INSIDE CFDA

- NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION -

As I travel around our country to Cowboy Fast Draw Championships from coast to coast, I'm pleased to report that the positive spirit of our membership is very high and strong. One of the things we can all be proud of is the friendliness and camaraderie that we find at any of our tournaments and CFDA Affiliated Clubs no matter where you travel across our great nation. Our Motto of Safety First, Fun Second and Competition Third is in full force wherever you go. From this positive spirit and commitment to principles that we share comes what many of us refer to as "Our CFDA Family!"

This Month's Column is About Clubs

I've stated many times before that our CFDA Affiliated Clubs are the very foundation of our sport. I came to this conclusion years before CFDA was created. I learned this truth from the actual history of the general sport of "Fast Draw" that I've been involved with since 1968.

History Lesson, Learning the Hard Way

Fast Draw Clubs sprung up across America from coast to coast during the late 1950's and 60's. Colt Firearms saw huge potential which caused them to resume production the Colt .45 S&W in 1958. Colt attempted to organize the sport nationally in 1962, but soon realized that there were too many irreconcilable differences between the regional associations and decided to drop the project. There were several associations, the main two were the Western & Mid-Western Fast Draw Associations, that sometimes joint sanctioned World & National Championships. There were also several State Associations like Ohio, Arizona, Kansas, etc.

In 1976, the World Fast Draw Association was established with a merger between the Western & Mid-Western Associations. Unfortunately, it was too late, since during the late 60's, 70's and 80's if there were any clubs left, they boiled down to just a few members. The sport became mainly made of shooters that traveled nationally from one Chairman Sanctioned Championship to another or smaller regional Vice-Chairman Sanctioned events. How do you recruit new members when the closest events are many hundreds or thousands of miles apart? The answer, "Very Few". What lesson was learned? **When there are no clubs to recruit and develop new members the sport will decline and die.** I had been involved in other shooting sports during the 80's and it bothered me to see WFDA's decline, so I came back and first served as Secretary, then Chairman of the WFDA for 6 years, beginning in 1992. I led a movement to rebuild the organization that declined to just over 100 members. We re-built it to just under 1,000, but the same old

politics that had affected Fast Draw since the 1950's & 60's were just too entrenched, when my term ended after 1997, I left and joined SASS. Currently, there seems to be less than 50 active WFDA members left in North America, many of them live in Canada, where it's been difficult to own a firearm for years and now cannot even buy one.

SASS & IPSC/USPSA Clubs

I spent the better part of a decade in each of these sports that grew to be huge. During the 80's I became very involved with IPSC, was President of Sierra Nevada Pistol League for several years a club that we built to over 120 members. In SASS, beginning in 1998, I founded a SASS Club, The High Plains Drifters, and built it to over 100 members. Both of these sports still flourish because they have a strong support for clubs across America as well as other countries.

CFDA Affiliated Clubs

From our clubs are developed the future leaders of our sport both locally and nationally. The large majority of our members don't travel much outside of their local regions, which is why active clubs are so crucial to Cowboy Fast Draw. However, our members that do travel and compete in CFDA Titled Championship across the nation, bring back important information and knowledge of constantly evolving standards and procedures to their clubs and regions.

CFDA Stand Alone Clubs

There are many CFDA Affiliated Clubs that are somewhat isolated, wherein the clubs are many hours apart. If those clubs do not host enough activity to keep their members interested, their membership numbers will stagnate and decline. Often there's just a small core of really committed members that sometimes do travel to contests outside of their region.

CFDA Regionally Connected Clubs

This is where the magic really happens! When there are multiple clubs that are within a few hours drive from one another it creates support between those clubs for each other's monthly matches and establishes a hotspot of regional activity, especially when club leaders coordinate their schedules. Some of these regions coordinate a regional series of Club Matches. In My Opinion, there's no such thing as too many clubs in an area!

CFDA's Goal is to Form New Clubs and Help Build Existing Club's Memberships

This is one of the key functions of CFDA! When we receive correspondence from prospective or new CFDA Members, we try to hook them up to the nearest club or members Sometimes with a phone number, we also try to link them with a contact email.

How to Recruit New Members?

Any Club That's Not Growing Will Not Survive! Many of our clubs have told us they have a hard time recruiting members. Sometimes members will find you, but really it does take effort to actively build a membership. First, our best recruiting

tool is our members who bring friends and family members, that's kind of like Network Marketing. Only we do not try to sell them soap like a company like Amway does. We DO try to Sell them on our sport, for which once we hook them on having fun with six-guns and making some of the best friends that will ever have. They will Thank You!

We also have two established public recruitment programs:

1. Try Cowboy Fast Draw Events - Formerly known as Town Folk Alleys, were popular. However, these events require a lot of club member support with transport, set-up, and tear-down. Plus, having teams fitting holsters, handling and cleaning guns, loading and unloading wax ammo, firing line coaches, timer operator announcers, scorekeepers, etc. Plus, the liability of shooting wax bullets in crowded locations.

2. Invitation to a Gunfighter - This method is becoming more popular, since all that is really needed is a display table showing some examples of Cowboy Fast Draw equipment. Maybe some videos playing, there are several available online on our website. What also really attracts attention is a pair of Gunslinger Timers, hooked to elevated Audience Displays, using Gunslinger Reaction Trainers to record reaction times, which can all be run on just battery power. It creates a very visible attraction! What really makes it work is having a very visible Drawing Box, wherein the public can fill out a card and enter a drawing for a **FREE LESSON, including Guns, Holsters and Ammunition.**

The most important part of either recruiting event is the follow-up. If you do not follow up your efforts by contacting participants, you just wasted your time, money, and efforts. **Here's how the two methods compare...**

1. Try Cowboy Fast Draw- Even though we would have all participants of Try Cowboy Fast Draw sign releases and provide phone numbers and emails, when participants were called after the event to see if they were interested in Cowboy Fast Draw, the response was "**Luke-Warm**" at best. Many were actually surprised that we would even call them. Yes, we did recruit a few and every new member is certainly valuable.

2. Invitation to a Gunfighter- When calling the folks who had submitted cards to win a **Free Lesson**, the response was usually "**Extreme Excitement**". They would often ask if they could bring friends or family members. If you're interested in learning how to run an Invitation to a Gunfighter, go to CowboyFastDraw.com, under Clubs Information & Downloads.

In Closing, Please support your local CFDA Club, State & Territorial Championships, and if you can travel to our National & World Championships, Even Better!

Kellyville, Oklahoma - It wasn't too hot or too cold at the Creek County Fairgrounds, but the wind came sweeping down the plain. After all it is Oklahoma! The 2026 shoot was a success and a big thank you to the Route 66 smOKin' Guns for putting on another great championship. The venue is just a stone's throw from the famous Route 66, aka The Will Rogers Highway, which is celebrating the 100th anniversary of its inception. Gun checks, safety meeting, pledge of allegiance and a prayer started each day. Leading off on Friday was the 4th annual Will Rogers shoot with around 50 gunslingers vying for the Centennial belt buckle that came out in 1979 celebrating Will's 100th birthday. This year's winner was Twitch, proudly taking his prize back to Texas. Thanks to Diamond Rose for another nice spread for the meet and greet after Friday's action.

This year's Shootist champion was Boss handling the big iron like it was a cap gun. All of you cowboys and cowgirls who shoot the long gun, my hat's off to you.

Saturday was the kick off of the main match which consisted of 9 rounds. There were 38 men, 21 women, 4 Jr. boys and 1 youth shooter. As usual you can always see handshakes, hugs and pats on the


back while on the line. It's hard to beat the camaraderie of the Cowboy Fast Draw family. That evening the banquet was held at the Elks Lodge in Sapulpa, Oklahoma. Good food, good company, awards from the previous day and a plethora of door prizes. Friday's fun shoots were as popular as ever with the couples shoot won by Corky and Boss who also were top couple of the weekend. Father and son duo of Ain't Missin' and Duke of Earl took the Bandit shoot while Rock Bottom won the Quick and the Dead for the second year in a row. Fighting his way back from Boot Hill, Dog Iron was able to secure the top spot in the Resurrection match. The best dressed of the weekend went to the one and only Shady Lady from Kansas.

Championship Sunday started off with three Jr. Boys who are all lightning fast, Night Light, Ain't Missin' and Sidewinder Wade. Night Light came out on top as the top Jr. boy champion and was also the proud owner of the men's fastest shot with an astounding .306!!

Next up was the women's championship with the top 7 battling down to the last

two standing which were Risky Dame and Corky with Risky Dame taking her place as the women's Oklahoma State Champion. Although out of the running for the championship, Hummingbird had the fastest women's shot as she sent her piece of wax downrange hitting steel at a blistering time of .404!

The weekend was finalized with the men's Mag 7 coming down to Dirty Mike and Quick Cal. The battle was fast and furious with Dirty Mike just edging out the Black Badge for the win. Dirty Mike was the first "Okie" to win the Oklahoma Championship in 2024 and now has a second notch to add to his gun. This, of course, also makes him the Resident State champion along with Diamond Girl as the women's Resident State champion. The 2026 Georgia State Championship saw a record number of 64 shooters join the Hickory Flat Shootist Society for three days of great shooting. The event was held in Waleska, Georgia at the property of Paul Poole, in a little historic community of Lost Town. The community was inundated during the creation of Lake Arrowhead in the 1970s. It was settled in the 1840s as a plantation named Lost Town. Many of the settlers' descendants of the original pioneer families still reside in Waleska.

In the men's super seniors Alabama was first with Buffalo Joe second and Sprayin' Lead Ned third. In ladies' Grand Dame, Brown Eyed Girl finished first with Lone Horse second. In the men's Old Timers,

Pale Rider came in first with Smokey Bear second and Toothpick third. In the men's Golden Gun, S-Man captured first with Colonel Buck coming in second. In men's Elder Statesman, Shane came in first, Gunner second and Concho Jim third. In the Annie Oakley category, Krazy Mae was first and Little Smokey second. In the ladies' Junior, Rebel Rose took first.

We also had a Shootist category for the woman and men. Winning the Shootist State Championship was Catskill Jean, followed by Madam Clerk, then Rebel Rose. In the men's, Green River took the championship, followed by Tin Bender, and Snake Bit third.

Sunday we began with the Bracket matches, where shooters compete in their speed brackets. In the Master Gunfighter bracket, Jackass Jiles came in first, Twitch second, and Big Ugly third. In the Gunfighter bracket, first was Alabama, second was Sugarbutt, and

Our top couple was Catskill Jean and I.B. Nobody who finished with highest combined totals. Our Top Hand award went to Rambunctious Red for all the hours he spent

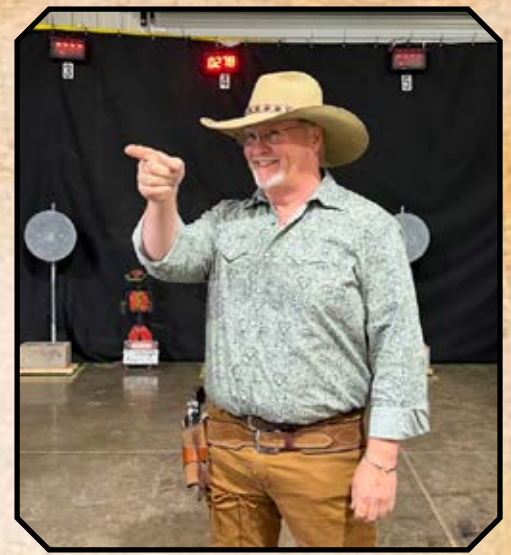

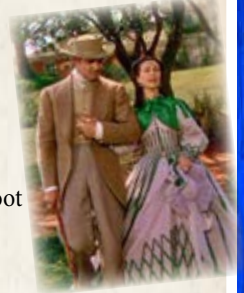

Alotta Lead's Family Favorite Recipes

Everyone loves a simple quick meal to prepare fast & get it on the table. This one comes together quickly, and it is delish!! It's a family favorite for sure! All in one dish in the **CAST IRON SKILLET**. Give it a try for a cozy movie night & by the way, the leftovers are even better!

Supreme Pizza Casserole *In The Cast Iron Skillet*

2 ½ cups of uncooked spiral pasta
 1 ½ lb. ground beef
 1-150z can Pizza Sauce or more to taste
 1-8oz can tomato sauce
 1-6oz can tomato paste
 ¾ teaspoon sugar -more or less to taste (we like it a bit sweeter)
 ½ teaspoon Garlic Salt – Black pepper to taste
 ½ teaspoon dried Oregano (I use a pizza Seasoning I buy online- it's made just for pizza)

3- cups Mozzarella Cheese - shredded
 Pepperoni, (almost cooked) pork or turkey sausage. (I use the Italian turkey sausage, has great flavor) As much or little as you want
 Medium onion – Green Bell Pepper, mushrooms all diced – use as much or little as you want to taste!

Here's what you do: Preheat oven to 350.

*Cook pasta according to directions and drain.

*Cook onions & beef in your cast iron skillet –break up the beef, cook on med high heat until browned. Drain the fat off! Add Garlic salt and pepper to taste.

*IN A LARGE BOWL - Combine.....all the pasta, pizza sauce, tomato sauce, tomato paste, sugar, & oregano (or pizza seasoning) Add the beef & onions to the bowl and mix well. *This is the pizza goodness!*

*Back to the skillet.....spread half of the mixture in the cast iron skillet.

* Top with 1 ½ cup cheese. Put remaining “pizza goodness” on top, add the bell peppers, extra onions, sausage & mushrooms on top then sprinkle with the remainder of the cheese.

*Bake for 30 minutes until heated through & the cheese is hot, bubbly & just turning brown! Yummmm! So good- with a side salad and garlic bread, you have the best movie night dinner!

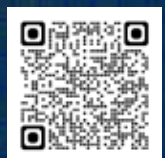

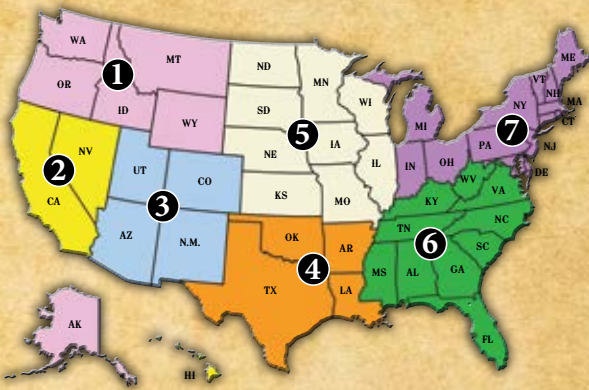

THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western Cowboy, Rodeo or Working Cowboy, Victorian Steam-punk clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Cowboy Hats for Men. No short-sleeve or t-shirts, tennis shoes, or baseball style hats are allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live

ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.

SOME OF OUR GOALS

To keep our clothing & equipment such as guns and holsters true to form of the time period that we represent (1873-1899). 1873 is the year that the Colt Peacemaker was introduced.

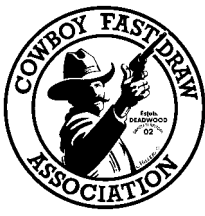
