I'm writing this column while riding along with Dead Eye Kid & Six Gun Shells on the way to the Idaho State & Great Northwest Territorial Championships. People have asked over the years how I ended up in Northern Nevada. It was actually because of the Sport of Fast Draw. I moved to Reno in 1974 to accept a construction job offer from Fast Draw legends Jim Dyer and Dave Tuttle who owned a construction company at the time. I soon realized that Reno was a perfect place for a Fast Draw junkie like me, since it was right in the middle of the American West and the most active region for the sport in the entire country. I could reach Fast Draw matches in Arizona, Southern and Northern California, and Oregon all within a 4 to 10-hour drive. Plus, the construction industry was really taking off in Reno. Shortly after being told I could not take time off to attend a Fast Draw Contest, I decided to stake my claim and start my own construction business.

One day, a few years later, while checking a job on a gravel road out in the middle of nowhere, while driving my 260Z, I stopped to help a good-looking gal with a broken-down car that happened to be a 240Z. After helping to get the car running and following her out to the main road, she decided to stop and thank me. I told her I knew a good Z-Car Mechanic and gave her my card that said "World Fast Draw Champion" on it. She gave me a card back that introduced her as an Artist. I left the next day for, you guessed it, a Fast Draw Contest. When I got back to town I worked up the nerve to call her. She said she was cooking a hamburger and was watching the 1978 World Series on TV and said she would throw on another if I wanted to come over as a Thank You for helping her out. Well, let's just say, it was love at first sight and Alotta Lead and I were married 6 weeks later. And here, you all thought I got my alias from shooting... ☺

I wrote the above because "God Only Knows" what or where my life would be if it wasn't for Fast Draw. Perhaps that's why I love it so much and the happiness it has brought to so many people. The Cowboy Fast Draw Association that so many of us have spent over 2 decades developing has especially changed so many lives, we should all be so proud that many of our members call it, their CFDA Family...

FASTEST GUN ALIVE UPDATE

First, Congratulations to all of the winners, there were many! I think we were all pleased that we once again we are back to drawing over 200 Shooters. Plus, we set a record of drawing over 20 Youth, Junior and young adult Shooters. We fired almost 30,000 rounds of wax bullet ammo, **Thank You Gun Hawks for all that you do!** I find it interesting that there are those who've wandered off to spin-off sports complaining they don't like being X'd out of

a match with nothing to do. The fact is that FGA offers a number of competitive opportunities other than the main match. Our Thursday 2-X Category Match with over 200 shooters, then that same day if you happen to get your 2nd X, there are Side Matches to enjoy. On Friday, our goal is 7 Rounds, not an easy task with 5 Ranges going full blast. But, if you find your 4th X, there is a 2-X 2nd Chance Match on Saturday followed by our Tournament of Champions, Shootist & Junior Championship Shoot-offs. Then of course everyone gets to play in our Bracket Matches on Sunday Morning, just before our Mag 7 Finals! When you are not shooting you can watch exciting championship finals and enjoy our evening events. Some Shooters have even complained that there is too much shooting... We have refined our sport so much that most of our CFDA Titled Matches also have adopted Side Matches, with Bracket Matches really becoming popular. Look for the full article on the 2026 Fastest Gun Alive in the next (Winter) Issue of the Gunslinger's Gazette.

Make your plans now for the 2027 Fastest Gun Alive the 3rd weekend of the month July 14th – 18th! 2027 is CFDA's 25th Anniversary!

2026 CFDA SCORING PROGRAM UPDATE

Our new scoring program is in its final stages of development and testing. We've learned a lot running the program for the first time ever in a titled championship at this year's FGA. We found out in the past that you can test a Scoring Program until you're blue in the face, but it really takes major matches for the real truth to come out! Our FGA Scoring Team all tested it ahead of time and I must admit, I was nervous about using it at our biggest match. But, after consulting with our team we all agreed that it was time to put it to the ultimate test.

Yes, we did have problems, quite a few actually, but our experienced team found ways around those problems and kept everything running on time, I just can't thank them enough! They also made notes and kept track of the problems.

After FGA, CD Tom and I worked many hours over several days getting the problems worked out. There were some very deep parts of the program that needed the coding adjusted, sometimes just one letter or small character makes all the difference. This is an internally very complicated program, given all of the options we offer, with multiple ranges, categories and divisions we run. There are over 100,000 lines of code in this program along with hundreds of tables in the background. As of this writing, our FGA Scoring Team is running it through one more short cycle of testing. **Thank You Wild Shot, Ubet, Lady Heather and Bean Counter.** We're also working on producing a new manual for this version, which will be much more thorough than the last one. There may also be some videos in the future, but that will take some time. This new program does quite a few things better than the last version, especially when it comes to registrations, back-ups, restores, producing match results and much more. We're on track to begin distributing this to our clubs this off-season during the Fall & Winter, and ready for the 2027 Season.

BOARD OF TERRITORIAL GOVERNOR ELECTIONS

It's time to conduct our annual election for Territorial Governors. Please see details on page 22 of this issue of the Gunslinger's Gazette.

U.S. MARSHAL'S MUSTER & TG BOARD RESULTS

At our annual Marshal's Muster at FGA, we had several agenda items. Probably the most controversial one was considering whether to have a shot limit per round in Main Matches. This was previously considered in 2021 and barely voted down. Many members wanted it re-addressed. After a rather emotional debate, the consensus was finally reached that there should not be a shot limit in Main Matches. At the August CFDA Territorial Governors Board Meeting, they voted to agree and no further action will be taken.

The other significant issue was to try to reduce scheduling conflicts between CFDA Class A & B Titled Championships and Class C Sanctioned events. Class C Sanction Matches are defined as non-titled, but advertised, annual club matches usually like Jackpot or Themed Shoots. CFDA established a rule years ago that Titled Championships held on the same weekend must be separated by a minimum of 1,000 miles. Since CFDA Titled Championships take many months of planning and considerable financial investment by CFDA Host Clubs, the "strong" consensus of the U.S. Marshals was there should be a separation of at least 500 miles between a Class C Shoot and any CFDA Titled Championship.

The U.S. Marshals also agreed was that CFDA Titled Championships should have the first right of choosing dates for their events. Therefore, it was agreed that CFDA will not allow C Class Championships to officially announce dates or advertise on any CFDA Social Media Assets like our Gunslinger's Gazette, CFDA Website or Facebook, more than 6 months prior to the dates of their event. This gives our CFDA Titled Championships an advantage as long as they pick their dates more than 6 months prior. **Warning!** This also works both ways and means that CFDA Titled Championships, must also not schedule their match dates to conflict a previously scheduled C Class Match within 500 miles. The Board of Territorial Governors also approved this item at the August Meeting.

Well, we're most of the way to Boise, so I will conclude my writing, get this emailed to stay out of trouble with our Editor-in-Chief, who threatens me with posting unbecoming photos all the time.

I wish you all the BEST! There's still a lot of shooting left this season, all the way to Pennsylvania, California and back to Arizona. Hope to see You at a Match Soon!

This is one that needs to be changed up!

This item seems to always be brought up - every year at the Marshal's Muster. There are not enough emphases on how important it is to have more than one day a month of shooting in a club. We get phone calls and emails from members that want to continue shooting in CFDA, but not enough days of club activity, also club leaders that say that their clubs are not growing! There's one thing that hindering a successful outcome...it's NOT having enough shooting days for practice or having club matches for its members. If you're a new club and you don't have a certain time and days to practice, it looks like you're not organized, and folks are not interested. Having a CFDA Club means a whole lot more than to say you have a CFDA Club.

There is a responsibility to running a club- as a successful one from the start. Locations, Times, & Days need to be consistent and be put out there so members or prospective new members can count on knowing how to schedule their time as well. Can't tell you how many members have called or emailed stating they love the sport, but their local club has only one day of shooting per month, and sometimes even those are cancelled for one reason or another.

Please don't take me wrong, I'm not saying all clubs are like this, look at the ones that run the fun and highly successful clubs - those are the clubs that shoot multiple days per month. They also do fun things within the club that all members can partake

in even outside the club perimeters, they all work as a team, have fun together to make fun a top priority! They might have several different range locations so if one is not available, they can move to another- not to miss a shoot or practice days. Have several club members that are capable to take over running a club practice or shoot day if the main person isn't available so that nothing must be canceled. A CFDA Club can have more than one range location, each one for a few dollars to be covered with CFDA Club Liability Insurance. Please think about adding on more shoot days if you don't have this option. Your members will thank you, it will attract more members, and the club will flourish. The sport of CFDA Thanks you!

Speaking of CFDA, we all know that CFDA is a non-profit now and can take in donations, just like any other 501 C-3 Non-Profit Charitable Organization. When having a Shoot for the Stars auction at your match, please consider doing auctions for CFDA, the members sport. To help it grow and be the best it can be, it needs the funds to continue on into the future. If CFDA has helped you in some way, consider giving back to it. Ask your local Territorial Governor in your area what needs to be done to help CFDA. Be part of a big movement that is on the horizon. It's the best family-friendly sport ever!

In closing, with this being the Fall issue, we have one more issue of the Gunslinger's Gazette Magazine to go for 2026 which is the "Winter issue". Where did the time go? Makes you stop and think about the wonderful times that were had over the past year and all the great CFDA events you were at, and the amazing folks you met along the way. 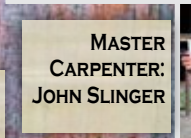

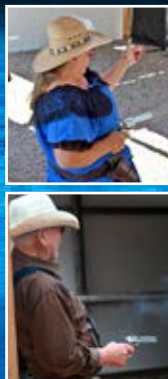

Stampede stepped up and quickly mastered the challenge to claim 1st place, followed in 2nd place by Cowboy Up.

Sunday morning belonged to the bracket shoots, but a brand-new competition quickly became the talk of the range. Ol' Red's Bracket Brawl brought together teams of three shooters, one from each bracket, in a fast-moving showdown for the lowest combined score. The inaugural match drew plenty of excitement, laughter, and good-natured trash talk from the crowd, with the winning team made up of Dead Eye Kid, Quick Cal, and The Cowboys own Deadeye Desperado, who etched their names into the books as the very first Bracket Brawl champions.

Pineville, Louisiana - Lagniappe (*lan-yap*) is a Cajun French term that means "a little something extra". It is a staple of Cajun merchants, who like to give extra value to their customers. The Cross Branded Peacemakers wanted to continue this tradition and give extra value to the shooters who came to Louisiana State Championship.

The Louisiana State Championship was held at the Hotel Plantation, a venue that has given us exemplary service in the past. To be generous, this was not the case this year. The hotel has undergone an ownership change that affected the physical facility and the hospitality culture that made this a first-class venue in the past. We apologize for any inconvenience.

The Cross Branded Peacemakers arrived at the venue on Thursday morning to erect the ranges and set up the amenities. We started at 9:00 am by first covering the 6500 square foot carpeted floor of the ballroom with a poly house wrap used in

residential construction. We then began erecting ranges, setting up scoring tables, and taking care of all the little things that are necessary to have a comfortable, safe, shooting event.

Our crew is second-to-none. By noon, the ranges were erected, the electronics were plugged in, and the fellows were practicing on the ranges. Squirrel Girl had set up her scoring area, while Blue Eyed Belle tweaked the amenities like shooters bags and door prizes. Texas Rose arrived shortly after noon and gave us some minor points that we had overlooked. They were quickly addressed. Many thanks to our Regulators who keep us straight. We then got down to the finer points of the new rule book that I needed clarification on.

After the prayer and pledge, we started the match with a quick qualifier for the Bracket match. Some were surprised to see that we used Drawing Cards to tabulate Xs and draw rounds. Drawing Cards are a valuable backup to our computer society and are extremely useful when the electricity dies or the computer glitches. If your club doesn't know how to use Drawing Cards, dig them out and practice with them. It's a good tool to have when things go sideways.

One special award for the Bracket Matches was crafted to remember Vovo, a shooter in our club. He was a mechanic by trade and specialized in helicopter maintenance, specifically the manufacture of tools for the helicopter industry. He died during December 2025 and our club mourns the loss. His sons donated some of his tools and club member Shorty D crafted a replica of a revolver from Vovo's tools and we presented it to the winner of the Sheriff's bracket, the bracket that Vovo fell into at

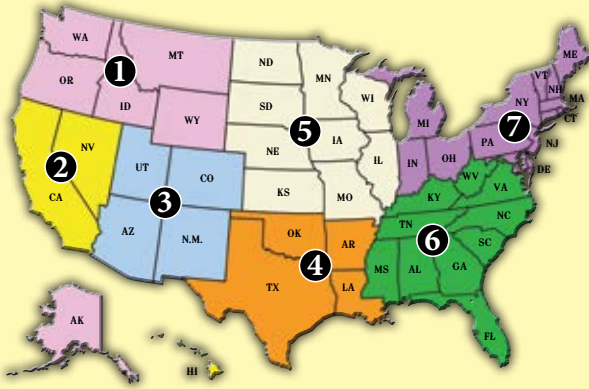
- IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT - BOARD OF TERRITORIAL GOVERNOR ELECTIONS

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Alotta Lead's Family Favorite Recipes

Summer is coming to an end and Fall weather is just around the corner! There's always time for one more delicious Family Favorite! This one you can cook over a campfire or right in your own backyard on the BBQ grill.

We love this one for our family get togethers, it quick easy and yummy.

Give it a try – you'll be making this a family favorite as well!

Fresh Fruit & Chicken Kabobs

2 cups of fresh pineapple- cut into 1" chunks

3-4 Fresh plums cut into quarters, then half again

2-3 Med apples- firm and crispy- cut into 1" chunks (green ones work best-tart yet sweet)

1 cup of Honey

6 Tablespoons Lemon juice- (fresh is best, but can substitute bottle juice if needed)

¼ cup Dijon Mustard ½ more or less to taste

2 tablespoons fresh ginger

1 tablespoon low sodium soy sauce- omit if you like

Teaspoon of fresh garlic- diced very small -more or less to your taste

Touch of Brown sugar- more or less to taste...we like ours on the sweeter side

2-1/2 lbs. Chicken Breast- cut into 1" cube size

Next.....If you use wooden skewers soak in water for at least 30 minutes. You can use metal skewers as well.

The Basting Sauce: Mix together: honey, Dijon mustard, brown sugar, garlic, ginger, soy sauce, & lemon juice, combine all ingredients really well and set aside.

Take all the chopped fresh fruit and cubed chicken & alternate on each skewer; pineapple, chicken, plum, chicken, , apple, chicken....you get the point & you can do it in any order you like.

After finishing all the skewers, brush with the yummy sauce & place on your med-hot campfire grill or backyard BBQ grill. Keep basting with the sauce, turning every few mins, not to burn or dry out the chicken. Cook until the chicken is golden caramelized brown and is gooey with the sauce, or cook until it's 160 degrees. You don't want under cooked chicken- it will not be a family favorite! Enjoy this main dish BBQ along with warm French bread and side salad! For a little extra kick in the sauce, add red pepper flakes to taste! It'll know your socks off! So good!



Sanctioning a Titled Match & First Right of Refusal

Just a Reminder, As stated on page 30 of the Gunslingers Guidelines, To Retain First Right of Refusal: A current host club must declare their intention to host the following year's event within 60 days following a current championship. They must submit the CFDA Sanctioned Event Agreement and the minimum deposit, which will secure their date and titled championship rights for the following year.

If a club fails to submit the Event Agreement within that 60 days, then they shall relinquish their "first right of refusal" for the titled championship for the following year.

So Don't Delay! If you haven't already sent in your 2027 Sanctioned Event Agreement to lock in your dates, be sure to get them sent in ASAP. We will not post any dates on the CFDA website until the paperwork has been received at CFDA headquarters. Sanction Agreements can be found on the CFDA website under the "CFDA Events & Results" section.

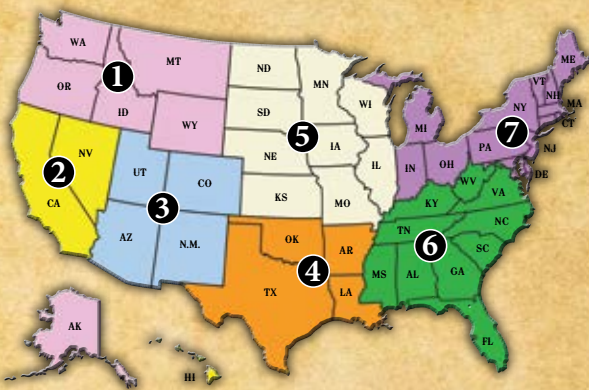

THE GUNS

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

THE HOLSTERS & GUN BELTS

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

AMMUNITION

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

TARGETS (THREE STANDARD TARGETS)

17-3/16" Round Plate - 47" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
24" Round Plate - 50" Center Height (Start Light in Center)
Balloon-Disc - Rarely Used in Championship Finals - See Specs

White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

COMPETITION TIMERS

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Sanctioned contests must use target with impact sensors.

SHOOTING STYLE

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

CONTESTS

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

CLOTHING

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western Cowboy, Rodeo or Working Cowboy, Victorian Steam-punk clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Cowboy Hats for Men. No short-sleeve or t-shirts, tennis shoes, or baseball style hats are allowed.

SAFETY

One of our primary goals is to educate as many people as possible in the safe and proper use of firearms. Even though we use wax bullet ammunition, we treat them as they were live

ammunition and observe all established range safety rules.

To keep our clothing & equipment such as guns and holsters true to form of the time period that we represent (1873-1899). 1873 is the year that the Colt Peacemaker was introduced.
