting World Fast Draw Championships since the age of 22 years old, for over 50 years. If you want to know my shooting sports accomplishments both of my biographies, one for shooting and one for management, are posted on our website, under About the CFDA, scroll down to Management.

I don't mean to brag about these things, they're just facts. However, there's a more important fact! I am both grateful and humbled by YOU, the folks who make CFDA what it really is. It's a brother and sisterhood, where there's a bond created between all of us. What we have is much more important than just a sport, it's called our CFDA Family!!! In all of my years of shooting sports, I've never seen anything like this. I'm not the only one, because those of us who "really get it", are totally committed to it.

God Willing, while I'm still able to be part of the management of CFDA, I will always be committed to finding better ways to manage and improve our sport. We should always be interested in hearing new ideas from any member, as long as those ideas follow the Founding Principles of CFDA, as written on Page 4. in our Guidelines, for which my experience tells me that anything less will fail.

I ask anyone who is committed to the future of CFDA to consider playing a larger role within our organization. There's many ways to help that I've already written about in this article. You might even consider running for Territorial Governor, or even for Chairman in 2028. We need to develop the future leaders of our sport, we all need to work together!

Top Gun of the Year is one of the highest competitive achievements that can be obtained in our sport. I consider it the 3rd highest achievement, just behind the World & U.S. National Championship. The point system was created in 2007, the goal was to bring continuity to connect all CFDA Titles and much more than just an attendance award. A member must make a commitment for an entire season to dedicate themselves to show up and compete in various Class A & B CFDA Titled Championships. Your highest point totals from 6 championships are added throughout the year, which must include at least 2 State Championships. These point totals are calculated by Wild Shot and kept updated throughout the season on our CFDA Website. 2025 Men's Top Gun of the Year- Rango

QC: **NOTE:** This is the first interview for our annual Top Gun of the Year Article that I've been able to do in person. It makes me extremely proud to interview my very own Grandson...

Rango how do you feel about winning our Men's Top Gun of the Year?

Rango: I feel fantastic! It's one of the biggest accomplishments of my life so far. Especially since it's not just winning one match, it took a whole season to accomplish and it came down to the last match of the year where I won by only 8 points.

QC: How did you get started in Cowboy Fast Draw?

Rango: I've been around it my whole life since CFDA is a big part of my family. When I was 7, I really wanted to try it, so it was you Grandpa who took me out to the range to practice. I was not old enough to draw the gun from the holster, so I had to hold the gun with my left-thumb on the hammer while placing the barrel of the gun on a stool, that was really fun. The Gun Hawks let me compete in shoots that way until I turned 8, I could hardly wait for my birthday! I thought I was getting really good. The Gun Hawks were all great sports and supportive by cheering me on even when I won rounds using this huge advantage. Then when I discovered how hard drawing from the holster really was, I asked if I could go back to placing the barrel of the gun on the stool again. They laughed and said Nope, you're 8 now!

QC: What do you love most about Cowboy Fast Draw?

Rango: What I love the most is traveling and getting to meet the nice people in our sport. Then traveling to more events, seeing them again and meeting even more really friendly people. It's like a really big second family all

over the country.

QC: What inspired you to train to become a champion?

Rango: My love for the sport. It's really the only sport I've ever really competed in. Then, when I made it into my first Top 7 Shoot-off, it made me really want to work harder to win a championship.

QC: How much do you practice?

Rango: I used to practice a lot. But now that I have developed a draw that I'm confident in, I don't have to practice continuously like I used to. I just have to sharpen my draw and mentally focus for several sessions before a championship.

QC: Do you have any tips for our members?

Rango: Keep your focus and don't let one bad round throw you off your game. Stay calm and just get ready to shoot the next round. Take one shot at a time and never give up.

QC: What accomplishment are you most proud of?

Rango: Well, it's hard to beat winning Top Gun of the Year. But really, I'm most proud of winning my first title, the 2021 Kansas State Championship, during my last year as a Junior Shooter. Especially, since the final round was against you Grandpa. My Dad, Dead Eye Kid was there and also finished in the Mag 7 Finals too, it was a really special weekend for all three of us that I will never forget.

QC: What are your goals for 2026?



Note: Rango and Emberly are both CFDA Titled Champions, who met as teenagers while attending CFDA events. They are engaged to be married in August of the year!



I think it's amazing that you won our 2025 Ladies Top Gun of the Year, since you're a relatively new shooter on the CFDA Top Gun Tour...

How do you feel about winning our 2025 Ladies' Top Gun of the Year?

I ended up barely winning by just 6 points just ahead of two great champions K.K. Kid and Lefty Lipscomb just one point back. QC: How did you get started in Cowboy Fast Draw?

He told us about winning a drawing for FREE Cowboy Fast Draw lessons with the Great Basin Gun Hawks in Fernley. The event was the next day on a Sunday and we asked if we could come along to watch. He called and asked if he could bring some friends and they told him he could invite anyone to come along and join the fun. We showed up and loved it so much we all immediately joined CFDA & the Gun Hawks and began to order everything we needed to get started in Cowboy Fast Draw.

Just as we were getting everything we needed and really starting to get involved Covid hit and set us back a bit. We really started to get involved in 2021, my first big shoot was the Western Territorial at the Shelterwood

Ranch. I really had no idea how I was doing, I just kept hitting the targets and ended up in a shoot-off for the 7th Seed in the Mag 7 Finals against Legally Loaded. It was a real learning experience. I was so excited and mistakenly did a practice draw when I first got to the firing line and broke a Technical Rule. Bad Boy got the call straightened out and it just ended up as a warning. I took 8th Place and everyone was so nice and supportive. That is when I really got hooked on CFDA. Turd Herder and I was just in the process of retiring from our business and CFDA has become a huge part of our lives.

QC: What do you love most about Cowboy Fast Draw?

HB: Really, it's the camaraderie of fellow shooters and the love of competition. I really like to feel part of every match by helping out as a Range Master or keeping score.

QC: What inspired you to train to become a champion?

HB: My first Titled Championship was the 2024 Western Territorial, I found out that it's really anyone's game. So, I practice to do my best.

QC: How much do you practice?

HB: I would like to practice every day, but that really turns into about 3 times a week. Plus, I like to shoot any local matches I can. A lot of my practice is on the 17" Laser Target.

QC: Do you have any tips for our members?

HB: Keep practicing and try for a consistent and smooth draw. Smooth is Fast! Practice keeping your focus. Do some warm-up draws before you actually start shooting and prepare yourself for a good session, practicing a warm-up routine is important, since you can bring that routine to matches too. I think wearing clothes and boots for practice that are similar to what you're going to compete in is important.



Thank you, Wild Onion Willie, Short Keg, Smokin' Joe, CoCo Bandit, Ol Buck'r, Lefty Lipscomb, Wild Shot, Yee Haw Hickey, Old Drifter, Still Shot and the Potter Family, Crosswired, Rossow, Montana, and Bean Counter.

We started off Tuesday September 30th with an all-day open registration and

gun check to alleviate the morning rush. That evening Lefty Lipscomb held her annual welcome dinner and gathering in Range A. Now for some Championship Finals. We start the show with our Fantastic 4 Youth. Going in, we line up and introduce the future of our sport, the kids. Seeding as follows; 1st Night Hawk, 2nd Mayhem, 3rd Lil Downtown, and 4th Six Gun Shelbs. I'd like to mention we had two new youth shooters at Shelterwood Ranch, this being their first titled championship. Mayhem who is from Oregon and shoots with the Crooked River Rangers, and Lil Downtown from southern California, who shoots with the Bar T Gunfighters. We hope they both come back next year!!

Six Gun Shelbs was feeling under the weather and opted out of the shoot offs, placing her as an automatic 4th place. I'm happy to report she was back to her feisty self and was able to shoot the remainder of the weekend. So, with that, Mayhem and Lil Downtown move to the line. After 5 shots, Lil Downtown wins the first round. Night Hawk comes up to the line to shoot with Lil Downtown, leaving Mayhem hanging out to see which of them she'll shoot it out with for 3rd place. Only 5 shots again, because these kids don't miss, and Night Hawk wins that round, taking the catbird seat. Dang, only 3 shots this time and Lil Downtown gets the faster hits, winning the round. Mayhem takes 3rd place in her very first titled championship event. Now, Night Hawk comes out of the catbird seat moving Lil Downtown to lane 4. Taking the score 3 to 2, and winning the final round, Night Hawk wins and is the Youth Champion. Ending the round with a handshake and a hug of his new shooting buddy who takes 2nd place. Congratulations to our youth shooters, great shooting!

compete on the line without ill attitudes. They encourage each other and definitely have fun!

Next up are the only two juniors, 1st seed Shell Shock from Texas, and 2nd seed Ry-Dog Jones from California. Shell Shock chooses lane 4 giving Ry-Dog Jones lane 3. The first round goes 2/2 but it's Ry-Dog Jones that gets the last winning hit. They switch lanes and do it again. The 2nd round goes 2/2 again but it's Shell Shock that gets the faster hit to win the round. So now it's 1X/1X so whoever wins the next round is the Junior Champion, and it could go either way. These young adults are also impressively seeded in the Mag 7 in the men's and ladies' division. The last round goes 2/1 in Ry-Dog Jones favor, and he gets the last hit with a .323 to Shell Shocks .387. Congratulations to Shell Shock for 2nd place and to Ry-Dog Jones, our Western Territorial Jr. Champion.

The ladies take the stage next for their Magnificent 7 and seeded as follows; 1st Shell Shock from Texas, 2nd Harley from Colorado, 3rd Deadeye Dixie from Idaho, 4th Sierra Rose from Arizona, 5th KK Kid from Texas, 6th Lefty Lipscomb from Idaho, and 7th Ricochet Rose from California. We start with 6th and 7th seeds having Lefty Lipscomb taking lane 1, giving Ricochet Rose lane 2. The score gets to 2/1 then Lefty Lipscomb hits the final shot to win the round. Next up to challenge Lefty Lipscomb is KK Kid. Again, this round goes 2/1 in Lefty Lipscomb's favor and she hits the final shot to win another round. Sierra Rose comes to the line to take on Lefty

Lipscomb. The round goes 2/2 and Sierra Rose hits the last shot to win the round. Over on lanes 3 and 4, KK Kid wins the round against Ricochet Rose giving her a 2nd X and Ricochet Rose takes 7th place. Deadeye Dixie now takes on Sierra Rose on lanes 1 and 2. Deadeye Dixie wins the round. KK Kid and Lefty Lipscomb are shooting it out on lanes 3 and 4, as the score goes 2/2. KK Kid gets just a tad faster shot winning the round and Lefty Lipscomb takes 6th place. Harley steps on the line now to take on Deadeye Dixie. The score is 2/0 in Deadeye Dixie's favor, but Harley comes back with a mean 1,2,3, winning the round and sends Deadeye Dixie to lanes 3 and 4 in the next bout. Currently on lanes 3 and 4, Sierra Rose and KK Kid are shooting to see who takes 5th place, and it's Sierra Rose who takes 5th. Shell Shock, our 1st seed comes up to challenge Harley, on lanes 1 and 2. They both get 3 shots on the target but it's Shell Shock who had a faster time and wins the round and places herself in the catbird seat. On lanes 3 and 4, Deadeye Dixie and KK Kid are shooting for 4th place. Deadeye Dixie hits all 5 shots while KK Kid hits 2 and it's Deadeye Dixie who wins the round and KK Kid takes 4th place. Now our last round to see who will go up against Shell Shock. Whoever goes out this round will place 3rd. The score is 2/1 in Harley's favor and she puts another hit on her target placing Deadeye Dixie in 3rd place. Shell Shock comes back to the line to take on Harley. Shell Shock is clean while Harley has 1X. Harley gets the first hit on the target, but Shell Shock comes back 1,2,3, and wins the round. Harley takes 2nd place and Shell Shock wins the ladies Western Territorial Championship. Congratulations ladies!!

Now it's time for the men's Magnificent 7 and seeded as follows; 1st Witlock from California, 2nd Ry-Dog Jones from California, 3rd Arizona Cactus Kid from Arizona, 4th Highlander from Oregon, 5th Smokin Joe from California, 6th Stampede from California, and 7th Oregon Ranger from Oregon.

First up are Stampede and Oregon Ranger on lanes 1 and 2. This round goes 2/1 in Oregon Rangers favor and Oregon Ranger takes the win hitting a .330 to Stampedes .331. Smokin Joe comes to the line to take on Oregon Ranger. Smokin Joe is hitting but he just can't touch those .332s that Oregon Ranger is hitting and now will take the X and shoot it out with Stampede on lanes 3 and 4. Now it's our 4th seed, Highlander who takes on Oregon Ranger. Highlander comes out blazing with a .608, .616, .541, 1,2,3, and Oregon Ranger has lost his mojo, not hitting, and takes his first X. Meanwhile, over on lanes 3 and 4, Stampede and Smokin Joe are battling and the score is 2/2. The crowd is cheering and encouraging our slower shooters, Highlander and Smokin Joe, as it's proof that you don't need to be a speed demon to make it to the Mag 7, you just have to be accurate, and that they were. Smokin Joe hits a .706 to Stampedes .342 and Smokin Joe, my fellow Sundowner, places 7th in the Western Territorial Championship. Up next is Arizona Cactus Kid to take on Highlander on lanes 1 and 2. They both hit 1,2,3 but it's Arizona Cactus Kid that was faster each

shot. On lanes 3 and 4, Oregon Ranger and Stampede have to duke it out again. These two are both hitting but taking turns hitting faster than the other. Stampede hits a .316 to Oregon Rangers .312 and with that, Stampede gets

his second X and places 6th. Ry-Dog Jones is up next to challenge Arizona Cactus Kid on lanes 1 and 2. This bout goes 2/2 and Ry-Dog Jones gets the last hit. Over on lanes 3 and 4, Highlander and Oregon Ranger are 2/1 in Oregon Rangers favor and Oregon Ranger gets one more hit to seal the deal, placing Highlander in 5th place. Now our 1st seed, Witlock comes up to challenge Ry-Dog Jones on lanes 1 and 2. Witlock has missed his first three shots and finally hits a .347, but Ry-Dog Jones hits his third hit, .341, and squeaks by and wins the round and takes the catbird seat. Arizona Cactus Kid and Oregon Ranger are on lanes 3 and 4 and get the score 2/2 but it is Oregon Ranger who gets the faster time of .329 to Arizona Cactus Kids .358 who takes 4th place. On lanes 3 and 4 we have Oregon Ranger and Witlock, which was a really tough bout. I have to tell you the times of each shot because this was so, SO close!! Oregon Ranger gets the first hit, .324. They both hit the next round, Oregon Ranger .329/ Witlock .330, next shot – they BOTH hit a .323, next shot they both miss, then the final shot – Witlock hits a .332 to Oregon Rangers .331. This round places Witlock in 3rd place. After that, Ry-Dog Jones comes back to the line to shoot with Oregon Ranger, the last two shooters left. Again, these two men are so close in their times, it is agonizing. .325/.322, .327, .326, .326/.323 then Oregon Ranger takes advantage with a .320 to Ry-Dogs no time and wins the bout. Now, they switch







CFDA 2025 Club of the Year

SUN DOWNERS

EST. 1958

The CFDA Board of Territorial Governors selected The Sundowners for CFDA's Club of the Year Award. The Sundowners is the oldest active Fast Draw Club that we know of anywhere. To really learn and understand the history of this club I called and interviewed the founder of this unique club, George Narasaki a.k.a. Sundowner CFDA #L94.

QC- George, it's always good to talk with you, but the first thing I want to say is Happy Birthday! I looked at our CFDA database and noticed that just yesterday you turned 90 Years Old!

SD- Thanks Cal, it's really hard to believe that I'm 90 now, even for me.

QC- You know George, you're an inspiration to all of us in so many ways. You stay in good shape and still shoot amazingly well. You still consistently shoot in the very low 4's and even pop one out in the 3's every once in a while! What's your secret?

SD- I keep walking every day, I used to walk 2 or 3 miles a day, now it's about 1/2 mile a day. You just got to keep moving and getting exercise. Practicing Cowboy Fast Draw helps keep my body and mind active, and strong. I think that if I quit walking, that'll be it for me.

I have always loved to travel to contests, traveling with Kenny (Short Keg) makes that possible. But it's getting harder for both of us to drive great distances around the country. But I've got to say, I cannot thank my wife, Nori, and Kenny's

wife, Lynn, enough for being so supportive. Without their support we couldn't do what we do.

QC- So let's talk about your club, The Sundowner's, winning CFDA's Club of the Year. How do you feel about that?

SD- Fantastic! I'm really excited about this, it's a real honor. All of the Sundowners are going to be very proud of this!

Author's Note: The early beginnings of Fast Draw date back to the mid and late 1950's, this is the era when Sundowner began shooting.

The Sport of Fast Draw has undergone many changes over the years. From just putting your trigger finger on a button and simply timing your draw, which was called "Self-Start" or "Off the Button".

In 1956 they began holding walk-n-draw contests where they shot blanks at each other on Allen Street in Tombstone, AZ, during their annual Helldorado Days Celebration, commemorating the Gunfight at the O.K. Corral. The start signal was a drop of a handkerchief, to commemorate the famous "Handkerchief Duel", which is still talked about at the tour in the Birdcage Theater.

After a few years this led to the Sahara-Colt National Fast Draw Championship, held at the brand-new Las Vegas Convention Center (1959 - 1962), which attracted national news coverage. That event

was called Walk n' Draw Level, they still fired only blanks similar to the Tombstone event, but using actual timing equipment and a lot more rules and judges. The Sport of Fast Draw has had so many club, associations and versions in its over 70-year existence, it's hard to keep track of. The Sundowners Fast Draw Club has seen them all.

QC- George, I think our readers are really interested in learning more about the history of how, when and why The Sundowners were founded. When did the club really take off?

SD- I was in my early 20's when I really got interested in Fast Draw and the whole sport was really taking off. I founded the Sundowners in 1958 and invited about 6 or 7 shooters to join as members. I wanted to hand-pick members with winning attitudes and who also displayed good sportsmanship. They also had to be willing to show up and help out at any contest that they went to. In 1960, the club really took-off growing to about 20 members.

(Picture Left) This picture was taken in 1960 at the Nevada State Championship in Virginia City near the Bucket of Blood Saloon. Down in the Front Row, 3rd from left is Short Keg (age 16); far-right is The Draw, with Wild Onion Willy just to the left of him. Standing in the Back Row 3rd from the left is me; 2nd from the right is Frontier Bob. These are the 5 original Sundowners that went on to join CFDA.

Author's Note: The Sundowners expanded their club with perhaps the most impressive list of members, most either winning CFDA Titled Championships or becoming well-known and respected competitors on the Cowboy Fast Draw circuit, who are true to the original vision that Sundowner had when he formed the club.

Many of the great names in the history of our sport are Sundowners, whether in the picture taken at the CFDA National Championship at the Shelterwood Ranch, or not. Some members won championships in the old days of Fast Draw like California Thumber, Frontier Bob, Wild Onion Willy and Sundowner; and some became CFDA Titled Champions like Short Keg, Sprayin' Lead Ned, Jess, Lefty Lipscomb, Huckleberry Honey, Fowl Shot, The Lawman, Semi-Sweet, Vic Torious, and youth champion Night Hawk; along with some of the legends of our sport who have passed like The Draw, Omaha Outlaw and Express Rider.



Sundowner has kept true to form and continues to invite members who are not only competitors and sportsmen, but always there to help like Wild Shot, Legend Hunter, Coco Bandit, Smokin' Joe, Frisco Kid, and Doug Dylan.

QC- Where does your club currently meet and practice?

SD- *We have a 4-Lane Range in Vacaville, CA and we shoot on the 3rd Weekend every month.*

QC- Do you have any tips for other clubs?

SD- *Just find good people that you can tell love the sport.*

QC- What are you most proud of about your club?

SD- *All of the champions who were Sundowners for over 65 years.*

Additional Comments:

The Sundowners hosted the 1st CFDA California Championship in 2007, in Los Banos, CA.

In 2020, Fowl Shot & Huckleberry Honey opened their Shelterwood Ranch in Oroville, CA to hold the California State Championship, just for that year, since The Cowboy's range in Oakdale, CA was not available, due to Covid. Since there were no other CFDA titles available for 2021, the Western Territorial Championship was offered and moved from Nevada to Oroville, because the Shelterwood Ranch is just too beautiful of a venue to not host a CFDA Titled Championship. Fowl Shot

is Frontier Bob's son, which makes him a legacy member of the Sundowners, he and Huckleberry Honey care deeply about the history and future of the Sundowners.

Since that time there have been 5-Western Territorial Championships & 3-CFDA National Championships held at the Shelterwood Ranch, hosted by The Sundowners!

I would like to thank Sundowner for the interview and all of the information about club members and photos. Sundowner is truly an amazing legend of our sport dating back to its very beginnings. George, just keep walking every day, it's an honor for all of us to see you on the firing line.



* The Territorial Governors are an elected position, that are nominated and elected by the members in the Territory they represent. They are elected for a 2 year term. The initial Territorial Governors were appointed in 2025. Their initial term is set simply by whether the territory they represent is either an odd or even number. Once Territorial Governors are elected by the membership of their respective territories, they all become 2-Year terms. This means only 50% of the Territorial Governors may change each year, which provides continuity. For a complete understanding please refer to our CFDA, Non-profit By-Laws. How did I get my alias? With a little help from one of my grandpas, Ol Buck'r. One day, he was telling me a story about working on a ranch and what they called the cattle at night - "night hawks". I thought it was a pretty cool and picked that as my alias. It's hard choosing an alias.



Alotta Lead's Family Favorite Recipes

~ CHOWDER SOUP ~

Who doesn't love and enjoy piping hot Chowder Soup on a cold wintery evening for dinner? Chowder soups are so easy to make, and this is a Family Favorite we always have several times throughout the winter months. You can add different types of veggies as well....zucchini, mushrooms, yellow squash, the list is whatever you like! Even add chopped chicken or bacon bits.

Here's What You Need:

- 3 Tablespoons unsalted **Butter**
- 1 Medium **Onion**, diced
- 2 Cloves **Garlic**, minced
- 2 Large **Carrots**, diced into small bite size pieces
- 2 **Celery** stalks, diced
- 2 Medium **Red Potatoes**, washed, diced into bite size chunks
-leave the skin on if you like-yum!
- 4 Cups **Chicken** (or vegetable broth)
- 1/2 Teaspoon **Salt** or to taste

- 1/2 Teaspoon **Black Pepper** to taste
- 2 Cups **Broccoli** – cut into small pieces
- 1-1/2 Cup **Corn** kernels (fresh or frozen)
- 3 Tablespoons all-purpose **Flour**
- 2 Cups **Milk**
- 3 Cups of Shredded **Cheese** *pick your favorite type*
- 1 Tablespoon of sugar..... *more or less to taste*
- 1/4 Cup chopped fresh **Green Onion Tops**
(the green part for garnish if you like!)

Putting it Together!!

- *In a large soup pot, melt the butter over medium heat. Add the chopped onion and garlic, and sauté for about 3 -4 minutes, or until the onion is translucent.
- *Stir in the diced carrots, potatoes & Celery. Cook for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- *Add the chicken broth, salt, sugar and black pepper. Bring the mixture to a boil, then reduce the heat to low and simmer for 15-20 minutes, or until the potatoes are tender.
- *Stir in the broccoli and corn. Simmer for another 5 minutes, or until the broccoli is just tender.
- *In a different saucepan, mix together the milk & flour until mixture is smooth. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until the mixture thickens, about 7-9 minutes.
- *Remove the saucepan from the heat & stir in your favorite shredded cheese until melted and smooth.
- *Pour the cheese sauce into the pot with the vegetables, stirring to combine. Heat through, then taste & adjust seasoning. Serve hot, garnished with finely chopped green onion tops if desired.
- **Enjoy this "Chowder Soup" with a big hunk of warm French bread with butter and honey, or a side salad for an amazing dinner!

The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. A refund of the sale will be made, minus the original \$35 shipping fee and a 5% re-login/re-stocking fee.

THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western Cowboy, Rodeo or Working Cowboy, Victorian Steam-punk clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Cowboy Hats for Men. No short-sleeve or t-shirts, tennis shoes, or baseball style hats are allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live

ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.
